FRONT COVER:

In 1901 a tramp is injured on railroad tracks. There is no hospital available for a stranger to receive medical care in Oakland County. Mrs. Harry Coleman and Mrs. Charles H. Going form the Oakland County Hospital Association to coordinate fundraising for a hospital. Nine years of hard work and dedication lead to opening ceremonies, on May 18, 1910, of the Oakland County Hospital — fondly known in those days as the Old Women's Hospital.

In 1915 the City of Pontiac begins management of the Oakland County Hospital on July 1 and changes the name to Pontiac City Hospital.

In 1931 the addition of a new wing facing Johnson Street is heralded by a name change to Pontiac General Hospital, as we know it today.

OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS



OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION

In 23 years, the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission has experienced phenomenal growth and introduced innovative forms of recreation to the people of Oakland County.

In 1980, more than 1.3 million people visited the Oakland County Parks, more than the total population of the county. By the end of 1989, that figure is expected to reach 1.5 million.

Throughout the years, the residents of Oakland County have supported the park system, renewing a one-quarter mill tax every five years.

Since 1966, more than 4,000 acres of land have been acquired by the county parks with assistance from state and federal governments.

There are now nine Oakland County Parks providing year-round recreational opportunities including camping, boating, swimming, fishing, golf, picnicking, nature study, mobile recreation and winter sports.

The Oakland County Parks have also been a leader in innovative leisure facilities and programs, including two wave-action swimming pools, giant water slides, the country's first year-round, dome-covered driving range, a nature interpretive center, therapeutic recreation for the handicapped, and a community mobile recreation fleet.

Future plans for the parks system include the development of Orion Oaks as an outdoor-oriented, universally-designed park providing year-round programmed recreational and educational opportunities for persons of all abilities and disabilities.

In 1983, the Oakland Parks Foundation was created by a group of private citizens who have an interest in preserving and enhancing parks and recreational opportunities in Oakland County. The non-profit foundation accepts gifts and donations in the form of grants, cash, trusts, land and other bequests to assist the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission in carrying out its goals.

The Oakland County Parks and Recreation system includes:

Addison Oaks: Located on 700 acres of wooded land surrounding three, spring-fed ponds. Activities include swimming, fishing, boating, camping, picnicking, cross-country skiing and ice skating. Primitive and modern campsites with water and electricity are available. Also located at the park is the Conference Center for business and social gatherings of all types, including formal garden weddings. A botanical garden is also proposed. Situated along West Romeo Road, 9 miles north of Rochester. (Phone 693-2432).

Glen Oaks: An 18-hole, par 70 golf course. The 137-acre site also features a newly-renovated clubhouse with banquet facilities and lounge. Cross-country skiing is available during winter months. Located on 13 Mile Road between Middlebelt and Orchard Lake Roads in Farmington Hills. (Phone 851-8356).

Groveland Oaks: The 362 acres of park land on Stewart Lake provide Groveland Oaks a natural setting for camping and other recreation activities. The park features 600 sites for recreational vehicles and tent campers. Other activities include swimming, a waterslide, fishing, boating, picnicking and nature study. Located off Dixie Highway at Grange Hall Road in northwest Oakland County. (Phone 634-9811).

Independence Oaks: This 1,062-acre site retains its natural setting, yet offers year-round recreation. Activities include boating and fishing on 68-acre Crooked Lake, swimming, picnicking, hiking, nature study, cross-country skiing and other

winter sports. The park features a boathouse and picturesque Twin Chimneys shelter overlooking the lake. Year-round nature interpretive programs are conducted by the parks naturalists. A 4,000 square foot nature center offers exhibits and facilities for educational programs. The Cohn Amphitheater, made possible through the Oakland Parks Foundation, was dedicated in 1987. A new hard-surfaced All Visitor Trail has been added for use by the handicapped. Located on Sashabaw Road, two miles north of I-75. (Phone 625-0877).

Orion Oaks: In 1980, the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission acquired its ninth park, Orion Oaks. Designed for group use, the park will provide overnight accommodations for youth, senior citizens, the disabled, and community organizations. Facilities will include a lodge and group cabins, dining areas, meeting space, a multipurpose hall, and an indoor swimming pool. There will be opportunities for public use of the park for programmed classes, special events and meetings.

Red Oaks: The newest and most exciting addition in Madison Heights is the Waterpark with a Wave-Action swimming pool and three-flume waterslide. The pool creates three-foot waves in eight patterns while the three slides offer rides on water through loops and turns. The waterpark also features a large deck and lawn area for sunbathing, picnic facilities, a bath house and concession building. The 9-hole, par 35 golf course with watered fairways and starter building is located on John R Road between 12 and 13 Mile Roads in Madison Heights. Across John R is a 39-station driving range which provides year-round golf practice under an inflatable dome. (Phone 541-5030 for the Golf Course, 548-1857 for the Driving Range or 585-6990 for the Waterpark).

Springfield Oaks: The Springfield Oaks complex includes a challenging 18-hole championship golf course and a multi-purpose Youth Activities Center available for banquets, receptions, concerts, shows, 4-H and indoor sports. The park also includes two outdoor horse arenas for exhibitions, rodeos and special events. Springfield Oaks is located on Andersonville Road in Davisburg. (Phone 625-8133 Activities Center or 625-2540 Golf Course).

Waterford Oaks: A 145-acre park, Waterford Oaks is currently the site of the Commission headquarters as well as an Activities Center Building. A tennis complex with eight courts, horseshoe pits, beach volley ball, shuffleboard courts, and a facilities building has been recently completed. The wave pool, second of its kind in the country, automatically creates gently rolling waves for swimmers and can accommodate 600 people in the pool and 600 more on the carpeted deck. A giant double waterslide opened at the wave pool in 1982. The Waterford Oaks Activities Center is a popular facility for wedding receptions, recreation programs, banquets and parties. The Center is also the site for numerous classes such as dancing, dog obedience and creative arts. Waterford Oaks is located in Waterford Township on Watkins Lake Road. (Phone 858-0913 Activity Center, 858-0906 Administrative Offices).

White Lake Oaks: This 18-hole, par-70 golf course with its watered greens and fairways is conveniently located in central Oakland County. The facilities include a clubhouse with locker rooms, a pro shop, pull and electric golf cart rental and a restaurant. A private room that can accommodate up to 250 persons is available for private parties. White Lake Oaks is located on South Williams Lake Road off M-59, near Pontiac. (Phone 698-2700).

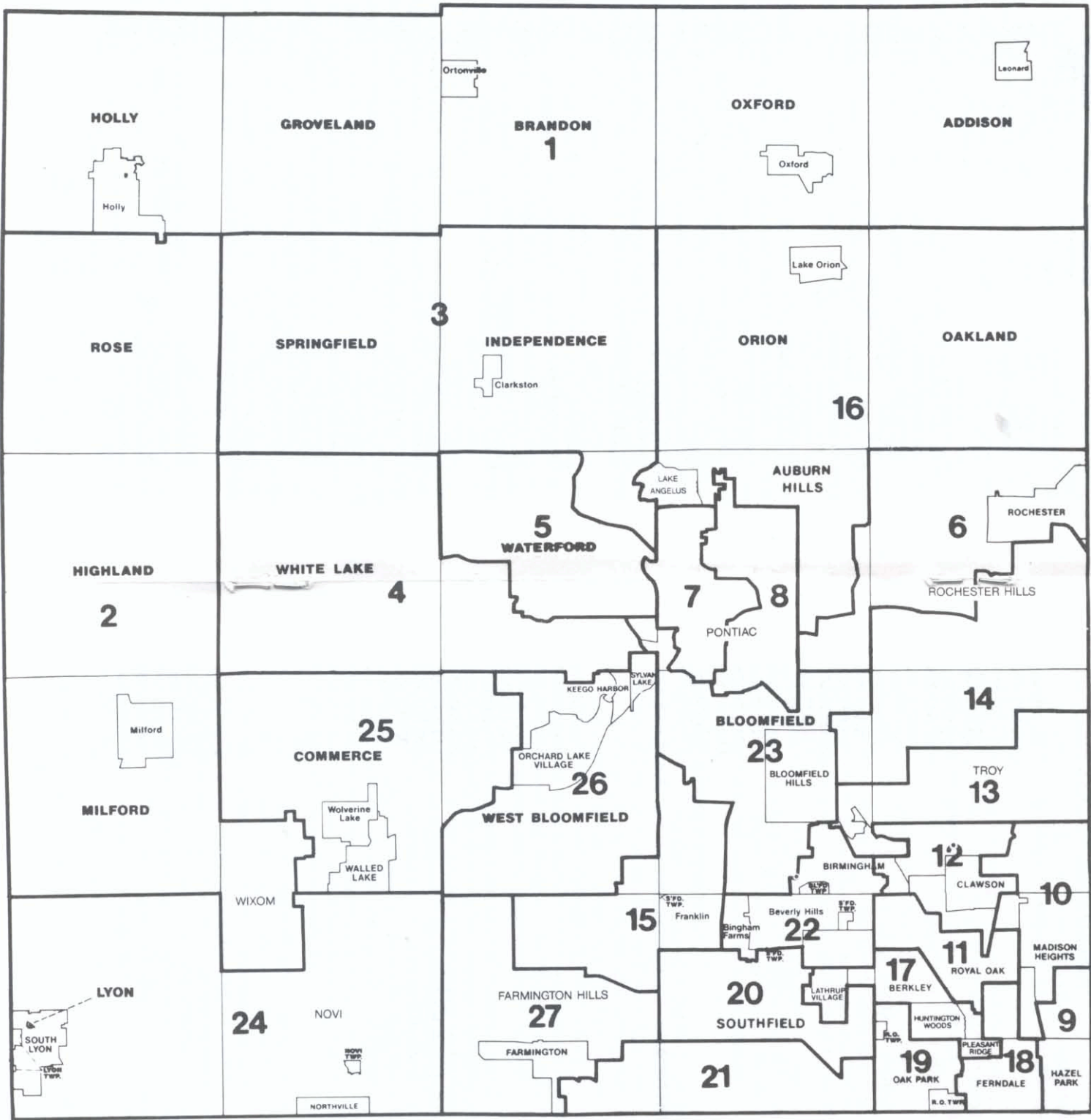

OAKLAND COUNTY GOVERNMENT

In August of 1974, Oakland's citizens voted to create the first unified form of county government in the history of Michigan. Less than 60 such governments exist across the nation.

The government is headed by an elected County Executive, whose responsibilities are similar to those of a governor or the mayor of a large city. The County Executive administers the government on a day to day basis, proposes new programs and policies, and represents the interests of Oakland's slightly over one million citizens.

Under this structure, the Board of Commissioners performs a role similar to a state legislature or city council. It acts on proposals submitted by the County Executive and makes proposals of its own. Government policy is set by the Board of Commissioners and implemented by the County Executive. The County Executive may veto acts of the Commission and the vetoes can be overridden by two-thirds vote of the Commission.

The third branch of government, the judiciary, was not changed by the executive form of government. Similarly, the five other offices headed by officials elected county-wide remain unchanged. These are the Prosecutor, the Sheriff, the Clerk-Register of Deeds, the Treasurer, and the Drain Commissioner.

SERVICE CENTER COMPLEX

Such a center has been developed in Oakland and the Court House serves as its focal point. The Service Center Complex is located on a 450 acre site and serves as the hub of County Government. The County has been working towards the development of this complex by systematically constructing facilities as needed and funds permit. The complex is laid out in a spacious setting according to a master plan, thus giving direction to an ultimate development which will be functional as well as aesthetically pleasing. Most of the County's departments and institutions presently are housed here. One of the principles designed into the Service Center is the "Community" concept of campus development whereby similar or related functions are grouped together.

At the Service Center is the Law Enforcement - Jail Complex. In designing the Complex, the County has looked to the future in anticipating an expanded role for Sheriff's Department in law enforcement. Nationwide research as to how a jail and its related facilities might be designed to be functional and operationally efficient has resulted in a plan, which, might serve as a model for other local agencies who deal in law enforcement. The Sheriff's Department, County Morgue, and an Operating Center for Disaster Control Operations are under the same roof. A closed circuit television system for surveillance and security, a crime laboratory to provide technical assistance on a local basis for crime solving, and a communication control center for the law enforcement for the entire County are in the building.

A second complex has been built on the Service Center grounds. The Oakland Community Mental Health Center is operated by the county Community Health Services Board. The Center consolidates a number of programs for the retarded. Diagnostic and testing rooms, a day care center; and educational, occupational and recreational training areas, as well as administrative offices make up the new building, which was constructed with 60% county money and 40% Federal grant funds. The Center houses Community Mental Health Service programs for more than 120 retarded individuals, in addition, the Counseling and Evaluation Service sees about 450 persons a year. It is unique in Michigan in having been funded well over half by county government.

The Children's Village also is on the Service Center grounds. It provides shelter, care and treatment services for neglected and delinquent wards of the Court.

Situated on fifty acres in the Service Center, it consists of small units which provides an opportunity to deal with individual problems of youth. The Village affords a home-like atmosphere to the troubled children coming to the attention of the Court. It is a model which evokes considerable favorable reaction from visitors and Judges from throughout the State and other areas of the country.

Oakland's officials are proud of the County Court House Complex and its related facilities. Visitors from other counties, states and nations have found and will continue to find themselves most welcome.

OAKLAND COUNTY COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Most people have emotional problems from time to time — depression, anger, anxiety — and these problems can get out of hand. Sometimes they can begin to interfere with a person's whole life, especially relationships with family, friends or co-workers.

Oakland County's Community Mental Health Services, a division of County government, can help with these problems. There are five major outpatient clinics operated by Community Mental Health for adults and children with emotional troubles. The clinics are staffed with psychologists, psychiatrists and social workers who offer individual and group counseling, and there are outreach offices to make services available to all parts of Oakland County.

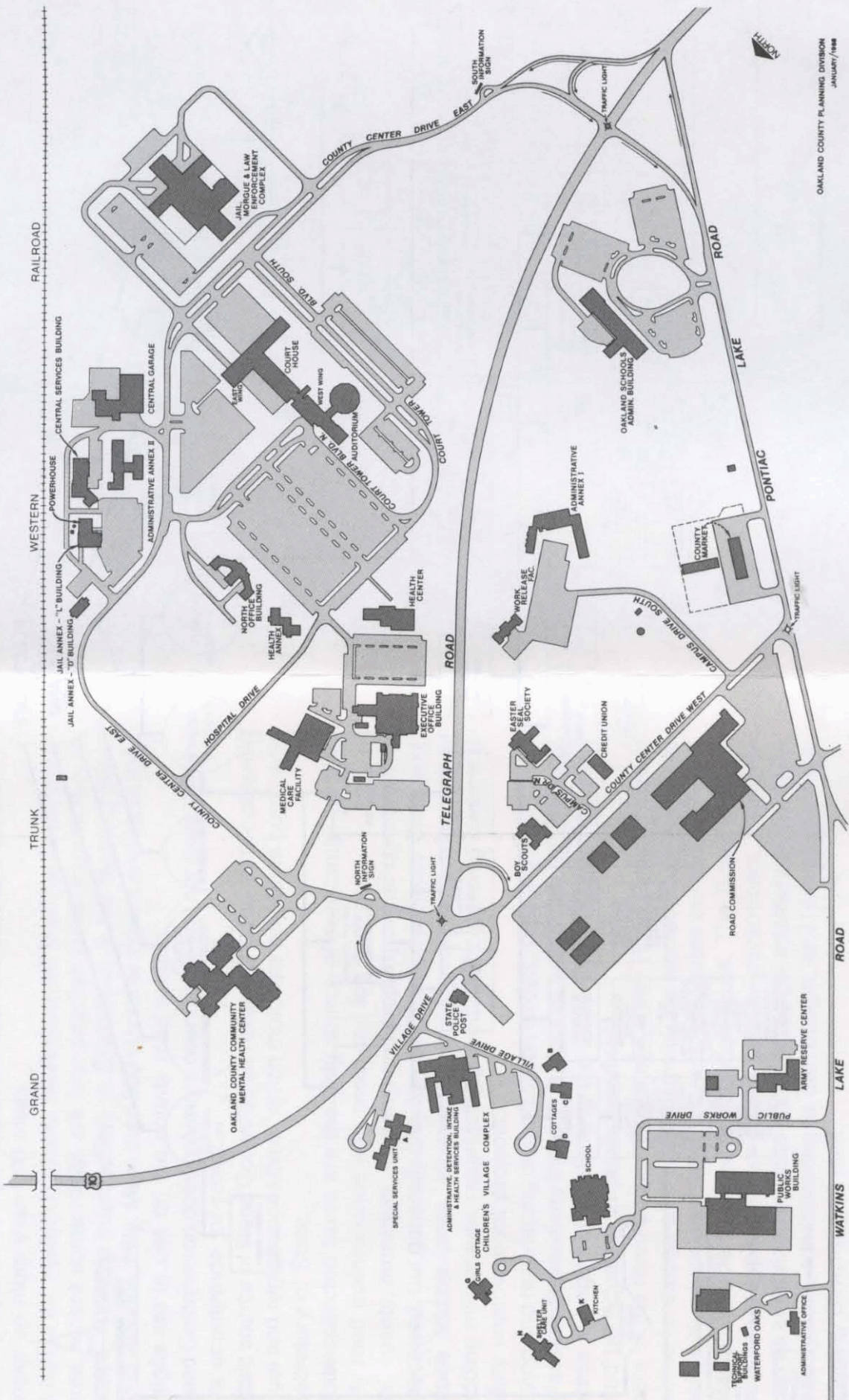
Fees are on a sliding scale, based on the client's ability to pay, and Community Mental Health clinics are approved for Blue Cross. The clinics are part of a \$9.2 million program directed by the Oakland County Community Mental Health Services Board, whose members are appointed by the County Board of Commissioners, and funding for the program comes from the County and State of Michigan. The total program also includes outpatient diagnostic and counseling services for developmentally disabled people; day programs for mentally ill and mentally retarded adults, and emotionally disturbed children; continuing treatment services for chronically mentally ill adults, particularly those who have been hospitalized; various specialized residential treatment programs; and mental health educational services to the public.

Most Community Mental Health programs are open Monday-Friday during day and early evening hours. At night and on weekends and holidays there is an Emergency Service for all Oakland County residents at Common Ground in Birmingham. Their help is available by phone or on a walk-in basis.

If you or someone you know, an adult or child, may need professional mental health services, we are ready to help any way we can. Community Mental Health programs are supported by your tax dollars, for the benefit of all Oakland County.

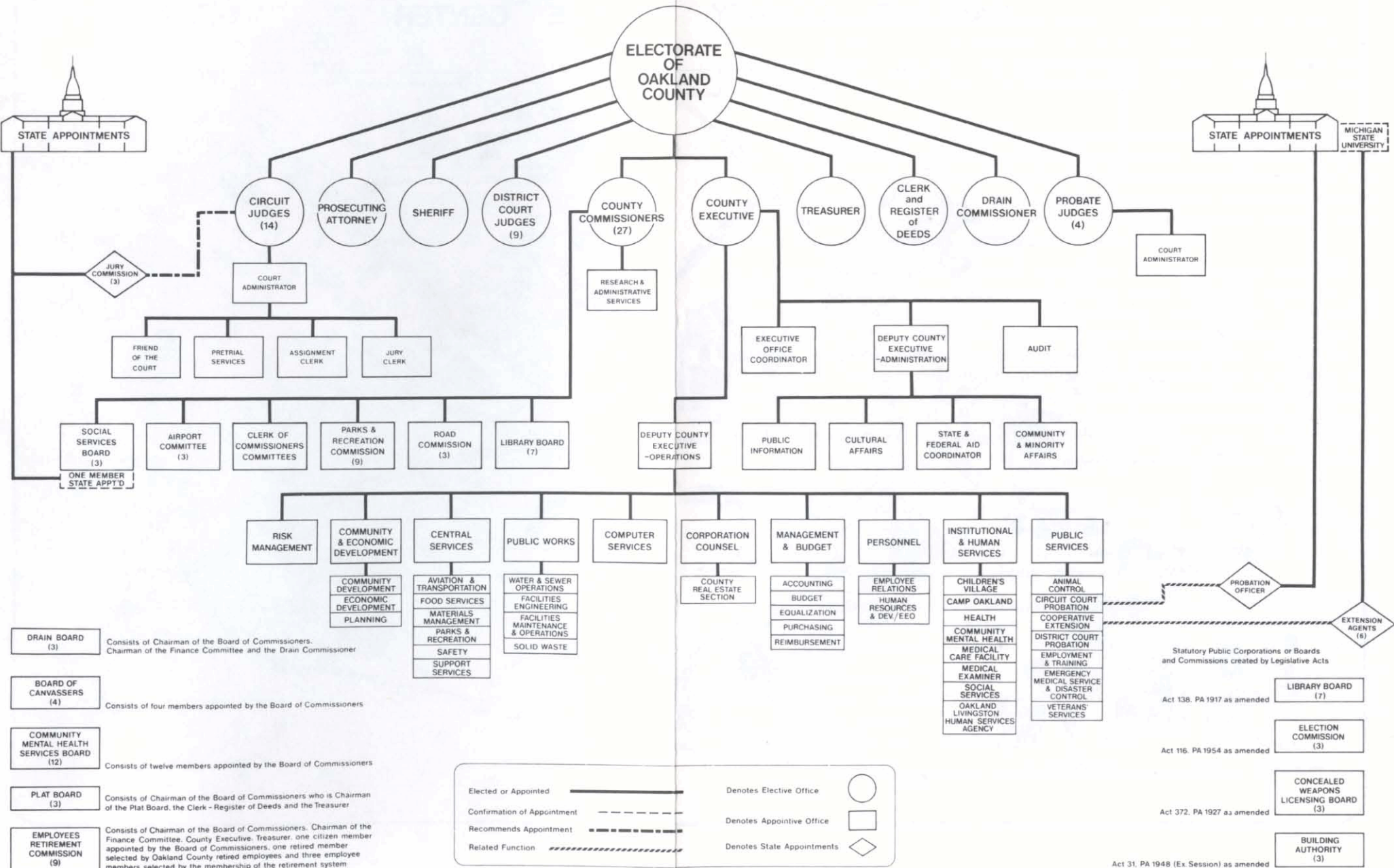

OAKLAND COUNTY ROADS

More than half of all highways, roads and streets in Oakland County are on the county system, which is under jurisdiction of the Board of Oakland County Road Commissioners.

The Road Commission is now in its 76th year of service to the people of Oakland County.

Totalling more than 2,400 miles, this system includes all public roads in townships and through streets in most cities and villages. It is the longest county system in Michigan. Its subdivision streets alone (all in townships) make up more than 900 miles.

About half of the system is paved. More than half is within the county's urban area, where some roads are four and five lanes wide to handle heavy traffic. A single intersection, in Southfield, is the meeting place for 100,000 vehicles daily. More than 900 electrical signals and more than 35,000 signs are in use on the county road system.

The Road Commission does not levy a countywide tax, nor does anyone levy a tax countywide for roads.

The basic source of Road Commission revenues is the state-collected vehicle fuel and registration taxes, which motorists pay at the pump and to the Secretary of State.

The state-collected taxes are the only source of substantial funding for county road maintenance and snow and ice control.

Federal, county, municipal, township and property owner contributions are also received, but generally only for specific road projects. Such projects include adding lanes, intersection improvements, paving gravel roads, adding new gravel, resurfacing paved roads, passing lanes and other safety improvement projects.

For paving and resurfacing of subdivision streets, property owners can specially assess themselves through a process prescribed by state law. The process is begun by contacting the Road Commission; then petitioning and participating in public hearings.

Members of the three-person Board of County Road Commissioners are appointed for staggered six-year terms by the elected Board of County Commissioners, which also sets their salary. Salaries are funded by the state-collected vehicle fuel and registration taxes. The Board of Road Commissioners is separate from county general government, establishing policies as authorized by state statutes for management of the countywide road system, administering its own budget, and hiring its own full-time Managing Director and staff.

Citizen complaints and requests for information are given special attention by the Road Commission's Department of Citizen Services. That office may be reached between 8 a.m. and 4:45 p.m. weekdays by dialing 858-4804.

WHERE TO GET MAPS, AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS AND DEVELOPMENT INFORMATION

If you are looking for property line maps, aerial photography or development data, the Oakland County Planning Division has what you need.

Property line maps of every parcel in Oakland County are kept up to date each year. Aerial photography is also provided for the entire county — the most recent being 1985. The aerials can be superimposed with the current property line maps or enlarged to a scale where even telephone poles or parking lot lines are easily visible. Realtors and developers use aerials to locate available vacant land. If you ever need an aerial view of a street, home, place of business or accident site, the Planning Division can provide you with a custom aerial enlargement.

Street-Index maps printed in four quadrants (NE, NW, SE, SW) are produced which include local information and places to see. Special "theme" maps are also available which show such topics as zip codes, school districts, voting precincts, population densities, zoning and master plans, sewers, land use, and natural resources, as well as lands already zoned industrial, commercial, office or multi-family but vacant. These are just a few of the many maps available.

In addition to maps, development data and statistics are also produced. Population, housing, income, land use, zoning and environmental data is prepared and collected. Planning staff are available to explain how the land is being used, where the wetlands and sensitive ecological areas are, soil conditions, population trends, ethnic makeup, median or per capita incomes and sewer locations.

The Planning Division also assists local communities to revitalize their downtowns or plan for a park. Local officials are kept on top of the issues and actions before the Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG) and the Southeast Michigan Transportation Authority (SEM-TA) by the Planning Division staff.

School and civic group tours of the office are conducted as requested. We are also available to make presentations on various planning topics or projects.
