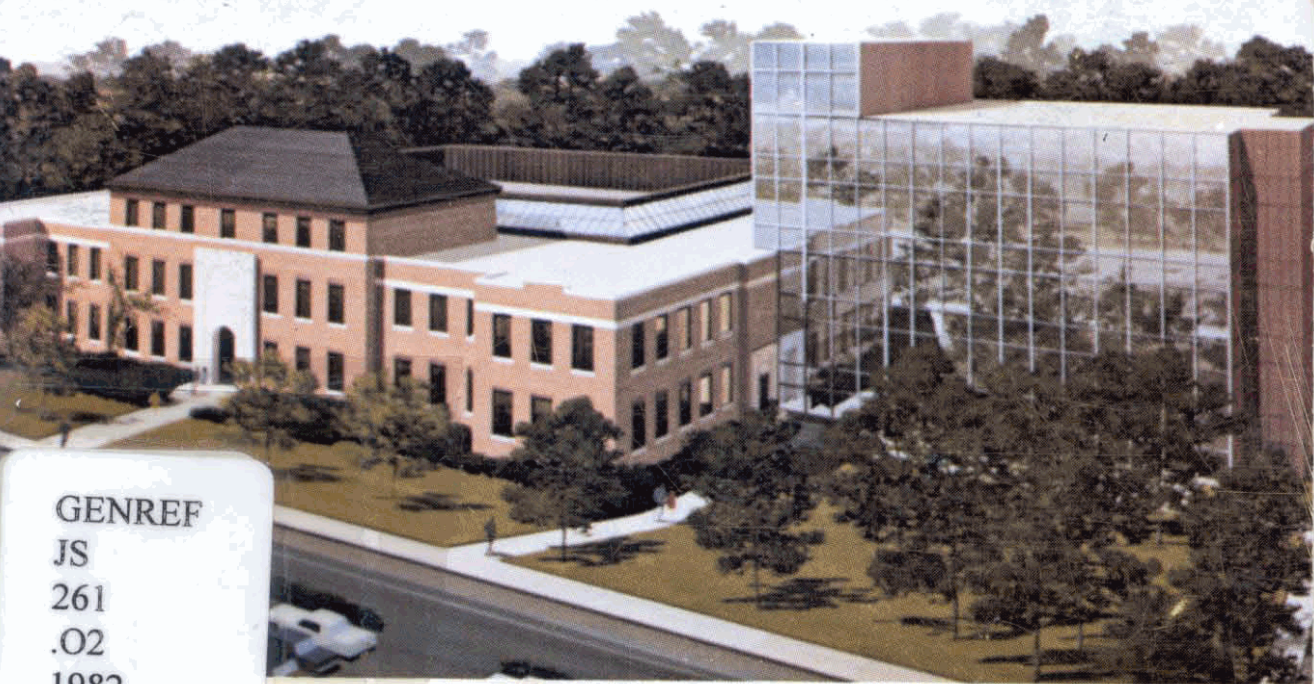

FRONT COVER:

County Executive Building, Constructed in 1926 with a four story wing added in 1951, the building originally served the County as a Tuberculosis Sanatorium. Completion of the new Medical Care Facility in 1975 made the old building obsolete. Plans were begun on a major remodeling in 1976 and, in 1981, it was fully occupied. As the Executive Office Building, it provides quarters for the County Executive and many of his administrative staff. In designing the remodeling, the architectural firm of TMP Associates of Bloomfield won an award from the Michigan Society of Architects for adaptive reuse of an existing structure.

OAKLAND COUNTY ROADS

More than half of all highways, roads and streets in Oakland County are on the county system, which is under jurisdiction of the Board of Oakland County Road Commissioners.

Totalling more than 2,500 miles, this system includes all public roads in townships and through streets in most cities and villages. It is the longest county system in Michigan. Its subdivision streets alone (all in townships) make up more than 1,000 miles, or the equivalent of a trip from Pontiac to Florida.

About half of the system is paved. More than half is within the county's urban area, where some roads are four and five lanes wide to handle heavy traffic. A single intersection, in Southfield, is the meeting place for 100,000 vehicles daily. More than 800 electrical signals and 35,000 signs are in use on the county road system.

The Road Commission does not levy a countywide tax, nor does anyone levy a tax countywide for roads. Also, the elected Board of Oakland County Commissioners is prohibited by law from using any of its general property tax levy for roads.

The basic source of Road Commission revenues is the state-collected gas and weight tax, which motorists pay at the pump for gasoline and diesel fuel and to the Secretary of State for vehicle registrations. Because the gas tax has been a flat rate per gallon sold, the amount of revenue has fallen off in recent years as motorists have switched to more fuel efficient vehicles.

Four townships do levy locally-voted taxes for roads: Commerce, Highland, Bloomfield and Avon. The long-standing Commerce Township road levy has resulted in 75 percent of its roads being paved, which compares to 48 percent in townships countywide. Highland's relatively new road tax is making possible accelerated improvements to its roads. Bloomfield and Avon Townships use road levies to supplement road maintenance.

For paving and resurfacing of subdivision streets, the Road Commission limits its contribution of gas and weight tax funding to 10 percent of the project cost. By contacting the Road Commission; then petitioning and participating in public hearings, property owners may initiate special assessment districting for subdivision street improvements.

Members of the three-member Board of County Road Commissioners are appointed for staggered six-year terms by the elected Board of County Commissioners. A full-time Managing Director and a County Highway Engineer are appointed by the Road Commissioners. The Road Commission employs 472 persons, more than half of whom are hourly rated and perform maintenance functions.

Citizen complaints and requests for information are given special attention by the Road Commission's Office of Citizen Services. That office may be reached between 8 a.m. and 4:45 p.m. weekdays by dialing 858-4804.

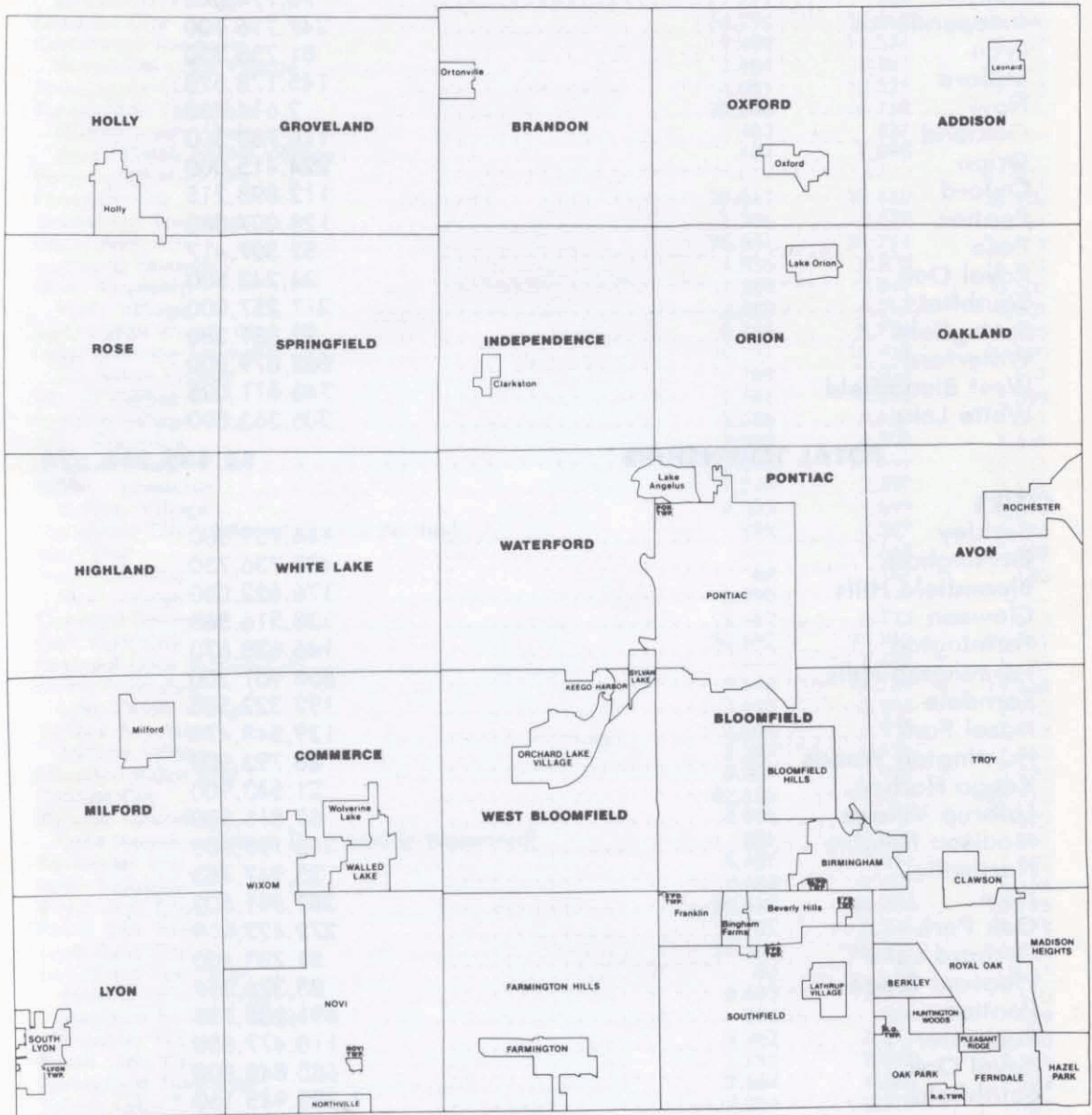

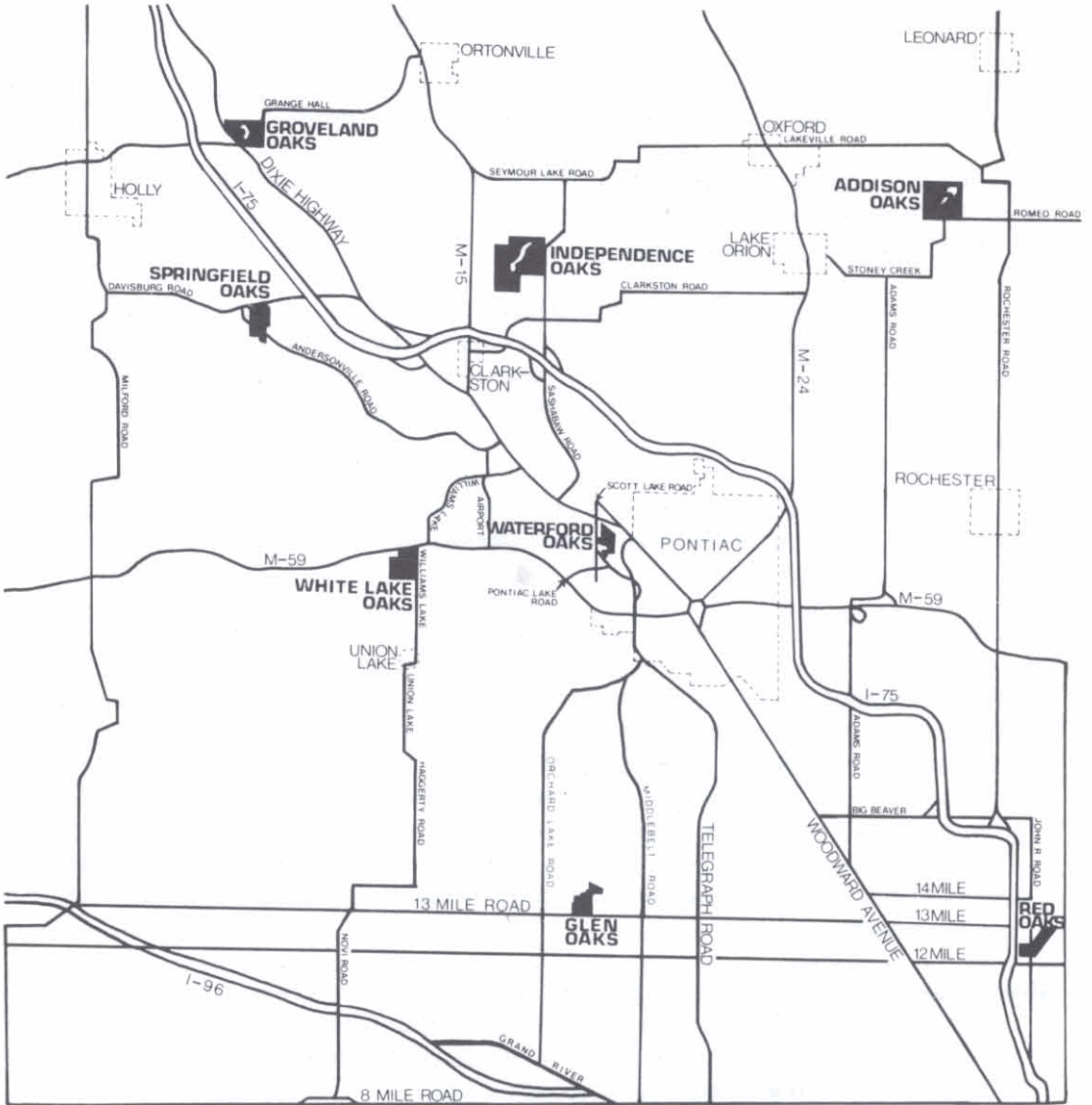

OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION

In 16 years, the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission has experienced phenomenal growth and introduced innovative forms of recreation to the people of Oakland County.

In 1980 alone, more than one million people visited the Oakland County Parks, more than the total population of the county. By the end of 1982, that figure is expected to reach one-and-one-quarter million.

Throughout the years, the residents of Oakland County have supported the park system, renewing a one-quarter mill tax every five years.

Since 1966, more than 3,700 acres of land have been acquired by the county parks with assistance from state and federal governments.

There are now nine Oakland County Parks providing year-round recreational opportunities including camping, boating, swimming, fishing, golf, picnicking, nature study, mobile recreation and winter sports.

The Oakland County Parks have also been a leader in innovative leisure facilities and programs, including Michigan's only wave-action pool, a giant, double water slide, the country's first year-round, dome-covered driving range, therapeutic recreation for the handicapped, a water coaster and a community mobile recreation fleet.

Future plans for the parks system include improved camping facilities and more active recreation opportunities at several parks including Red Oaks in the southeast part of the County.

The Oakland County Parks and Recreation system includes:

Addison Oaks: Located on 700 acres of wooded land surrounding three, spring-fed ponds. Activities include swimming, fishing, boating, camping, picnicking, snowmobiling and ice skating. In 1983, 50 primitive campsites and 50 modern campsites with water and electricity will open. Also located at the park is the Conference Center, for business and social gatherings of all types, including formal garden weddings. A heated swimming pool adjacent to the Center can accommodate up to 80 persons. Situated along West Romeo Road, 12 miles north of Rochester.

Glen Oaks: An 18-hole, par 70 golf course. The 137-acre site also features a newly-renovated clubhouse with banquet facilities and lounge. Cross country skiing is available during winter months. Located on 13 Mile Road between Middlebelt and Orchard Lake Roads in Farmington Hills.

Groveland Oaks: The 200 acres of park land on Stewart Lake provide Groveland Oaks a natural setting for camping and other recreation activities. The park features 600 sites for recreational vehicles and tent campers, which includes 20 new, modern campsites to open in late fall, 1982. Other activities include swimming, fishing, boating, picnicking and nature study. The beach features a 63-foot Rampage Water Coaster. Located off Dixie Highway at Grange Hall Road in northwest Oakland County.

Independence Oaks: This 830-acre site retains its natural setting, yet offers year around recreation. Activities include boating and fishing on 68-acre Crooked Lake, swimming, picnicking, hiking, nature study, cross country skiing and other winter sports. The park features a boathouse and picturesque Twin Chimneys shelter overlooking the lake. Year-round nature interpretive programs are conducted by the parks naturalist. Located on Sashabaw Road, two miles north of I-75.

Orion Oaks: The newest and largest addition to the parks system with some 927 acres located in Orion Township in north Oakland County. Previously owned by the Chrysler Corporation, the county acquisition was part of a 2,400-acre parcel acquired by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. The county site contains 91-acre Lake Sixteen. At present, no plans have been made to develop the park but it may provide such activities as camping, boating, fishing, picnicking and winter sports including cross country skiing.

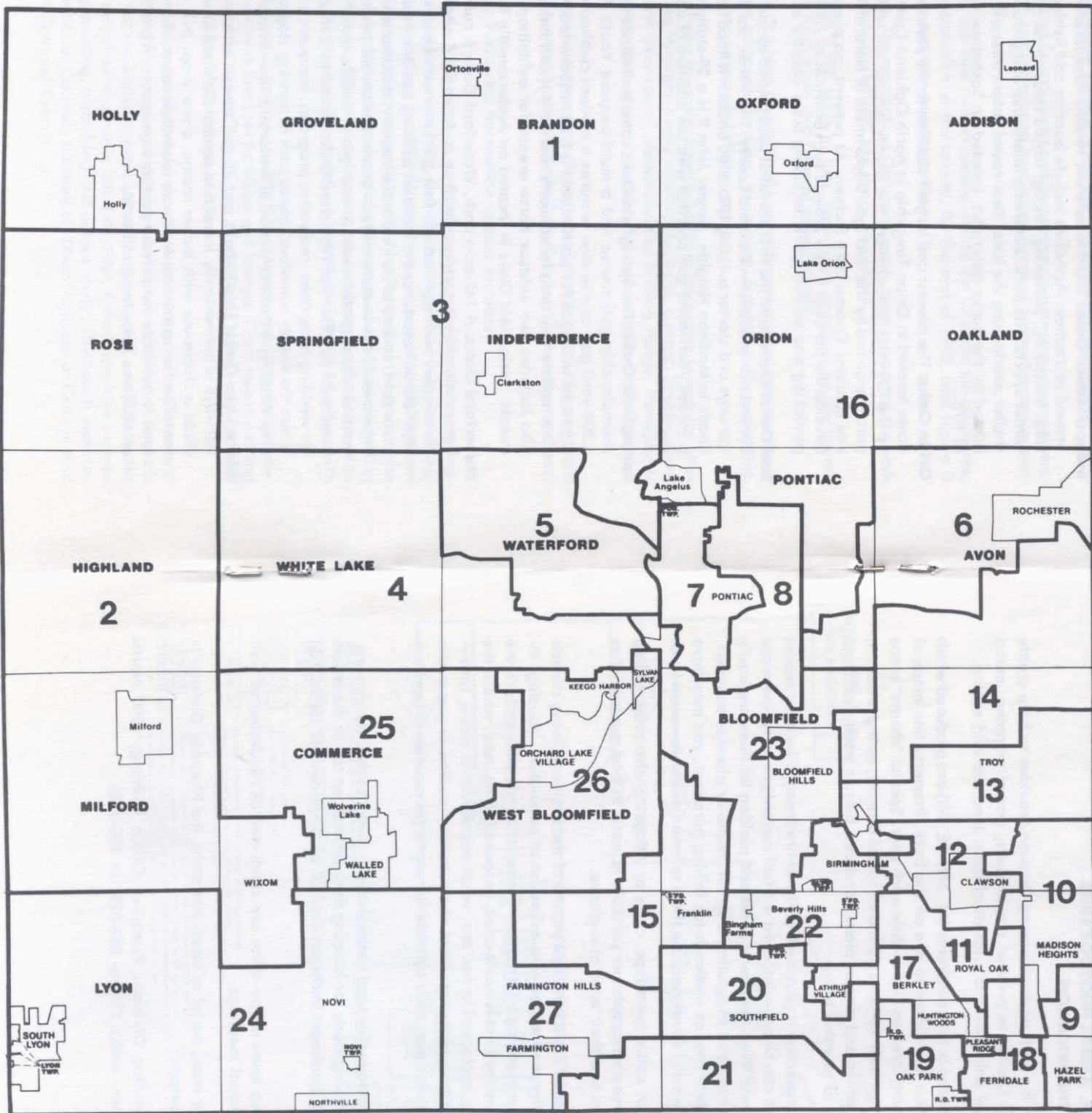
Red Oaks: Represents the first parcel of land owned by the Parks and Recreation Commission in Southern Oakland County. The 9-hole, par 35 course with watered fairways and starter building is located on John R Road between 12 and 13 Mile Roads in Madison Heights. Across John R is a 39-station driving range which provides year-round golf practice with the addition of an inflatable dome during the colder months.

Springfield Oaks: The Springfield Oaks complex includes a challenging 18-hole championship golf course and a multi-purpose Youth Activities Center. The 6,300-yard golf course also features a modern clubhouse, pro shop, and dining room available for parties with a 3,000-square-foot hall. There is also an 8,400-square-foot area for concerts, shows, 4-H and similar activities. The park also includes two outdoor horse arenas for exhibitions, rodeos and special events. Springfield Oaks is located on Andersonville Road in Davisburg.

Waterford Oaks: A 145-acre park, Waterford Oaks is currently the site for the Commission headquarters as well as an Activities Center Building. A new tennis complex with eight courts, four platform tennis courts, horseshoe pits and shuffleboard courts, and a facilities building has been recently completed. The wave pool, second of its kind in the country, automatically creates gently rolling waves for swimmers and can accommodate 600 people in the pool and 600 more on the carpeted deck. A new, giant, double water slide will open at the wave pool in 1982. The Waterford Oaks Activities Center is a popular facility for wedding receptions, recreation programs, banquets and parties. The Center is also the site for numerous classes such as dancing, dog obedience and creative arts. Waterford Oaks is located in Waterford Township on Watkins Lake Road.

White Lake Oaks: This 18-hole, par-70 golf course with its watered greens and fairways is conveniently located in central Oakland County. The facilities include a clubhouse with locker rooms, a pro shop, pull and electric golf cart rental and a restaurant. A private room that can accommodate up to 250 persons is available for private parties on request. White Lake Oaks is located on Williams Lake Road off M-59.

WHERE TO GET MAPS, AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS AND DEVELOPMENT INFORMATION

Among the services the staff of the Planning Division provides to help create a climate for Oakland County to prosper are property parcel mapping, aerial photography and aerial enlargements, statistical data, land use and zoning.

Street-Index maps printed in four quadrants (NE, NW, SE, SW) are produced which include local information and places to see on the back. Property line maps of every parcel in the County are kept up-to-date each year. Special "theme" maps are also produced to show such topics as zip codes, school districts, voting precincts, population densities, zoning and master plans, land use, bicycle trails, farmland and natural resources to mention a few.

Aerial photographic coverage is provided for the entire county (the most recent being 1981). The aerials can be superimposed with all current property line maps enlarged to a scale where even telephone poles and parking lot lines are easily visible. If you are ever in need of locating a street, home or place of business, aerial view of an accident site, or wetlands for fishing purposes, you may have use for an aerial. Realtors and developers use them to locate available vacant land.

Aerial photography of entire townships, cities or villages is also produced up to almost any scale. These photographs are particularly useful to local municipalities and realtors needing to see their area at-a-glance.

Another service to round out a complete picture of the business/living climate in Oakland County is the preparation and collection of population, housing, income, school, land use and zoning information. Consultation to public and private agencies/people on how the land is being used, proposed to be used, where the wetlands and sensitive ecological areas are, what population is doing (growing/moving/shifting), ethnic make up, level of education, median or per capita incomes, where the sewers are, soils suitable for septic (to mention a few) are also provided.

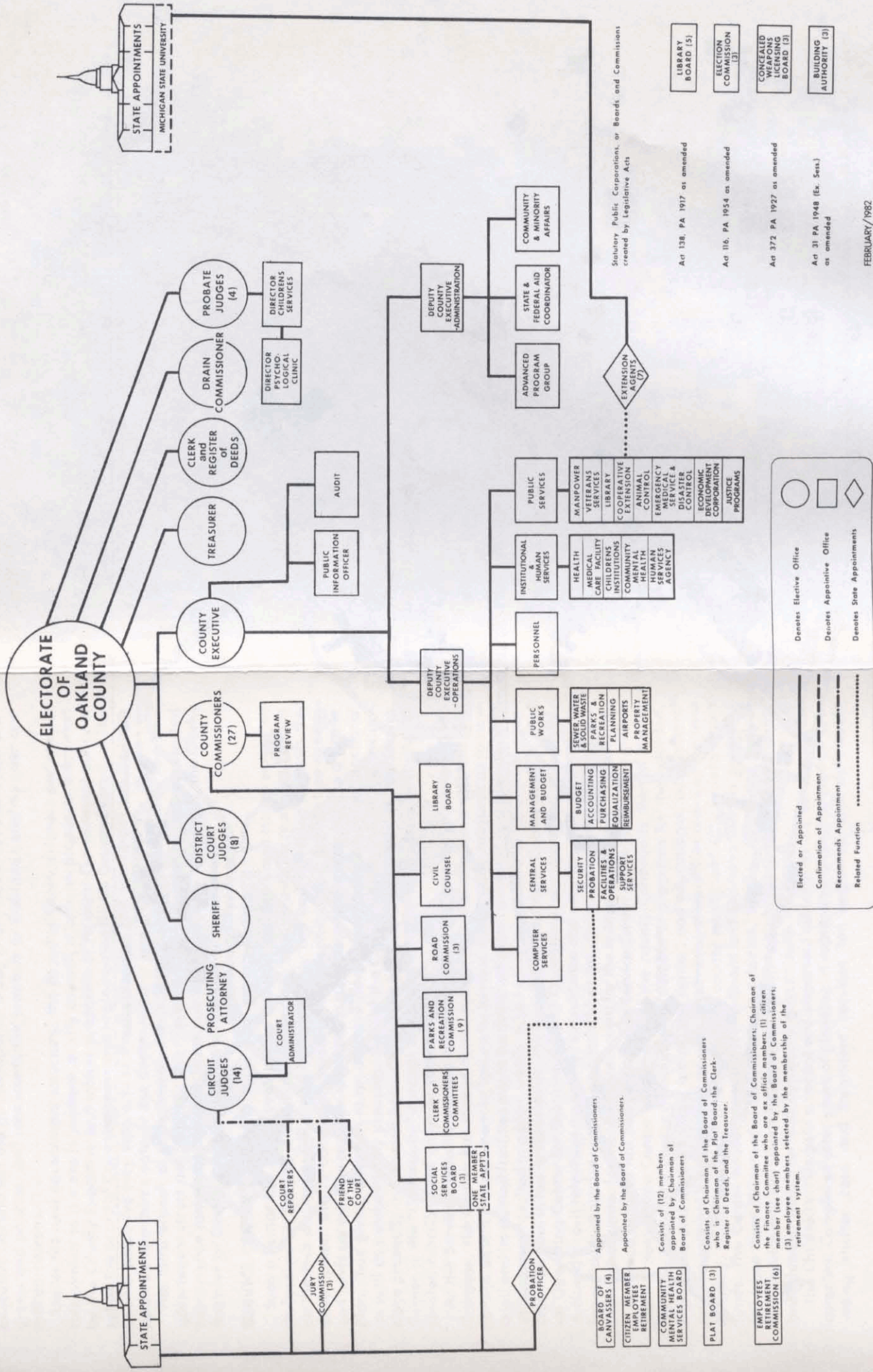
The Planning Division also assists local communities to revitalize their downtowns, plans for a park or a parking study, or keeping their officials on top of the issues and actions before the Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG) General Assembly.

School and civic group tours of the office are conducted as requested as well as attendance at municipal meetings.

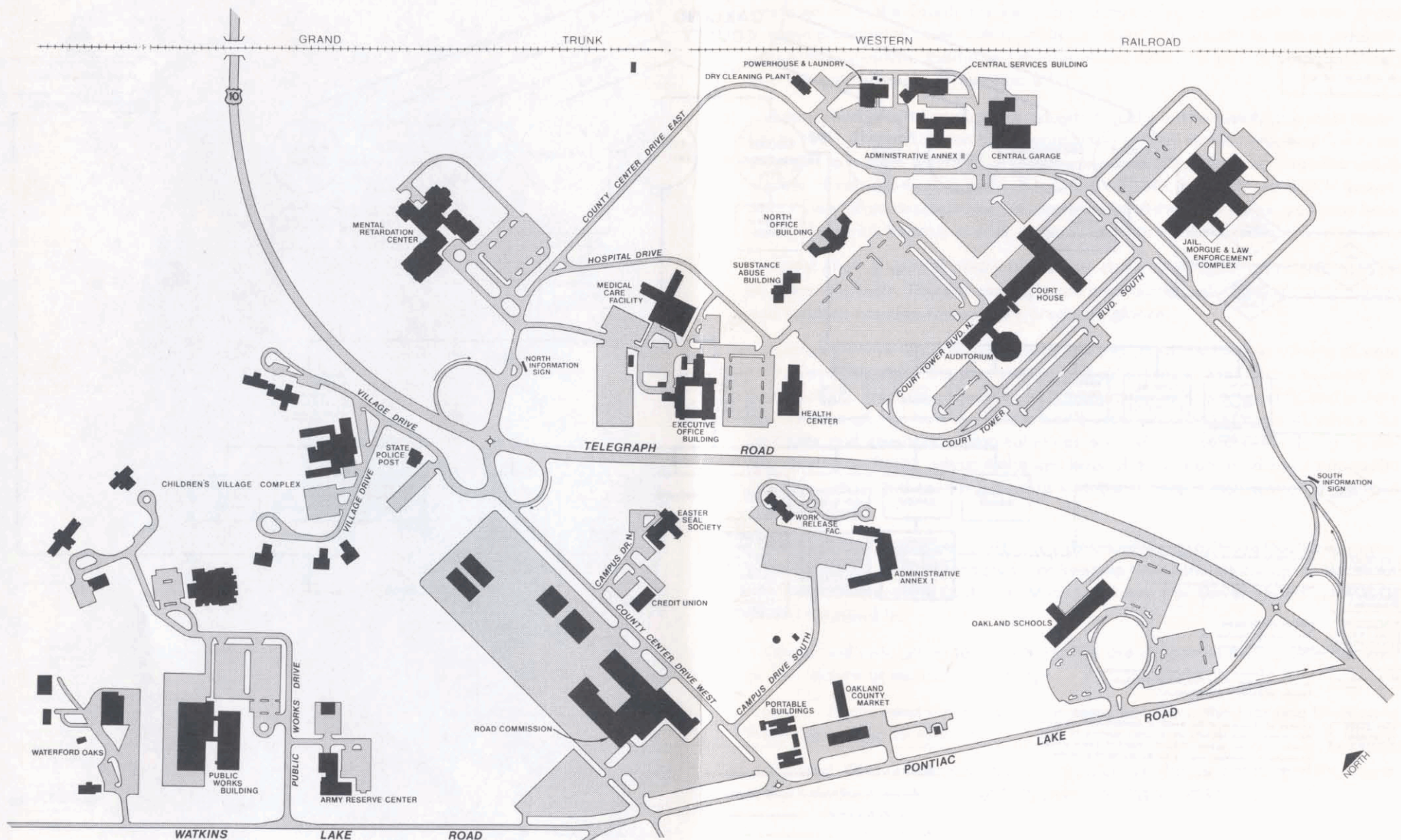

OAKLAND COUNTY NEW GOVERNMENT

In August of 1974, Oakland's citizens voted to create the first unified form of county government in the history of Michigan. Less than 60 such governments exist across the nation.

The new government is headed by an elected County Executive, whose responsibilities are similar to those of a governor or the mayor of a large city. The County Executive administers the government on a day to day basis, proposes new programs and policies, and represents the interests of Oakland's slightly over one million citizens.

Under the new government structure, the Board of Commissioners performs a role similar to a state legislature or city council. It acts on proposals submitted by the County Executive and makes proposals of its own. Government policy is set by the Board of Commissioners and implemented by the County Executive. The County Executive may veto acts of the Commission and the vetoes can be overridden by two-thirds vote of the Commission.

The third branch of government, the judiciary, was not changed by the new government structure. Similarly, the five other offices headed by officials elected county-wide remain unchanged. These are the Prosecutor, the Sheriff, the Clerk-Register of Deeds, the Treasurer, and the Drain Commissioner.

SERVICE CENTER COMPLEX

Such a center has been developed in Oakland and the Court House serves as its focal point. The Service Center Complex is located on a 450 acre site and serves as the hub of County Government. The County has been working towards the development of this complex by systematically constructing facilities as needed and funds permit. The complex is laid out in a spacious setting according to a master plan, thus giving direction to an ultimate development which will be functional as well as aesthetically pleasing. Most of the County's departments and institutions presently are housed here. One of the principles designed into the Service Center is the "Community" concept of campus development whereby similar or related functions are grouped together.

At the Service Center is the Law Enforcement - Jail Complex. In designing the Complex, the County has looked to the future in anticipating an expanded role for the Sheriff's Department in law enforcement. Nationwide research as to how a jail and its related facilities might be designed to be functional and operationally efficient has resulted in a plan, which, might serve as a model for other local agencies who deal in law enforcement. The Sheriff's Department, County Morgue, and an Operating Center for Disaster Control Operations are under the same roof. A closed circuit television system for surveillance and security, a crime laboratory to provide technical assistance on a local basis for crime solving, and a communication control center for the law enforcement for the entire County are in the building.

A second complex has been built on the Service Center grounds. The \$2.4 million Mental Retardation Center is operated by the county Community Mental Health Services Board. The Center consolidates a number of programs for the retarded. Diagnostic and testing rooms, a day care center, and educational, occupational and recreational training areas, as well as administrative offices make up the new building, which was constructed with 60% county money and 40% Federal grant funds. The Center housed Mental Health Board and Oakland Schools programs for more than 350 retarded individuals, in addition, the Counseling and Evaluation Service will see about 700 persons a year. It is unique in Michigan in having been funded well over half by county government.

The Children's Village is a recent and important addition to the Service Center complex. Completed after years of planning, it represents a new concept for providing shelter care and treatment services for neglected and delinquent

wards of the Court. Situated on fifty acres in the Service Center, it consists of small units which provides an opportunity to deal with individual problems of youth. The Village affords a home-like atmosphere to the troubled children coming to the attention of the Court. It is a model which evokes considerable favorable reaction from visitors and Judges from throughout the State and other areas of the country.

Oakland's leaders believe that local government ought to be as close and convenient to its citizenry as possible. In Oakland, this implies need for geographical decentralization of certain functions. The County's long range planning calls for this to take the form of development of a series of satellite Service Centers. Located in these centers will be departmental branch offices. Like the parent Service Center, they will be arranged in a campus type development.

Oakland's officials are proud of the County Court House Complex and its related facilities. Visitors from other counties, state and nations have found and will continue to find themselves most welcome.

OAKLAND COUNTY COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Most people have emotional problems from time to time — depression, anger, anxiety — and these problems can get out of hand. Sometimes they can begin to interfere with a person's whole life, especially relationships with family, friends or co-workers.

Oakland County's Community Mental Health Services, a division of County government, can help with these problems. There are five major outpatient clinics operated by Community Mental Health for adults and children with emotional troubles. The clinics are staffed with psychologists, psychiatrists and social workers who offer individual and group counseling, and there are outreach offices to make services available to all parts of Oakland County.

Fees are on a sliding scale, based on the client's ability to pay, and Community Mental Health clinics are approved for Blue Cross. The clinics are part of an \$8½ million program directed by the Oakland County Community Mental Health Services Board, whose members are appointed by the County Board of Commissioners, and funding for the program comes from the County and State of Michigan. The total program also includes outpatient diagnostic and counseling services for developmentally disabled people; day programs for mentally ill and mentally retarded adults, and emotionally disturbed children; continuing treatment services for chronically mentally ill adults, particularly those who have been hospitalized; various specialized residential treatment programs; and mental health educational services to the public.

Most Community Mental Health programs are open Monday-Friday during day and early evening hours. At night and on weekends and holidays there is an Emergency Service for all Oakland County residents at Common Ground in Birmingham. Their help is available by phone or on a walk-in basis.

If you or someone you know, an adult or child, may need professional mental health services, we are ready to help any way we can. Community Mental Health programs are supported by your tax dollars, for the benefit of all Oakland County.

For information or referral, just call this central number: 858-1234. At nights and on weekends, emergency help is available by calling 645-9676. Administrative offices are located at 1200 North Telegraph, Pontiac 48053 in the Oakland County Service Center complex.
