**Board to review expansion right**

In the tug-of-war over the right to expand commercial operations, property owners in the Novi Town Center area lost a little ground Monday night.

In a hurry-up mode to enact stricter construction standards in the Town Center zoning district, Novi City Council asked planning board members to decide tonight (Wednesday) whether to reconsider a proposed measure two officials called a "blank check" for owners of existing commercial businesses to expand.

The controversial paragraph guarantees commercial business owners the right to expand their operations as long as the expanded use is identical to the existing use.

For example, a service station in the Town Center area may expand, provided the expanded use continues to be an automobile service station in the existing structure or an enlargement of the existing structure.

Council Member Arlen Schroeder blasted the measure, put in the amendment to assure existing business owners (some of which have been located in Novi for decades) the new Town Center would not jeopardize their livelihood.

"I don't see why we should be approving something that not only allows, but encourages them to expand," Schroeder declared. "The dollars they sink into (expanding) their property are just going to freeze those uses in the Town Center."

Council Member Hugh Crawford countered that he could not support such restrictions on business owners who chose to locate in Novi. "The words in this section are fine the way they are. If the planning board is looking for direction, that's my position," said Crawford.

Council unanimously agreed to submit the proposed change to the amendment to the planning board — an action board member Judy Johnson fretted might draw fire from business owners to whom copies of the overall amendment council reviewed were distributed for reference.

"This has been handed out to a number of people," Johnson said. "We thought it was more than a working document."

The Novi Planning Board decides tonight that the paragraph should be deleted from the overall amendment.

**I-696 committee drafts proposal**

Novi City Council Monday endorsed a regional transportation committee proposal urging widening I-696 west of Telegraph Road and adding additional interchanges in Novi and Farmington Hills, among other improvements.

The Local Technical Advisory Group, an adjunct to the I-696 Ramp Access Study Committee appointed to study road improvement needs in the area, last month compiled a list of six specific recommendations for the use of several units of government responsible for funding and coordinating improvements.

The recommendations subsequently were approved by the I-696 Ramp Access Study Committee, a regional advisory body with representatives from local municipalities affected by highway improvements.

The recommendations specify that:  
 1. During the next design phase for I-696, widening to six or eight lanes should be evaluated.  
 2. An access ramp for Haggerty Road is needed to facilitate north-south travel in western Oakland County. Design and environmental studies should be initiated for building a connector or stub between the I-696/I-96 interchange and the Haggerty/Twelve Mile intersection. The studies should consider alternative designs using existing MDOT-owned right-of-way and existing improvements within the interchange area. Alternative designs for intersecting with Twelve Mile and connecting with Haggerty also should be considered. Design alternatives, the study further noted, should be coordinated with the ultimate development of a north-south highway (I-275) through western Oakland County.  
 3. Design and environmental studies should be initiated for building an interchange west of Drake Road. The interchange is needed to improve access to the Twelve Mile Road corridor west of Orchard Lake Road.  
 4. A north-south highway corridor study should be initiated cooperatively between the Michigan Department of Transportation and local agencies to evaluate options for improving north-south service in western Oakland County. Included in the study should be consideration of adding additional lanes to Haggerty Road.  
 5. The Oakland County Road Commission and the cities of Farmington Hills and Novi should coordinate their improvement projects to coincide with providing additional access improvements to I-696. This coordinated approach, the group maintains, will assure maximum system operation between the freeway and the local road and street system. The specific improvements consist of widening Twelve Mile from Orchard Lake to Novi Road, and subsequently to Beck Road.  
 6. Design studies of the Beck Road/I-96 interchange currently under way should consider upgrading the interchange and providing full interchange service. MDOT will work with the City of Novi to coordinate design plans with proposed development and Twelve Mile improvement plans.

**Mayoral election, term rules studied**

The 1985 mayoral race could be the last to be decided in a general election as a result of action by the Novi City Council Monday night.

With little discussion and by a unanimous vote, council approved the creation of a citizens' committee to study changing two provisions of the city charter: (1) the two-year duration of the mayoral term and (2) the election of the mayor by general ballot.

The charter review committee is expected to closely study whether the mayor should be a council member elected by a majority vote of fellow council members, much as the president of the Novi School Board is appointed by a vote of fellow board members.

Farmington Hills City Council, among other local municipal governments, annually appoints its mayor this way.

Members of the seven-member committee will be appointed by council. City council members will continue to be elected by voters in a general election.

The idea of selecting the mayor by council vote rather than in a general election gained momentum after last fall's mayoral election, one of the most expensive and bitterly contested in the city's history.

Critics of the existing election system claimed a general mayoral election is too expensive and disruptive. As longtime Novi political observer Russell Buton observed last fall, the election probably cost the city a useful voice in city issues by putting incumbent mayor Robert Schmidt out of office.

Schmidt himself, however, said at that time he did not favor doing away with a general election for mayor. He claimed a mandate of voters gives the mayor office and the community more visibility and strength.

If the review committee promptly recommends changes to the city charter as expected, council will place the issue on a ballot for city voters to decide — most likely in time for the August primary election.

Liaison to city officials will be City Clerk Geraldine Stupp, who will serve as a non-voting advisory member of the committee. Heten Seward of the League of Women Voters and Planning Board Member Isabel Collins reportedly are among those interested in serving on the committee.

Applications from city residents wishing to serve on the committee currently are being accepted at the city clerk's office.

**Snow job: It's better**

Thanks to the opening of the new Department of Public Works (DPW) facility on Grand River Avenue last year, city workers' ability to sweep snow off the streets has improved.

"The trucks are warm, so they can start faster. And we keep a load of salt stored in the garage so we can get out quicker," explained Novi DPW Director Edward Smialek.

"We used to have to store the salt outside and cover it during rain and snow. Often there'd be a lot of moisture getting into the salt, making it clump together."

## MSU study views police chases

Police pursuits are not particularly safe no matter how fast or how far they are or how long they last, according to the most comprehensive study of pursuits to date.

Dr. Erik Beckman, associate professor in the School of Criminal Justice at Michigan State University, studied factors involving 424 pursuits among 75 law enforcement agencies in nine states and two territories.

"Pursuits create a dilemma for law enforcement officers," said Beckman. "The need for apprehension must be balanced against the degree of inevitable hazard to all parties involved, including other motorists."

"Just as police use of force is restricted, so it appears reasonable to place restrictions on pursuits, bearing in mind that there are no specific limits on distance of speed that guarantee safety."

The study indicates that suspects are most vulnerable to injuries and death, other motorists second and police third. There was property damage in about one of every five pursuits, injuries in seven and deaths in one in approximately 33.

One of the findings that surprised Beckman was that roadblocks and ramming of a fleeing car, which had been considered to be hazardous, actually increase the capture rate while decreasing the overall injury rate and increasing the overall injury rate only slightly.

According to the study, when police used forcible intervention of any kind (roadblock, ramming, boxing in, etc.), there was a capture rate of 96 percent compared with the average capture rate of 77 percent.

Other findings of the study:

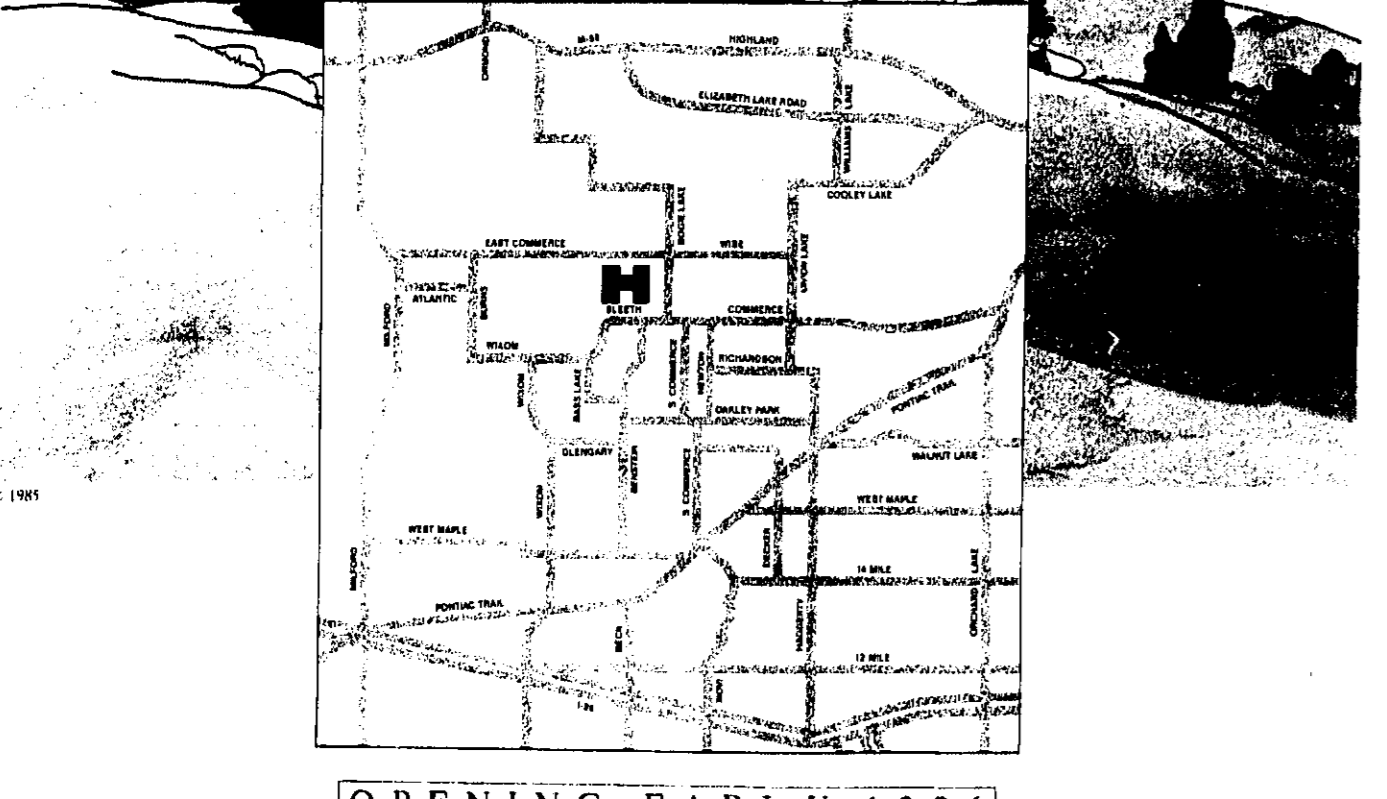
- Longer pursuits tended to result in violent felony charges, shorter pursuits in property felony charges.
- The majority of suspects were apprehended regardless of such factors as distance, time of pursuit, type of roadway, locale, environmental conditions, police and suspect speed.
- A driver attempts to elude officers usually for reasons other than being a dangerous felon.
- The event preceding the pursuit is unrelated to the safety of its outcome.
- The confidence of the officer's perception of the event preceding the pursuit is generally confirmed by the booking charges.
- Chances of the suspect escaping are greatly increased when the pursuing officer does not have a back-up unit.
- Pursuits generally end in a surrender by the suspect, either voluntary or in connection with the suspect being involved in an accident.
- When forcibly stopped, the most common booking charges against the suspect were violent felony, reckless driving and driving under the influence of alcohol.
- Ninety-six percent of the suspects were male; 87 percent were white and 16 percent were black; 45 percent were in the 21-30 age group and 37 percent were in the 11-20 age group.
- Suspects between 21 and 40 were booked predominantly on felony and driving-related charges; those under 21 and over 40 were booked predominantly on driving-related charges only.
- Pursuits with high speeds, long distances and intoxicated drivers occur primarily at night.
- Police injuries occurred in police speeds ranging from 41 to 140 miles per hour.
- Beckman recommends that all police agencies adopt a written policy for pursuits and reinforce it through training, supervision and post-pursuit analysis.
- The study involved 40 city police departments and 35 sheriff's departments in Alabama, Arizona, California, Florida, Georgia, Guam, Hawaii, Louisiana, South Carolina, Tennessee and the Virgin Islands.
- Beckman said a second study is being planned and will involve northern states with different climate conditions.

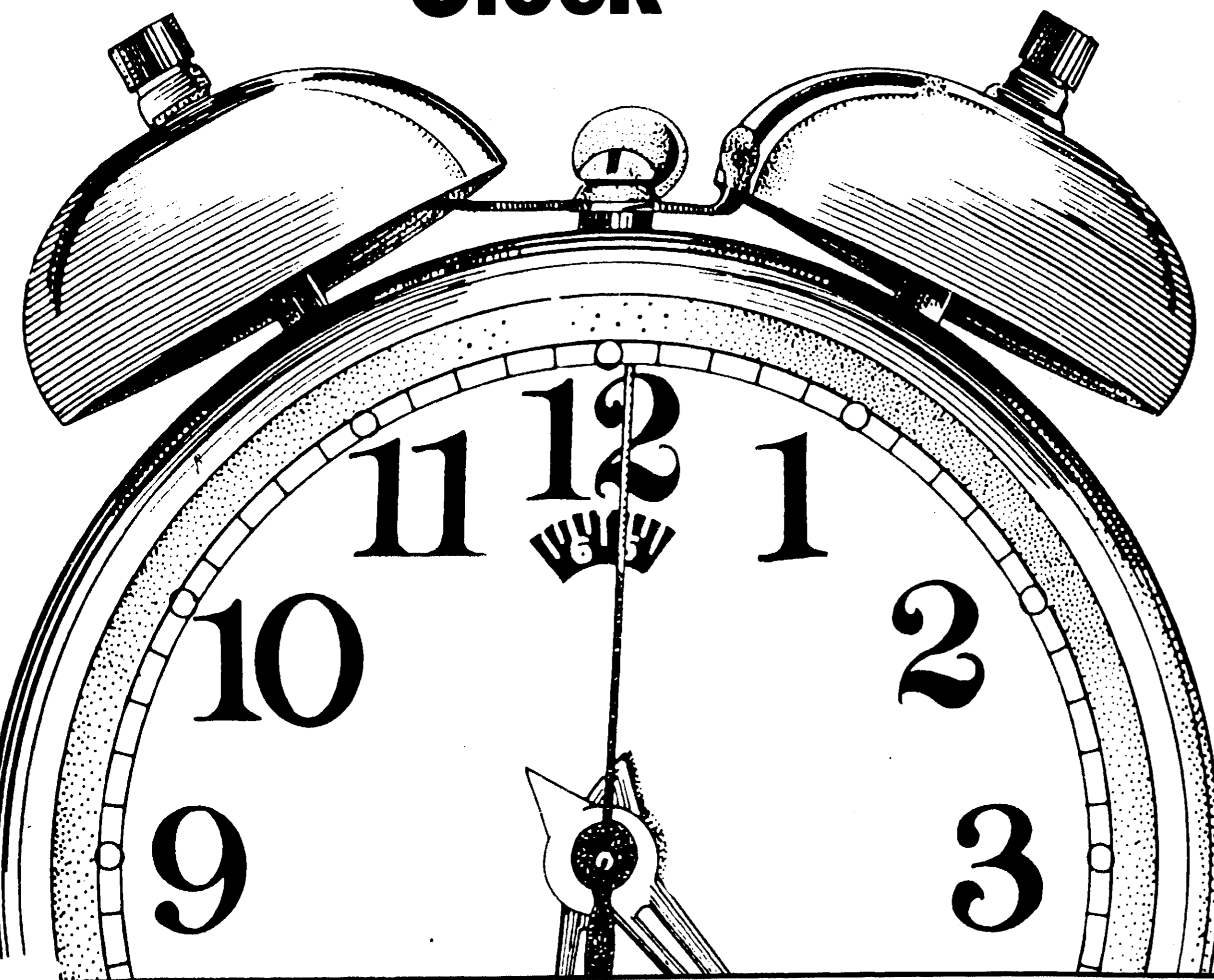

# HAPPY NEW YOU

## Use your brains, then your brawn

This is it. This is the year you're going to keep that New Year's resolution to get in shape. But before you lace up your tennis shoes and trot out the door, you should prepare yourself, especially if it's been a few years since you last ran or walked a mile. Starting an exercise program is always the hardest step, but if you follow a few common sense guidelines and pace yourself, you'll find it's not really that hard at all. The first step for anyone beginning to exercise is to get a good idea of what kind of shape you're in right now. Anyone who is over 35 years old or hasn't exercised for awhile

will want to start with a check-up at the doctor's office. "If they've never exercised before and they're starting, they should check with their physician," says Gary Wasiak, a Milford doctor who specializes in sports medicine. "This is especially important for anyone with a heart problem or any other type of ailment, such as a bad knee or ankle, since they are more prone to injury." The American Heart Association says about 10 percent of apparently healthy men over 35 years old have a hidden heart problem. While exercise can still be beneficial to those with certain ailments, it should be done under the supervision of a physician. One of the biggest mistakes beginning exercisers make is pushing too hard too soon, says Dr. Norman Brant, whose Novi office does sports medicine work. "The important thing is to pace yourself," Brant says. "Usually in your mind you're ready to push hard, but the body has to build up a bit. Start off at a moderate to easy pace. Don't try to go for the gold medal the first day."

The Livingston County Health Department recommends that those beginning an exercise program build slowly until they can raise their heart rate. "A fitness program should be started slowly and gradually increased in intensity over a period of

weeks and months, until you're exercising at 70-80 percent of your maximum heart rate," they say. To find your maximum heart rate, subtract your age from 220. For example, a 45-year-old male in good condition would have a maximum of 175.

Exercise performed in the "target zone" of 70-80 percent of that maximum yields the most cardiovascular benefit.

Wasiak says he usually starts his patients walking or running at a comfortable pace for 1/2 mile each day for the first week. If they feel comfortable with that pace they can increase the distance 1/2 mile the next week. Patients continue adding 1/2 mile increments each week until they are running or walking two-three miles a day, six days a week.

Wasiak also recommends that anyone using a fitness program take one day off each week to rest.

Before beginning any exercising, it's important to warm up the muscles you will be using by doing a few stretching exercises. It's also important to "warm down", or stretch after exercising to prevent the muscles from getting stiff and sore.

Most common stretching exercises can be found in any good exercise book or by consulting your doctor.

Most beginning exercisers soon find that fitness does not come without a little pain. Your muscles aren't used to being stretched and strengthened and they're going to be a little sore.

## Twenty ways to shed those remnants of '85

The assignment is 20 New Year's resolutions on shaping up, losing pounds and things like that. Sounds easy enough to put down in print but what about carrying through on the resolutions? Anybody can make them, but how many can stick to them?

Just the other day, I heard it is better not to resolve at all than to make unrealistic resolutions that are not kept—over and over again, like at the beginning of every New Year. So, the following list is suggested as a guideline from which you are allowed to pick and choose the ones that seem most possible to keep. After all, we don't want to create any problems among the readers by presenting them with unreasonable tasks in the shape-up department. A caution to readers: all of these require some degree of will power—or "won't power" as the case may be—and a doctor's advice before embarking on any of the more strenuous ones. For optimum success, choose a partner with whom there is a mutual obligation toward a "shape-up goal." You are a lot more apt to carry through with your resolutions.

1. This is an oldie, but goodie. Resolve to practice pushing yourself away from the table before you dip into that second helping. Better still, encourage the cook to fill the plates conservatively in the kitchen and eat only what you find there.
2. Resolve to leave the car cozily parked in the

garage or driveway and walk to work. This is not advised for those who live more than two or three miles from their place of employment.

3. For those who drive to work, resolve to choose a parking lot several blocks away and walk briskly to your employer's door.

4. Resolve, when going shopping or to the movies, to park on the far side of the parking lot (only when well-lit) and walk briskly (that is the operative word) to your destination.

5. Resolve to get up early at least three or four mornings a week and walk three miles in 45 minutes before going to work. Walking can be done in the evening, but seems more difficult to accomplish at the end of the day. Walking this briskly shapes up not only your body but your heart as well. It clears your head too, and is good to fight depression.

6. Resolve when the snow covers the sidewalks making them hazardous, to take your 45-minute walk at a school that allows walking and jogging clubs after school hours or try an enclosed shopping center. Many malls are open early for this purpose. Do not window shop or stop for coffee during this time—keep moving.

7. Resolve if none of these areas are convenient, to try spending at least 10 minutes a day (all at one time) going up and down stairs or on a treadmill. Again, it is good for your heart as well as your hips.

8. Resolve if you prefer jogging over walking to try it indoors at a school or mall during the winter months.

## Dieting takes more than just will power

The Thanksgiving to New Year's eating binge which has left most of us with refrigerators full of high-calorie leftovers and closets brimming with waist-pinchers at last finally has come to a close.

Now that the trifle's been eaten, the plum pudding devoured and the remains of turkey dinner sent home with relatives, it is time to give serious consideration to shedding

pounds. With diets topping the list of New Year's resolutions for many holiday overeaters, it is no wonder fitness centers and weight loss programs are in the midst of their busiest season.

However, before donning the aerobics shoes or stocking your refrigerator with rabbit food, consider a consultation with your doctor or advice from an expert.

Dietician Janet Franz, manager of Clinical Nutritional Services at Providence Hospital, notes that successful dieting takes more than just will power. "Normally the culprits are eating

patterns, not pounds," she says, adding that those who change their eating habits should be able to maintain their weight without dieting.

Franz, who finds her services most in demand after the holidays, stresses there are a few simple rules to follow when considering a good weight loss diet.

"A good weight loss diet does not limit you to a few foods or limit you to one class of food," she says. "I tell my patients that if they can't live with a diet, there is no sense in starting it. I don't think it's realistic to have people say they'll never again eat their

favorite foods," Franz notes.

She explains that a good weight loss program should help dieters retrain their eating habits by eating a wide variety of everyday foods (those in the four basic food groups) in smaller portions.

While she says that no foods should be considered taboo, Franz suggests cutting down on high-calorie sweets, red meat (which is high in cholesterol) limiting the intake of salt, caffeine and alcohol (which also includes beer and wine). She recommends adding more high fiber, fruits and vegetables.

While she admits many people are more health conscious today than a decade ago, Franz says overeating and overexercising can be as unhealthy as overeating.

She notes that while dieting may be slow going, dieters should not lose more than 2 to 2 1/2 pounds a week.

"People who go on extremely low-calorie diets — under 800 or 1,000 calories a day — won't get the essential nutrients," she says. Franz also cautions against skipping meals, noting that most people have a tendency to overindulge when they forego eating.

While supplementing a diet with vitamins is acceptable, Franz states that "megadoses of vitamins do not take the place of food."

She also encourages dieters to exercise, noting that even moderate physical activity can help keep the scales from climbing.

"Exercise and diet go hand-in-hand," she adds. "People should exercise more and eat less." "People can learn moderation," she says. "Eating a balanced diet and not eliminating everything you want to eat — but cutting down — is the key to successful dieting."

Call it elegant dining with a relaxed twist. The Canopy, located at 130 W. Grand River in downtown Brighton, has long been one of Livingston County's true dining showpieces. It's a gorgeous restaurant and they serve gorgeous food. It's always been a four-star establishment.

The thing is, those types of restaurants have a way of making you feel stuffy, stogy and oh, so proper. Not exactly the type of place to let down your hair.

Well, the Canopy doesn't exactly fit that mold anymore. It's still an elegant restaurant, but if you toss up a bit, it's allowed. Heck, it's encouraged.

The restaurant was purchased six months ago by Doug Wood and the new owner immediately set about to make some changes.

First off, he gutted several rooms in the restaurant, rebuilding them from the ground up. He put in new fixtures, new walls, new everything.

He also put in a dance floor. It's not very big, but it's definitely a dance floor, and it's right in the middle of the restaurant. On Friday and Saturday nights, you'll see folks hoofing it up there.

There was always a grand piano in the restaurant, and that instrument is still a fixture. Six nights a week your dining pleasure is enhanced by the sounds of Earl Williams at the keyboard.

On the weekends, though, you don't have to just sit by and listen to the music. Wood has installed a microphone next to the piano, and if the mood hits you, you're welcome to step up to the mike and belt out a tune.

"It's pretty popular," Wood said. "We've got a couple hams around town here who like to get up and sing."

While Wood has loosened up the atmosphere of the Canopy, he hasn't fiddled much with the menu. You can still get some of the finest cuisine anywhere.

"The menu is basically the same as it's always been," Wood said. "As far as that goes, we've tried to retain the flavor of the old Canopy."

So as usual, steak and seafood are the specialties.

One of the most popular seafood dishes on the dinner menu is the black and white fish, selling for \$11.95. You can also get a tasty serving of orange roughy for \$11.95.

Other popular seafood entrees include scallops and shrimp. There is also a different "fish of the day" available. "It's whatever the chef buys that day," Wood said. "In any case, it's always fresh and it's always good."

If seafood isn't what sales you, try some of the steak selections.

The Colorado strip is a healthy cut and it goes for \$12.95. The prime rib, a very popular dinner choice, sells for \$11.95.

Another big seller at dinner time is the surf and turf dish. It sells for \$17.95.

The Canopy is always hopping at dinner time, but it's also one of Brighton's most popular lunch havens.

The restaurant offers a full line of sandwiches, most in the \$5-\$6 range. The prime rib sandwich comes highly recommended.

There is also a "fish of the day" available at lunch, with perch reigning as the most popular

lunchtime seafood item. The Canopy offers a couple chicken dishes for lunch, and they're excellent.

Among the salads, the most popular lunchtime seller is the steak salad which goes for \$7.95.

To top off your meal at the Canopy, try one of the dessert selections available.

"Our desserts business is up substantially," Wood said. "We have a dessert cart, and that seems to be very popular. The chocolate mousse here is very good, and we also have some excellent torts."

Since he took over the Canopy last year, Wood has been pleased with the business he's doing.

"We've had a real good response," he said. "We're doing better now than the restaurant did in the past. I've been really happy with the way things are going."

And if you've ever been scared away from the Canopy by the fear that it's too stuffy a place for you, fear not.

It's an elegant place, but it's also a fun place.
