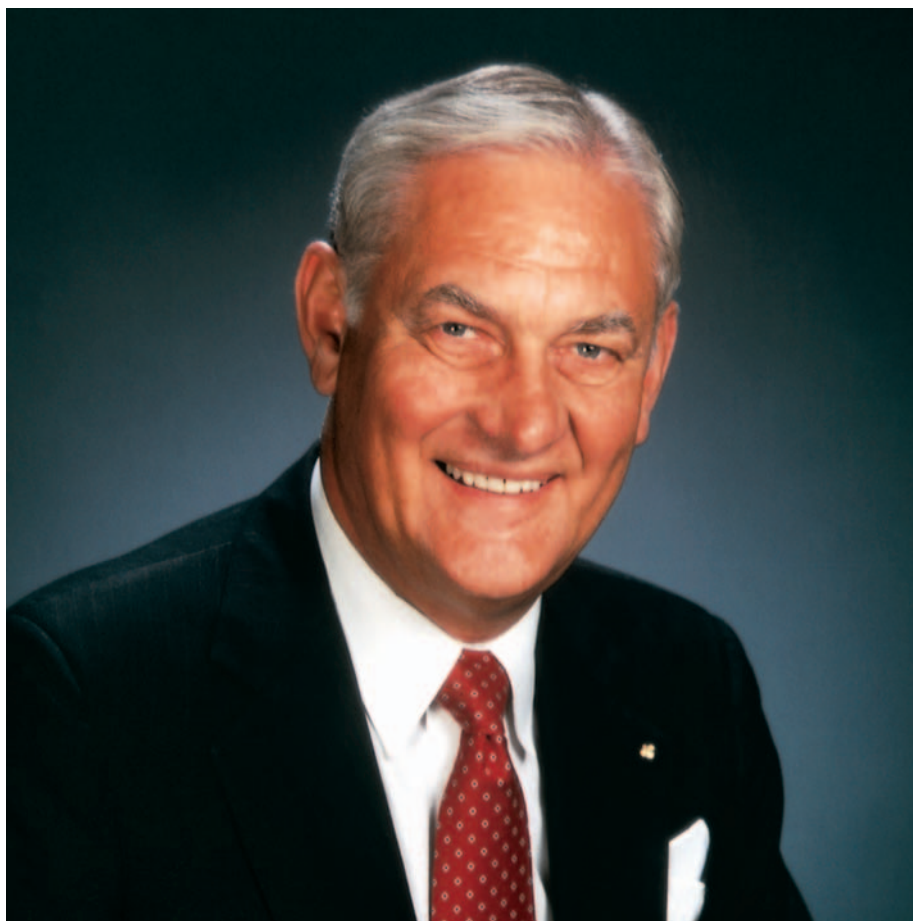

Oakland County lost a true visionary and pioneer with the passing of Daniel T. Murphy. Mr. Murphy began his career in Oakland County, which spanned 36 years, after serving in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was appointed Oakland County Register of Deeds in 1956 and was re-elected to that position in 1958 and 1962. In 1963, he was appointed Chairman of the Board of Auditors. In 1974, Mr. Murphy was elected Oakland County and Michigan's first County Executive and served with great honor and distinction until his retirement in 1992.

Dan Murphy carved a path through this new political wilderness, giving meaning and depth to the role of County Executive. His strong and determined leadership propelled Oakland County to new heights and expanded vistas. Mr. Murphy was a trailblazer who worked tirelessly to promote Oakland County's economic growth and unsurpassed quality of life. He often described Oakland County in mathematical terms, "30 by 30 is 900 miles, plus 400 lakes equals Oakland County, the most beautiful place on Earth."

Mr. Murphy left behind a proud and lasting legacy of achievement. He helped establish the "Big Four," the coalition of leaders of the City of Detroit and Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties. His leadership and vision also resulted in the establishment of the Oakland County parks system and the creation of the Southeast Michigan Council of Governments. In addition, he was instrumental in developing the 911 emergency telephone and tornado siren warning systems.

All of us who enjoy Oakland County's beauty and bounty owe Dan Murphy a sincere debt of gratitude for his many years of faithful service and for his inspired stewardship which has enabled this county to prosper, grow and attain true greatness. Dan was truly one of the founding fathers of Oakland County government.

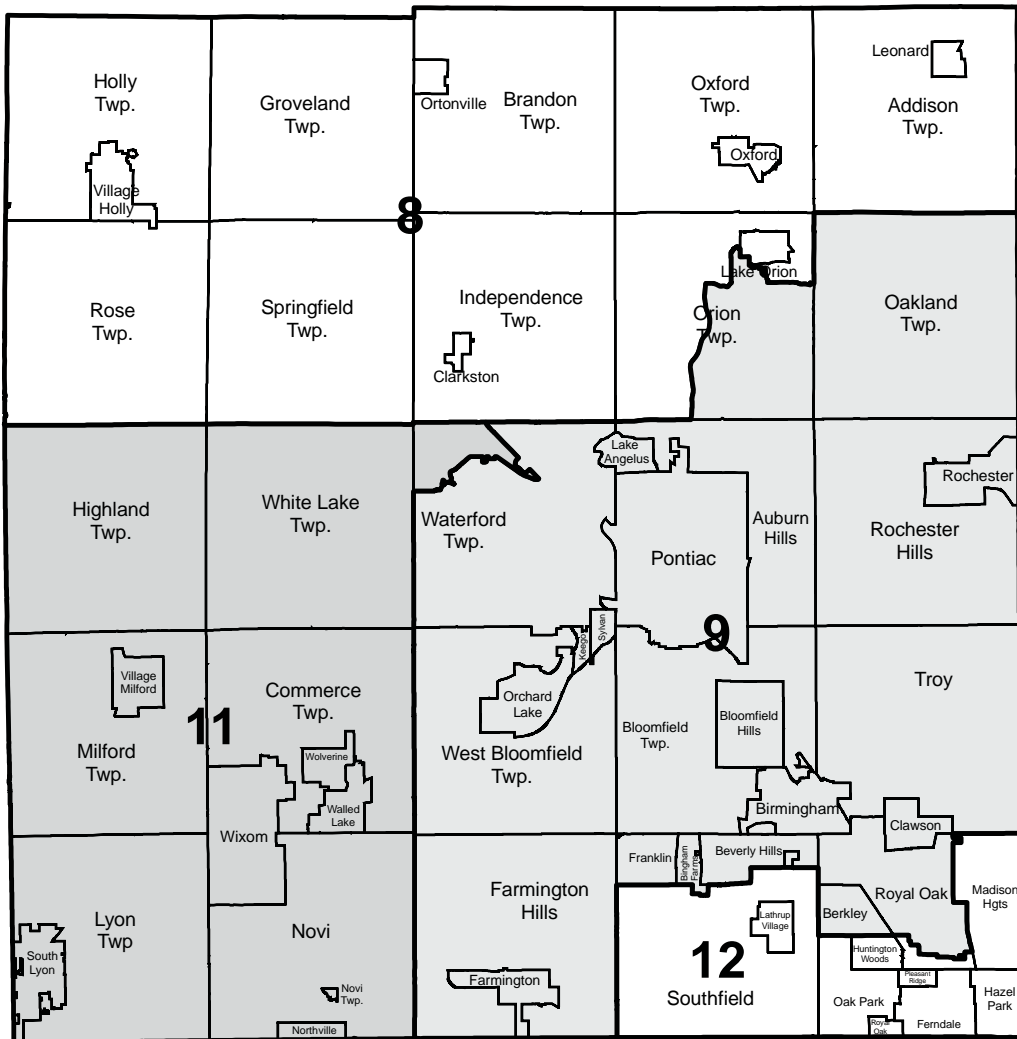

# U.S. CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS 2003-2012

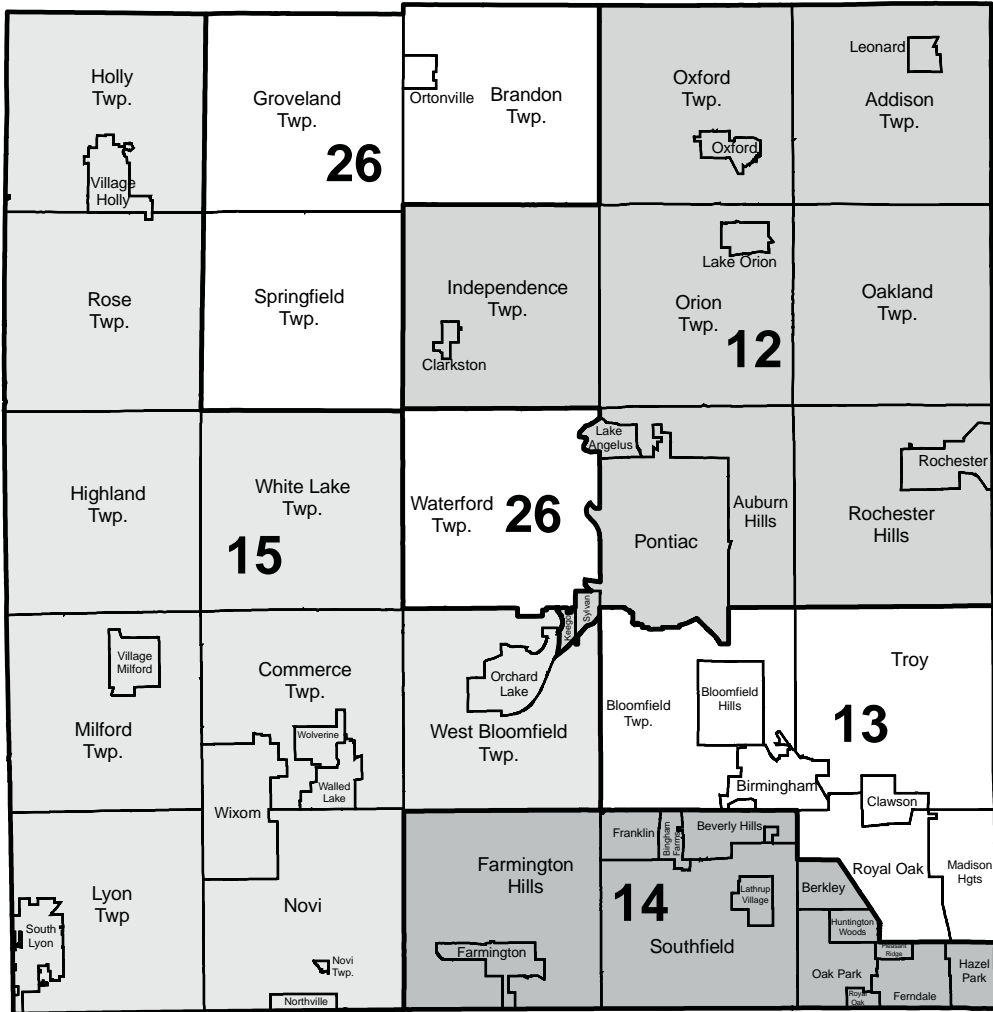

## **OAKLAND COUNTY GOVERNMENT**

In August of 1974, Oakland County citizens voted to create the first unified form of county government in the history of Michigan. Less than 60 such governments exist across the nation.

The government is headed by an elected County Executive with responsibilities similar to those of a governor or the mayor of a large city. The County Executive administers the government on a day to day basis, proposes new programs and revamps existing programs. The executive represents the interests of more than one million residents.

Under this structure, the Board of Commissioners performs a role similar to a state legislature or city council. It acts on proposals submitted by the County Executive and makes proposals of its own. Government policy is set by the Board of Commissioners and implemented by the County Executive. The County Executive may veto acts of the Board and the vetoes can be overridden by two-thirds vote of the Board.

The executive form of government did not change the third branch of government, the judiciary. Similarly, the five other offices headed by officials elected countywide remain unchanged. These are the Prosecutor, the Sheriff, the Clerk/Register of Deeds, the Treasurer and the Drain Commissioner.

## **AUTOMATION ALLEY**

Oakland County Executive L. Brooks Patterson identified Automation Alley as one of the nations fastest growing technology clusters. 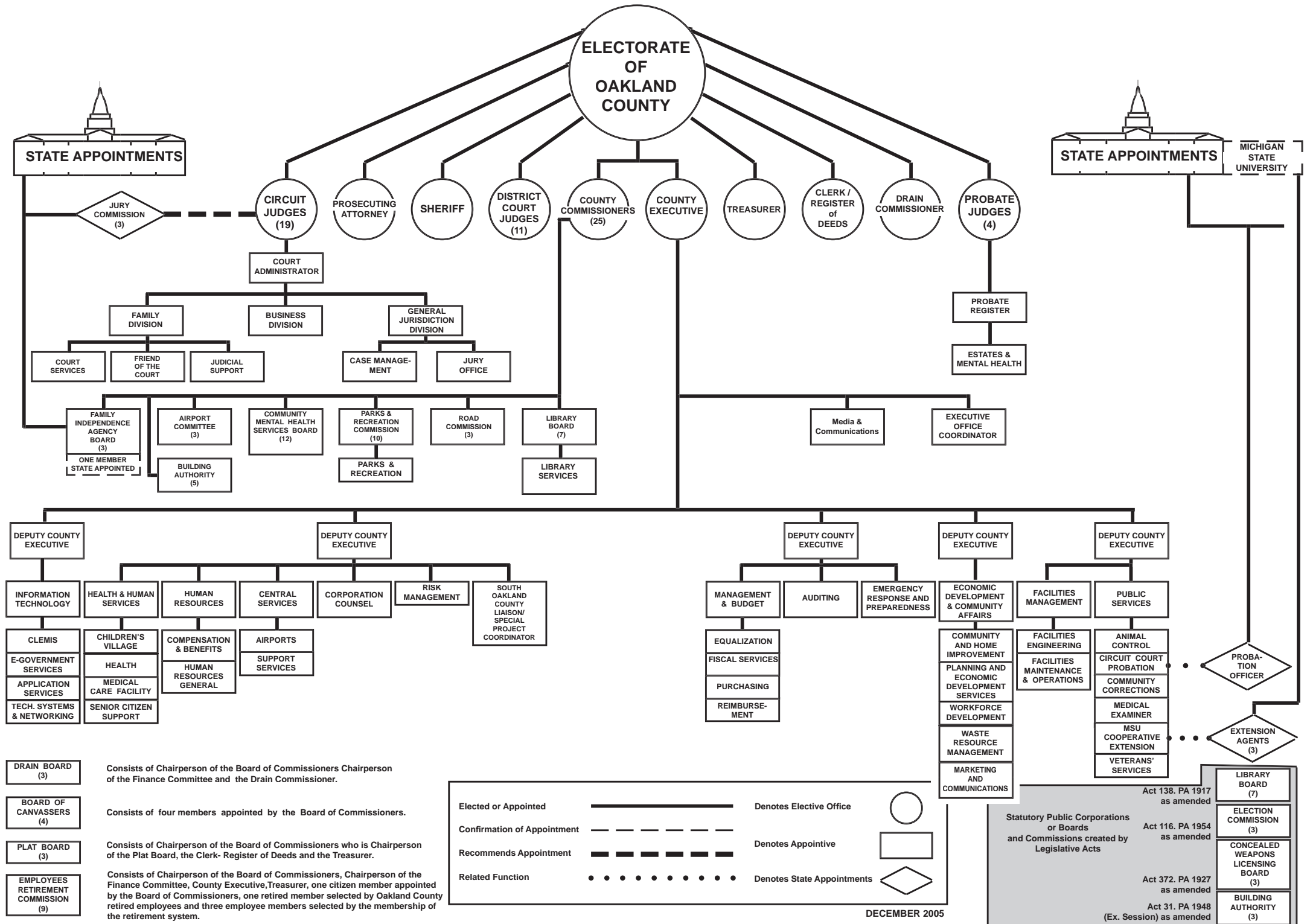

## **SERVICE CENTER COMPLEX**

The Oakland County Service Center Complex has been developed over the past 80 years and functions as the hub of county government. The majority of the county's departments and institutions are presently located on a 531-acre site in the City of Pontiac and Waterford Township divided by Telegraph Road. The County has developed the complex by systematically constructing facilities as needed and funding permits. It is laid out in a spacious setting according to a master plan, giving direction to an ultimate development, which will be functional, efficient and aesthetically pleasing. The Service Center was designed with a "community" concept of a campus development, grouping similar or related functions together.

The campus is serviced by full fiber optic connections and a county-owned and operated private telephone business exchange. The campus technology infrastructure allows state-of-the art communications between all government units and the public.

The 415,000-square foot courthouse houses Circuit, Family and Probate Courts, and offices of the Clerk/Register of Deeds, Treasurer, Prosecutor, and Board of Commissioners. Other major facilities located on campus are the Executive Office Building, Sheriff's Law Enforcement-Jail Complex, Medical Examiner's Facility, Public Health Center, Medical Care Facility, Children's Village and the Drain Commissioners Office.

The Oakland County Sheriff's Law Enforcement-Jail Complex serves not only as a location to house most of Oakland County's 1,900 inmates, but contains many key components of the state's largest full-service Sheriff Office. Its resources are always ready to assist any agency or person in Oakland County.

Resources and services of the Sheriff's Office include: A 31 member Harley Davidson Motorcycle Unit; K-9 Unit; Aviation Unit; Marine Unit; Armored Vehicle; Traffic and Alcohol Enforcement; Emergency Communications; Court Services; Forensic Science Lab; Boot Camp and many more outstanding specialty units.

The over 1,200 highly trained members of the Sheriff's Office work in six different divisions: Corrective Services, Satellite Services, Patrol Services, Sheriff - Emergency Response and Preparedness, Technical Services and Administrative Services. The mission of the Sheriff's Office is to safeguard and protect the citizens and property within Oakland County and the care and custody of inmates.

Children's Village provides detention, shelter, care and residential treatment services for neglected and delinquent wards of the court. It is situated on 50 acres on the Waterford Township side of the Service Center. The Village affords a home-like atmosphere for troubled children coming to the attention of the court and consists of nine separate program units that provide an opportunity to deal with the individual problems of youths and families.

The Oakland County Service Center is a model complex and is the core of county government. Oakland's officials are proud of the complex and its related facilities. County citizens and visitors from other counties, states and nations have found and will continue to find themselves most welcome.



## **OAKLAND COUNTY COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITY**

With a net operating budget of approximately \$230 million in Fiscal Year 2006, the Authority has been serving Oakland County's 1.3 million residents since 1964. It has grown to become Michigan's second largest public Community Mental Health Services Program and is responsible for services to adults with mental illnesses, children with serious emotional disturbances, and people of all ages with developmental disabilities. The Authority provides services to over 14,000 children and adults in Oakland County.

The Authority is governed by a twelve-member board, consisting of primary and secondary consumers and interested members of the community. Its mission is to support the advancement of social equity and improved quality of life for adults with serious mental illness, children with serious emotional disturbances, and people with developmental disabilities.

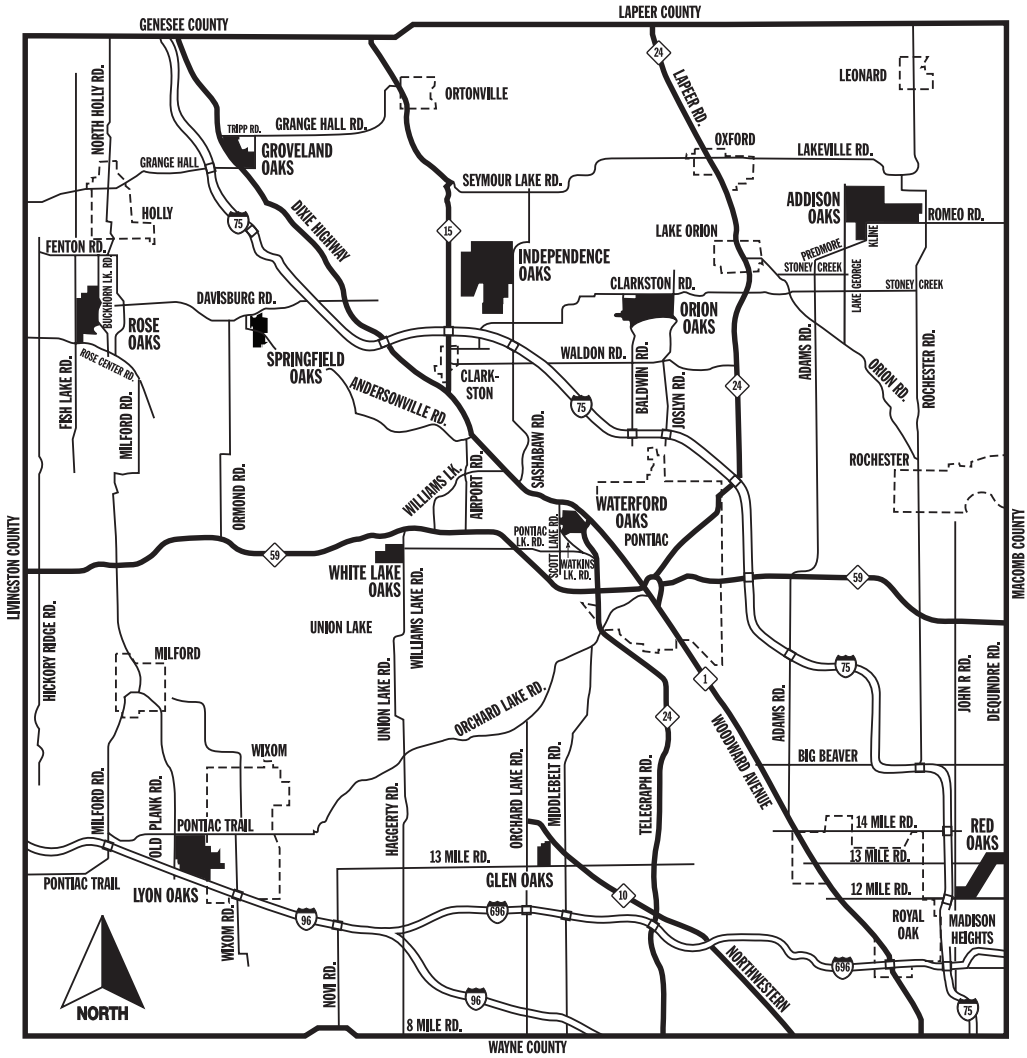
The Authority receives over 90% of the funding for mental health services from two sources: Medicaid capitation payments and state General Funds. Additionally, the County of Oakland provides about 5% of the funding. The budget allocates 95% of the funding to contracted services and support, with approximately 5% for the Authority administration.

The Authority's provider network consists of six major contracted service providers and several smaller providers who offer a full range of mental health and community-based services. These include evaluation and screening, hospital and residential treatment, respite care, clubhouses and day programs, supported employment, multilingual programs, corrections services, and a dual diagnosis program for individuals with mental illness and substance abuse. The Authority works with several Qualified Health Plans that provide comprehensive medical services to enrolled Medicaid recipients.

The Authority is fully certified by the State of Michigan Department of Community Health as required by the state Mental Health Code and Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations. Person-Centered Planning which is mandated by the code, provides individuals with disabilities with more choice and control. The goal of this model is improved quality of life for consumers and more integration as fully participating members of the community.

These programs are supported by your tax dollars. The Authority is ready to help eligible Oakland County residents who need professional mental health services in any way possible. # OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS



## OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS

With preservation of open space a priority, Oakland County Parks strives to enhance quality of life for its guests. A record number of visitors – 1.6 million – used the Oakland County Parks in 2005.

Recreational, leisure and learning experiences are made possible through special events, programs and facilities, supported in part by a one-quarter mill tax.

Homeowners pay an average of \$18.75 (on a \$150,000 home) to improve, maintain and acquire parks and recreation areas in Oakland County. Voters have supported the Oakland County Parks since its inception in 1966. The parks system is celebrating its 40th anniversary in 2006.

Currently, the 11-park system totals more than 7,500 acres. Land is acquired with assistance from state and federal grants. Ten citizens comprise its policy-setting commission.

A leader in innovative facilities and programs, the parks system offers two waterparks; The Fridge, Michigan's only refrigerated toboggan run; two nature centers; and a community mobile recreation fleet.

Trail projects for 2006 include expansion of an asphalt trail system at Groveland Oaks, completion of a 2.1-mile River Trail, including a boardwalk and footbridge at Independence Oaks, and additional trail expansion at Lyon Oaks.

Other improvements will include a campground recreation pavilion at Addison Oaks and a restroom building and small shelter for the Lyon Oaks Bark Park. In addition, a master plan will be created for 623-acre Rose Oaks. Preliminary planning for an equestrian center at Springfield Oaks will begin. Two six-person cabins will be built at Groveland Oaks.

**Addison Oaks:** The 1,140-acre park offers swimming, fishing, boating, camping, disc golf, cross-country skiing and mountain bike trails. In 2005, the Oakland County Parks Commission approved the purchase of 346 acres of environmentally-significant property adjacent to the park, making it the largest park in the system. The land consists of hardwood forest and open meadows plus marsh and wooded wetlands as part of the headwaters of the West Branch of Stony Creek, a tributary of the Clinton River. Addison Oaks also offers a 2.5 mile paved path is popular for hiking, biking, and blading. Modern and group campsites, as well as six overnight rental cabins are available. A conference center hosts business and social gatherings. On West Romeo Road, nine miles north of Rochester. (248) 693-2432.

**Glen Oaks:** The 18-hole, par 70 golf course features a clubhouse with an updated, renovated grill room, banquet facilities and outdoor wedding garden. Cross-country skiing is a winter option. On Thirteen Mile Road between Middlebelt and Orchard Lake Roads, Farmington Hills. (248) 851-8356.

**Groveland Oaks:** Campers have a choice of 462 campsites, group camping areas as well as six overnight cabins. Groveland Oaks offers swimming, a waterslide, fishing, boating, hiking trail, skate park and miniature golf course. Off Dixie Highway at Grange Hall Road, Holly. (248) 634-9811.

**Independence Oaks:** Activities at this 1,088-acre park include boating and fishing on the 68-acre Crooked Lake plus swimming, cross-country skiing and nearly 12 miles of trails. The Lewis E. Wint Nature Center offers exhibits and year-round nature programs, the Rubach Sensory Garden, a water garden and Cohn Outdoor Amphitheater. Camp Wilderness offers the camping experience to youth groups with platform tents, a modern restroom/shower building and group pavilions. On Sashabaw Road, 2.5 miles north of I-75. Park: (248) 625-0877; Nature Center: (248) 625-6473.

**Lyon Oaks:** This site features an 18-hole golf course, driving range, grill room and banquet facilities for special occasions. Day-use facilities include a nature center, hiking trails and bark park with water and pavilion. Bordered by Pontiac Trail, Old Plank and I-96 in Lyon Township. Golf Course: (248) 437-1488; Nature Center: (248) 437-7356.

**Orion Oaks:** This scenic 927-acre park offers boating and fishing (wheelchair accessible dock) on Lake Sixteen, nearly 10 miles of trails for hiking, mountain biking and cross-country skiing. An expanded parking lot for the Bark Park, accessible off Joslyn Road, is expected to open in 2006. The off-leash playground for dogs features open fields, trails, small and large dog areas plus a swimming beach for canines only. Bordered by Clarkston, Joslyn and Baldwin roads. (248) 858-0906.

**Red Oaks:** The Madison Heights water park features a wave-action pool, giant triple waterslide, river ride and two children's water playgrounds. The nine-hole golf course includes a pro shop, restrooms, vending and seating plus an outdoor terrace. Water park: (248) 585-6990; Golf Course: (248) 551-5030.

**Rose Oaks:** This 623-acre park includes two large and five small lakes as well as hiking trails. On Fish Lake Road, north of Rose Center Road, Rose Township. (248) 858-0906.

**Springfield Oaks:** This complex includes an 18-hole championship golf course (par 71) and a multi-purpose activity center for banquets, receptions and 4-H events, plus two outdoor arenas. The historic Ellis Barn was moved from its former home on Dixie Highway to Springfield Oaks last year. This park is also the proposed site of the Oakland Equestrian Center. Cross-country skiing is available at the golf course. On Andersonville Road in Davisburg. Golf Course: (248) 625-2540; Activity Center: (248) 634-7899.

**Waterford Oaks:** The 154-acre park is home to the Park Commission's administrative offices. The water park boasts Michigan's first wave-action pool, a giant double waterslide, group raft ride and children's water playground. The park also features "the Fridge" – Michigan's only refrigerated toboggan run. A BMX track hosts local state and national races. The activity center offers classes including aerobics and dog obedience. The park also offers a court sport complex with tennis and sand volleyball courts, shuffleboard, horseshoes and picnic shelters. Facilities on Watkins Lake and Scott Lake Roads, Waterford. (248) 858-0906.

**White Lake Oaks:** At this 18-hole, par 70 course, a new clubhouse/pro shop is expected to open in spring 2006. Cross-country skiing is a winter option. On South Williams Lake Road off M-59, near Pontiac. (248) 698-2700.

## **OAKLAND COUNTY ROADS**

Almost half of all highways, roads, and streets in Oakland County are part of the county system, which is under the jurisdiction of the Road Commission for Oakland County.

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) is now in its 92<sup>nd</sup> year of service to the people of Oakland County.

Totaling nearly 2,700 miles, RCOC's road system includes all public roads in townships, except state highways and through-streets in most cities and villages. It is the largest county system in Michigan, second in size only to the state highway system. Subdivision streets alone (all in townships) make up more than 900 miles.

About two-thirds of the system is paved. More than half is within the county's urban area, where some roads are four, five, six and seven lanes wide to handle heavy traffic. A single intersection, in Southfield, is the meeting place for 100,000 vehicles daily. More than 1,200 electrical signals and over 120,000 signs are in use on the county road system.

The Road Commission has no authority to levy a countywide tax, nor does anyone levy a tax countywide for roads.

The basic source of Road Commission revenue is state-collected vehicle fuel and registration taxes, which motorists pay at the pump, and to the Secretary of State. The state-collected taxes are the only source of substantial funding for county road maintenance, and snow and ice control.

Federal, county, municipal, township and property-owner contributions are also received, but generally only for specific road projects. Such projects include adding lanes, intersection improvements, paving gravel roads, adding new gravel, resurfacing paved roads, adding passing lanes and other safety improvement projects.

In 1992, the RCOC embarked on a program called FAST-TRAC, an Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) effort. The Road Commission has installed "smart" traffic signals operated by computers and video vision at nearly 650 intersections across the county. This is the largest adaptive traffic control system in the United States and the largest video imaging system for traffic management in the world. The Road Commission was the first local unit of government to initiate a program of this scope and magnitude.

For paving and resurfacing of subdivision streets, property owners can petition the RCOC to create a special assessment district through a process prescribed by state law. The process begins by contacting the Road Commission, then petitioning and participating in public hearings.

Members of the three-person Board of County Road Commissioners are appointed for staggered six-year terms by the elected Oakland County Board of Commissioners, which also sets their salaries. State-collected vehicle fuel and registration tax revenues fund salaries. The board of road commissioners is separate from county general government – establishing policies as authorized by state statutes for management of the countywide road system, administering its own budget and hiring its own full-time managing director and staff.
