

Library starts patron survey

If you receive a phone call from the Novi Public Library during the next few weeks, don't worry — it probably won't be about an overdue book.

Library volunteers are conducting a survey of local residents to learn their opinions about current and projected library resources and programs.

Brenda Burrell, Public Services librarian, said each telephone survey should take about 10 minutes to complete. "If residents are too busy to talk with us when we call, we'll be happy to call back," she added.

Some of the questions included on the survey are: "Do you think the Novi Public Library is easy to get to?" "Do you regularly use any library other than Novi's?" And, "Are you satisfied by the hours, facilities, collections and services provided by the Novi Public Library?"

Burrell said the library guarantees that anonymity of survey respondents will be preserved. Telephone numbers will be chosen at random from each of the city's voting precincts.

The telephone survey is part of a long range planning process. Demographic data about the city has been gathered from such sources as the Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG) and the Census Bureau.

Statistics about library use have been compiled and comparisons with libraries of similar size will be made. Results of the current telephone survey will be added to previously tabulated student and teacher surveys.

The final result will be a well-documented community profile that includes residents' attitudes about library service.

The profile will be used to determine goals for future library services and establish objectives for achieving the goals. The library's long range plan, to be updated regularly, will be available for the public's review at the library.

Will airport really spur economy?

"Will development of a general aviation airport in Wixom be an economic boon for the area?"

"Wixom officials will attempt to demonstrate that the answer to the question is 'yes' at a special meeting next Tuesday (November 16) in the Wixom Municipal Center at 7:30 p.m."

"The speaker will be Al Bogdan, director of the Detroit Regional Office of the State Department of Commerce, who will discuss the potential for economic development that will be created by expansion of Vernon Spencer Memorial Field into a general aviation facility."

Bogdan will emphasize the importance of airport development to attracting the so-called "high technology" type of development which has been identified by Governor William J. Wasieleski as a key to diversification of the state's industrial base.

One purpose of the meeting will be to generate support for the expansion of Spencer Airport from surrounding communities. Officials from both Lyon and

But also the efforts of other communities in initiating economic development within their boundaries," said Bonczek.

"The development of a successful high technology park requires certain amenities and support facilities near the site," he continued, pointing to Wixom's immediate access to rail and expressway facilities.

liaison, said the survey evolved through conversations he had with Melvin Perry Eagleton of Highway Tire and other business owners.

"We wanted to find out what was on their minds," Clifton said of the business community. He said the survey had been helpful in pointing out areas of concern to merchants, as well as positive comments.

Cast presents 'beautifully awful' theater

Theater-lovers looking for something unusual are advised to spend one night this weekend at Walled Lake Western. Students there will be presenting, "I Never Saw Another Butterfly," an adaptation of three pieces of literature dealing with life in the concentration camps of World War II. Described as "beautifully awful" by Western drama teacher Jacqueline Plas, the play is considered chamber theater and involves recitations by cast members directly to the audience. Plas said chamber theater is similar to that performed in Thornton Wilder's "Our Town," only "stretched into a much more full bloom." She adapted the script from three books of poetry written by survivors of concentration camps — including a book of children's poetry — during World War II. Although Plas said "I Never Saw Another Butterfly" is a "real heavy" drama, she also points out it has an uplifting message. "The theme is not the atrocities (of the camps)," she said. "The theme is how to survive with dignity and not sacrifice your own quality of life or set of morals under any circumstances." The play will be presented at 8 p.m. Thursday through Saturday in Western's auditorium. Tickets are \$5 each and are available in advance or at the door. Cast members are Diana Catacosinos, Jeff Pawcett, Liz Ferrick, Gayle Mandeville, Gwen Mollanen, Nancy Nevison, Theresa Pappas, Kelly Qualls, Kim Qualls, Charlie Richardson, Leslie Runk, Julie Sandeur, Tim Shasteen, Rob Stone, Jeanne Stubbs and Steve Webb. In addition to the cast, more than 50 other students have been involved in the technical aspects of the play, said Plas, who is directing the drama.

Village honors late dispatcher

Next spring when drivers pass by the administrative offices of Wolverine Lake Village, they'll notice a small flowering tree. What they might not know is that the tree was planted recently in memory of Evelyn Rosemary, a dispatcher for the village police department who died last November 17. Council Member Robert Woodrow, authorized by the village council to coordinate the tree-planting effort, said the tree's location is in just the right spot. It's near the administrative offices where Rosemary worked and will be highly visible to everybody who goes by. Woodrow said he didn't want to see the tree planted in Clara Miller Park, where it could be vandalized or overlooked. The tree was planted last spring, but the village waited until recently to install a plaque marked simply, "In memory of Evelyn Rosemary." Said Woodrow: "The last thing I wanted to do was plant the tree and then have Ev's children see it die. That would just be too hard on everyone." Rosemary's daughter, Kathy, said she and her two brothers appreciated the village's effort to remember their mother. The village council allocated \$350 to purchase a tree and plaque in memory of the dispatcher, who died of a heart attack at the age of 44. The plaque was made by Bob Bruder, husband of Betty Bruder, a dispatcher who worked with Rosemary.

Gas station is proposed

Construction of a self-serve Marathon Oil gas station is expected to begin this year as a result of action by the Novi Planning Board last week. Specifically, the planners voted unanimously to grant final site plan approval for the gas station which is to be constructed on a 3.6 acre parcel at the southeast corner of the Pontiac Trail/Beck Road intersection. The location of the gas station is likely to be affected by the proposed relocation of the Pontiac Trail/Beck Road intersection. Plans call for South Beck Road to be realigned to the east so it forms a conventional 90 degree intersection with Pontiac Trail and flows directly into North Beck Road. After the intersection has been realigned, the Marathon gas station will be situated on the southwest instead of the southeast corner. Site plan approval had been stalled as city engineers attempted to resolve drainage problems associated with the site. Engineering consultant Cliff Seiber reported last week that plans now demonstrate roadway flooding will not result as a consequence of development and that an adequate storm water outlet is provided. The exterior of the 336 square foot gas station will be face brick. Novi planners requested a face brick finish because surrounding buildings, including the Village Apartments in Wixom, have face brick exteriors.

College gears up to aid business, industry

When Richard McDowell was hired as president of Schoolcraft College in Livonia last year, he talked about "outreach" — helping business train employees and aiding southeastern Michigan's industrialization. The program is nine months old, and last week trustees gave McDowell's staff high marks for the early efforts. Highlights: Since the first of the year, nearly 50 companies have been personally contacted. The result has been a general increase in awareness of the part of both the college and the business community. Six individual program packages have been implemented, and another 12 are in the development stages. The report came from Ron Griffith, dean of continuing education and community services, and Stuart Baker, coordinator of business and industry in the work area. In the works are a chef refresher course for the U.S. Army and Marines, an upgrading program for licensed

"It takes a while," said Baker, "for them to understand what we mean by customized service to a business. We focus in on a company's specific needs." "They're struggling. I'll walk through a plant with them, and they'll say, 'This is where we used to do that.'" The six programs already launched are: Holdime-Livonia West — employee selection and start-up training; Cadillac Motor Car Division Livonia — trouble-shooting course for 27 technicians in digital electronics; Fisher Body, Livonia — fundamentals of speech, Schoolcraft's communication arts 103; Kroger Company — supervision, Schoolcraft's business 220; University of Michigan — three chef refresher courses; Westland Agency on Aging — life and work planning workshop. In the works are a chef refresher course for the U.S. Army and Marines, an upgrading program for licensed

practical nurses at Harper-Grace Hospital, start-up training for Hanlo Gauge, and "out-placement" services for Associated Spring. Said Griffith: "You work from their needs, not from your shelf. You discuss their problems and concerns, and work backward from there." The community college serving Northwestern Wayne County and parts of Oakland and Washtenaw counties surveyed its own faculty to see who might be interested in teaching in industry for supplemental pay. If no one on the faculty is available, then an outsider will be hired. Sometimes an existing Schoolcraft course is used, as in the supervision and public speaking courses. Much of the time, the course is tailor-made to solve the company's problem. "You have a three-way conversation — the company, the expert (instructor) and the college representative," said Griffith. "We enter into a formal agreement to render services. Administrative costs are included in the total contract. Much of the instruction is on-site in the industry." "There are 2,100 companies which have at least 10 employees," he said of the college district. The college targeted 50 as early prospects. The college also has joined other agencies in training programs. Among its partners are the Wayne County Economic Development Corporation, which is working with automotive suppliers on a program of "just in time" delivery; city industrial developers; and the Michigan Department of Education. McDowell reported progress on another front: the Schoolcraft College Foundation, a nonprofit corporation which raises funds for scholarships and equipment. Last year the foundation raised only \$1,700 in new gifts, so McDowell set a goal of \$15,000. He reported the foundation already has raised \$17,000 and that he is revising his goal upward to \$25,000.

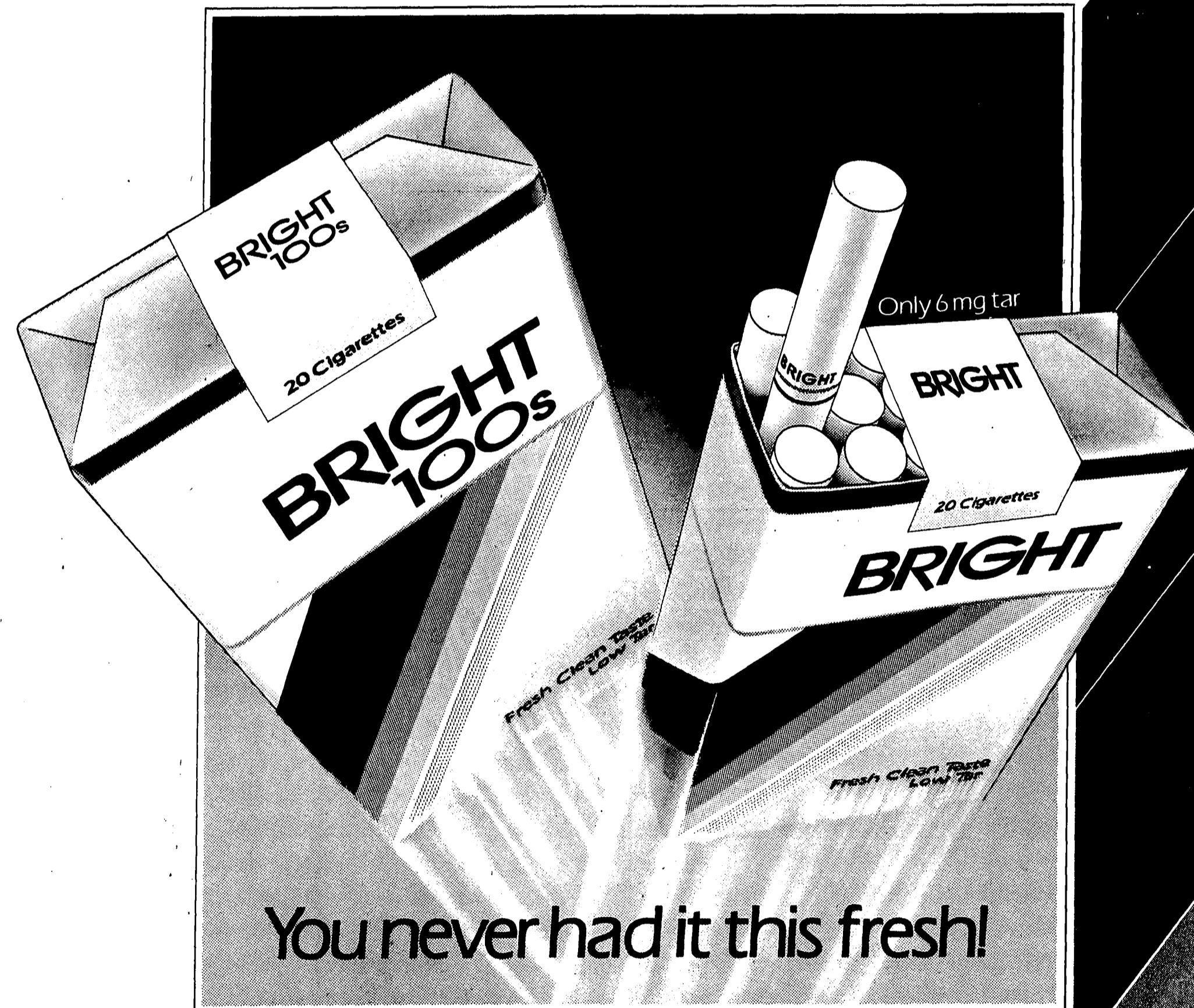

John VanSicklen, coach of the Viking squad, expressed similar sentiments. "It was just a super game," said the central mentor. "Both teams gave it everything they had."

The Vikings had their aerial game to thank for the victory. The Warriors limited Central to a minus-seven yards on the ground, but the Vikings pulled out the victory on the arm of Tom Menard who completed 10 of 19 attempts for 171 yards and two touchdowns.

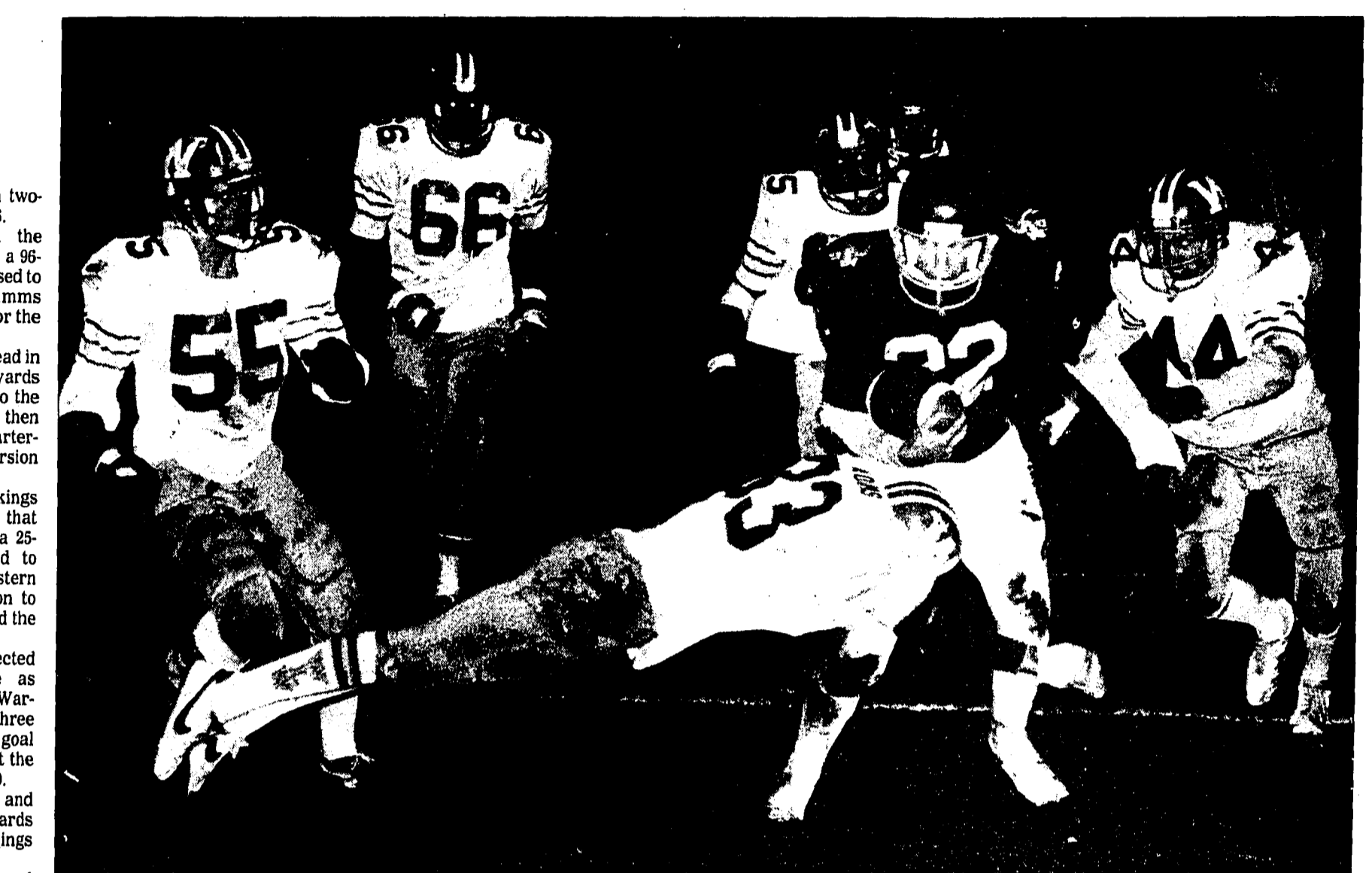
Kevin Wheeler latched onto five of those passes for 102 yards and a touchdown, while Steve Thibert grabbed three more that included a 25-yard touchdown.

Western was led by Paul Imms, their bruising 6-2, 220 pound tailback, who carried the ball 23 times for 158 yards and three touchdowns.

The two squads battled an even tempo through the first half until Western scored on a seven-yard pass from Menard to Wheeler late in the second quarter to make it 6-0 at the half.

The Vikings made it 14-0 early in the third quarter, as Tim Gieseler broke loose on a 25-yard touchdown jaunt and Menard hit Thibert for a two-point conversion.

And that's when things started to get interesting. Western's Aito Buttazzoni blocked a Viking punt midway through the period and Frank Garback

recovered on the two to set up a two-point conversion. Imms missed the kick.

The Warrior narrowed the margin to 14-12 moments later on a 96-yard flea-flicker. Rick Hunter passed to Joe Mills who flipped the ball to Imms who raced the length of the field for the score.

Western finally moved into the lead in the fourth quarter, marching 70 yards in eight plays as Imms bulldozed into the end zone from the two. Hunter then sprinted around left end on a quarterback bootleg for a two-point conversion that made the score 20-14.

With time winding down, the Vikings mounted a drive from midfield that culminated seven plays later in a 25-yard scoring pass from Menard to Thibert that made it 20-20. Western blocked the extra-point conversion to keep the score deadlocked and send the game into overtime.

The Vikings won the flip and elected to begin overtime on defense as Western lined up on the 10. The Warriors gained just two yards on the play and opted to go for the field goal on fourth down as Wankleski split the uprights from the 26 to make it 23-20.

Central then took over on the 10 and scored on a 35-yard field goal from nine yards out on second down to give the Vikings the 26-23 triumph.

The victory enabled Central to end the season with a 5-4 record, while the Warriors wound up with a 4-1-1 slate for the year.

Both VanSicklen and App noted Western's ability to come back from a 14-0 deficit to send the game into overtime.

"I think we may have let up a bit when we got ahead 14-0 in the third quarter and you just can't afford to do that against a good football team like Western," said VanSicklen.

App, on the other hand, said he was extremely proud of the way his team fought back from the 14-0 deficit.

"I could have hugged everyone of my kids," said the Warrior mentor. "They were down 14-0 but they just kept fighting and almost won the game. It was a tremendous battle between two good football teams."

"It was a heckuva way to close out the season," he added. "The fans who came out in the cold got their money's worth."
