And in case any person named in said Tax Roll shall neglect or refuse to pay his said tax you are hereby authorized to levy the same by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of such person, with the costs and charges of such distress and sale as provided by law; and for so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant.
