Planners OK Silver Beech

Despite opposition from surrounding residents, developers of Silver Beech Estates, a proposed cluster housing development, received special land use approval for their project from city planners.

Novi Planning Commission conducted a well-attended public hearing on special land use for the proposed development at its Oct. 5 meeting.

Planners voted 7-2 to grant special land use, but voted 9-0 to table action on the preliminary site plan until further information is provided.

Silver Beech Estates is a 74-lot detached single-family cluster housing project proposed at the northwest corner of the Nine Mile/Beck Road intersection.

City zoning laws require that developers receive special land use for projects which are categorized as cluster housing developments. The cluster option is meant to save woodlands and wetlands by allowing developers to "cluster" units together in smaller areas, preserv-

ing more environmentally sensitive lands elsewhere on the overall site.

Cluster developments are allowed in all of Novi's residential zoning classifications except R-A (residential agricultural), which is reserved for large-lot, single-family residential development. The property slated for development of Silver Beech Estates is zoned R-1.

Developers of the project received special land use from the planning commission in May, contingent upon approval of a variance from the Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA). A variance was needed to waive woodland/wetland area percentages required by the clustering option because developers fell slightly short of the mandated space.

The ZBA denied the developer's request, forcing them to revise the site plans and appear before the planning commission again.

Michael Rein of Bauers & Rein Associates — representing the developer — indicated to planners that 10 additional acres of land would be purchased to bring the site into compliance with clustering re-

Rezoning eyed for supermarket in western Novi

Residents in the western areas of Novi soon may not have to travel very far for milk, bread, eggs and other essentials from the grocery store.

The Novi Planning Commission has helped clear the way for development of a commercial shopping center on a 10-acre parcel at the Ten Mile/Beck Road intersection by voting to recommend the parcel be rezoned to a commercial classification.

The proposed shopping center is expected to include a supermarket, gas station and perhaps a sit-down restaurant.

Specifically, planners voted 8-1 at their Oct. 5 meeting to recommend that the 10-acre parcel on the northeast corner of the Ten Mile/Beck Road intersection be rezoned from its existing B-1 (general business) and R-4 (single-family residential) classifications to B-2 (commercial business).

Commissioner Edward Kramer

cast the lone dissenting vote, stating that he didn't think the timing was appropriate for the rezoning.

"Eventually, yes," Kramer said about the rezoning. "Now? Why now?"

Kramer pointed out that several shopping centers in the city have vacancies and questioned whether or not the market could support another shopping area.

In defense of the rezoning, Commissioner Thomas Kavanagh said he thought the planning commission should leave business risk issues up to the entrepreneur.

However, Kramer was not alone in his criticism.

Resident Laura Lorenzo acknowledged that she was opposed to the rezoning because it would encroach upon the existing residential area and would damage the area's integrity.

Al Tuomaala of Siegal-Tuomaala Associates, Architects/Planners Inc., indicated that a major super-

Video renters seek ease

The Novi News, in the second part of a two-part series on video tape rental stores, examines hot titles, "the video experience," and what one should know before choosing a store to do business with.

One word about sums it up for the average video tape renter — convenience.

Renters constantly seek a more convenient way to rent tapes, and they have plenty of outlets to choose from now.

With increased competition now firmly putting its thumbprint on the industry, store operators have chosen a variety of different paths to increase convenient service. Most of it appears to be directed to the renter's benefit.

"This is a business that depends almost entirely on

convenience," said Esther Shapiro, director of the Detroit Consumer Affairs Division. "If it becomes too cumbersome, too difficult, shoppers now have the opportunity to look elsewhere."

"It's the convenience, more than the other factors involved," she said.

Stores have been pushed to implement later hours and early morning drop-off periods. They have changed the base rates they charge for tape rentals, altered so-called late fees, and generally implemented procedures to cut down on the amount of time that renters must spend in the stores to rent and drop off tapes.

A most convenient time to drop off tapes has proven to be on the way to work in the morning, yet most video stores don't staff their outlets until 10 or 11 a.m. As a result, some have added mail slots for returning tapes, while others have adopted time-sharing plans with neighboring stores.

Wixom woodman gets sentence

Wixom woodman Henry Lee "Hank" Johnson was sentenced Monday to 27 to 50 years in prison for the February killing of an off-duty Wayne County Sheriff's Deputy.

Johnson received a mandatory two-year sentence for using a firearm to commit a felony, plus a 25 to 50 year sentence for second-degree murder.

The sentence means Johnson, 60, will be eligible for parole in 18 to 20 years, according to Oakland County Assistant Prosecutor Frederick Miller.

Johnson has entered a request for an appeal, court officials said Tuesday.

The Wixom man was convicted last month of killing deputy Russell Francis Dickson, 36, of Livonia after an apparent dispute over a firewood sale.

Johnson allegedly shot and killed Dickson Feb. 7, then attempted to hide his body in a rural Wixom fire near Twelve Mile and Napier Road. An autopsy revealed that Dickson died of multiple gunshot wounds to the head.

Johnson was well-known in the area for operating a firewood sales business out of his home in southern Wixom.

"There apparently had been some dispute," Miller said. "Dickson apparently told his wife 'No one is going to talk to me like that' after talking to Johnson on the phone."

"It's a tragedy in a sense that Dickson was entering the reclusive world of Henry Johnson," Miller said. "He probably had no idea what he was getting into."

Johnson had a lengthy history of run-ins with the police and at least one other felony conviction. He had

Radon testing escalates

Radon testing kits sold out quickly last week, although Novi officials restocked the supply by Wednesday (Oct. 12) morning.

Building Department officials report selling about 90 of the testing kits Friday, Oct. 7, after a week's worth of news reports pointing to high levels of the gas in southwestern Oakland County homes.

Another 25 residents were placed on a waiting list to receive the kits.

The colorless, odorless, radioactive gas occurs naturally as a result of breakdown of uranium in soils. Prolonged exposure to high levels of the gas can lead to lung cancer.

"It's a very positive step to see people testing their homes," said Alex Johnson of the American Lung Association of Southeast Michigan.

"We're getting more results and we're better able to get a handle on the extent of the problem."

"That's what we recommend... that people test," he added.

Novi made test results available to residents last week after the Lung Association released a report indicating dangerously high levels of the gas in 75 percent of the homes tested in the Novi-Milford area. However, it appears as if that conclusion was based on data gained from about four local homes.

Overall, the Lung Association tested about 300 homes in the metro Detroit area.

The price of the test kit was changed by the city last week from \$13.50 to \$13.

Test results will be made available in about two weeks. Johnson said the Lung Association has been sticking to that schedule, despite the fact that they are receiving "thousands" of the kits from the metro Detroit area.

remove the flag during high winds. Feldman said he disagreed with "many" of the points made in the report. "Up and down Grand River, you have flagpoles that are much closer to the wires than mine," he said. "They have been in to inspect us before - at our request - and never mentioned anything about the flagpole." He said the windy conditions came up "all of the sudden."

Feldman said he will appeal the fine. "I don't see how anyone could have predicted a sudden weather change," he said. "I feel very badly that it happened - it was a freak of nature."

Yerkes said the \$480 fine was based on a formula taking into account the degree of hazard and the number of employees exposed. It isn't necessarily based on the degree of injury to employees, he said.

Companies can be fined between \$50 and \$1,000. The Michigan Department of Labor is responsible for enforcing a series of workplace safety requirements.

Robertson primes 'A' battle

Robertson spoke about the Michigan ballot question and urged those attending to attract additional supporters, Ireland said. The tax-funded abortion question has lingered for about 15 years in Michigan, ever since state funding for elective abortions began in 1974.

The issue was finally taken out of the legislature's hands last year when the Michigan Committee to End Tax-Funded Abortions sponsored a petition drive to allow the question to be placed on the ballot. That question effectively allows Michigan voters to make law with their vote in the Nov. 8 election.

Proponents of the measure object to using tax dollars for the practice, while opponents say revoking the funds would deny poor women the right to have abortions performed in a clinical environment, besides creating a possible increase of future welfare cases later.

Road fee outlook looking very grim

Although a proposed \$25 vehicle registration fee in Oakland County has garnered some political backing, many supporters of the measure remain pessimistic about its chances of gaining voter approval Nov. 8.

"There is some support out there for it, but it is unfortunate that it is not going to pass. People just aren't going to vote for a tax increase," said Pat Jacobs, former spokesperson for the "Keep Your Oakland County Roads Moving" committee.

Jacobs said many of the volunteers from her group planned to work with a second committee, the "Community Alliance for Roads" (CAR), which also formed earlier this year to promote the proposal.

Jacobs:
'There is some support out there for it, but it is unfortunate that it is not going to pass. People just aren't going to vote for a tax increase.'

CAR Chairperson Ken Strobel said recently his group has a \$50,000 budget to promote the fee, which, he says, is necessary even if it is "just a partial solution to the road woes."

The Oakland County Road Commission said the fee, which would be levied on motor vehicles registered to anyone living within the county, would raise about \$20 million a year. Over its 10-year life, it would then generate \$200 million of a projected \$750 million needed for road repairs and improvements.

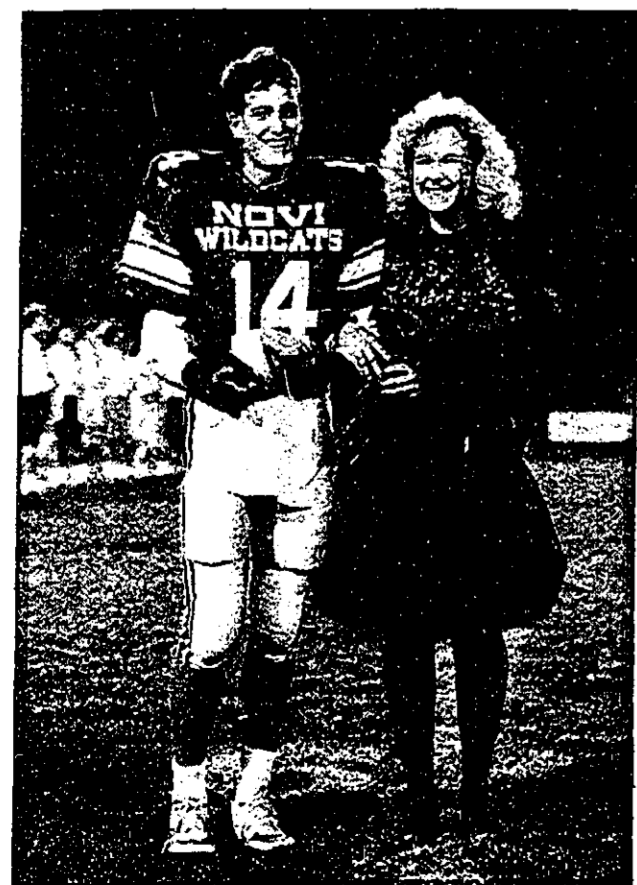
Novi fans root for the Wildcats to bring home another victory

Planners recommend rezoning at intersection

market chain is proposed for the corner. He said a commitment from the chain has not been secured yet, but speculated that there wouldn't be a problem in doing so.

"Tuomala was representing the Briarwood of Novi partners, who requested the rezoning.

"We feel this particular site is a logical spot for a commercial shopping center," Tuomala told the planning commission. "The marketing support and need is there for such a site... the western section of Novi is devoid of a shopping market/retail use."

He stated that 1,683 housing units already exist within a one-mile radius of the proposed zoning area, and an additional 1,636 units are pro-

posed. Tuomala argued that the timing was indeed appropriate, since it would take at least two years to complete the project if the rezoning were approved by the city.

City Planning Consultant Bradon Rogers reminded the planning commission that the Ten Mile/Beck Road intersection is slated for a shopping center use on the city's amended master plan.

"There are a number of subdivisions that are generating a market for a neighborhood shopping center," Rogers remarked.

Existing and proposed subdivisions in the area include Braes of Novi, Pebble Ridge, Yorkshire Place, Simmons Orchards, Briarwood of Novi, Hummingbird Estates, Cedar Springs and Green Orchard Meadows. Commissioner Kathleen McAllen

asked what effect a 600-plus parking lot would have on the traffic traveling Beck Road.

Traffic Consultant Rod Arroyo commented that the shopping center would most likely capture traffic from the existing traffic stream. He estimated that 30 to 40 percent of the traffic generated by the proposed commercial center is already on the road, and cars entering and exiting the parking lot would be those that already use the route.

"I think the intersection could handle the use," Arroyo said.

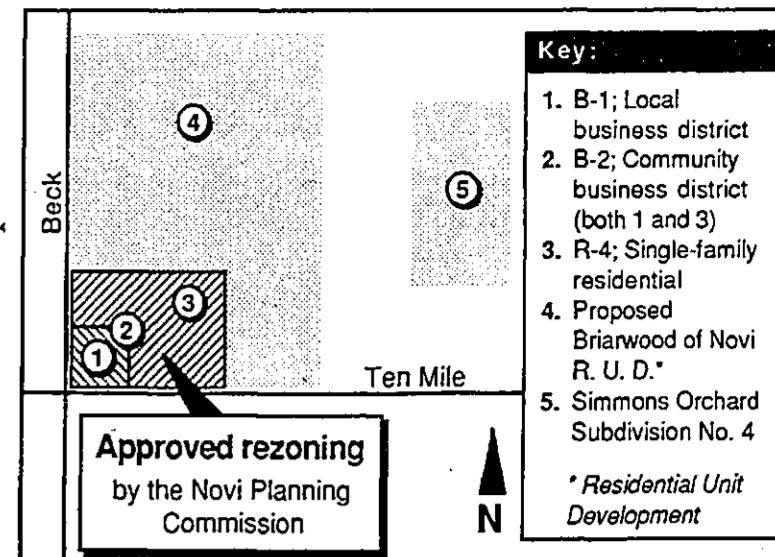
Engineering Consultant Deborah Gosselin remarked that Tuomala's housing unit estimate was on the "conservative side." She said a great deal of the proposed subdivisions and developments in the area are ex-

pected to reach build-out in two to three years because of the recent availability of sewer taps.

"If we're going to do something on the west side, we could do it right on 10 acres," Commissioner John Balagna commented. "If we don't rezone, we're going to get another small strip mall like the ones we already have."

Commission Vice Chairperson Judith Johnson also spoke in favor of the rezoning, stating that the western area needs a shopping market.

"We had planned for commercial at this corner — this is the best intersection to serve the western side of the city. This is an opportunity to bring the zoning in conformance of the master plan," Commission Chairperson Charles Kureth said.

Video stores compete by providing convenience

A Commerce Township video store, which used to accept no returns until it opened in the early afternoon, now allows its tapes to be dropped off at the 24-hour party store next door.

Other stores routinely rent their tapes on a two or three day basis, for slightly higher rates. It's a trade-off for the customer, especially ones who are too busy or simply not very good with deadlines.

Novi Video, near Ten Mile and Meadowbrook Road, has late charges which are actually about one-half of the daily rate, decreasing the incentive to immediately return the tape.

For instance, if a renter took out a tape that costs \$2 to rent overnight, they would be "fined" an extra dollar — a total of \$3 — for keeping it an extra night.

Shapiro: 'This is a business that depends almost entirely on convenience. If it becomes too cumbersome, too difficult, shoppers now have the opportunity to look elsewhere.'

Choosing a store has become relatively easy. With the phasing out of most store membership fees, lifetime memberships can now be ac-

quired with a license, credit card and a signature. Other than maybe a slightly increased load of junk mail over the course of a year, there

seems to be no disadvantage to the "shotgun" approach — joining as many video clubs as possible. About the only local store to still have membership fees is TSV Video, near Ten Mile and Meadowbrook Road. The store charges a \$19.95 fee, but offers paying members a 50 cent discount on each tape rented. The membership fee pays for itself if you're a frequent renter, said owner John McGill.

"The optional paid membership offers a different price scale. It's proven to be pretty attractive for a lot of our customers," he said. Free memberships are also offered at the TSV outlet. "Free" members simply pay a higher "per video" price.

It's difficult to get a tab on what the average video customer prefers, but it appears as if most rent from more than one store, with about 70 to 80 percent of their business going to one

rental outlet. Renters must choose between the larger "McVideos," which offer an expanded tape base and sometimes lower costs, or the smaller, "mom-and-pop" organizations, which place their strengths on personal service and first-name basis familiarity with their customers.

Other factors involved include:

- Availability of adult movies. Are they kept in a discreet location away from teenagers and younger children? Are they available for adults who are interested in them?
- Amount of children's selections. The number of special programs for children or special rental rates.
- Availability of older movies, classics or rare titles. Not all stores have these readily available.

Use of waiting lists or reserved lists for titles that may be in high demand. Some stores are shying away from reserving tapes or placing

customers on waiting lists. Shapiro said customers should watch closely for any hidden costs that may come with signing up with a video store. She said there have been relatively few complaints about the industry as a whole, but that consumers should still stay on guard.

"I think you're going to start to see some of the gimmicks come up now," she said.

This is a slow time of year for video rental outlets, though they are bracing for the last week in October. That's when the legendary "E.T." movie hits the video stores. Most stores in the area have already developed long waiting or purchase lists for the big day — around Oct. 27.

Other big titles for the fall season include "She's Having a Baby," "Masquerade," "Moonstruck," "Broadcast News," "Planes, Trains, and Automobiles" and "Suspect."

Car phones

Are they status symbols or useful business tools?



A dying fad or a useful business tool? When they were introduced four years ago, car phones were the rage of society's upper crust. And with the possible exception of Space Invaders, car phones were considered by many to be a technological marvel.

But four years later, the public's intrigue with car phones has seemed to peak and only the business world has been able to utilize its services, according to local car phone dealers. "It's still selling pretty well, but as an individual dealer my sales have tapered off since they (car phones) were introduced in November 1984," said Brian Murray, manager of Murray's Car Audio in Novi.

Murray noted that his store caters to the business crowd, "because the car phone is seen as a tool which will aid in productivity."

He added that people who buy car phones for their novelty aspect usually shop at appliance stores, where prices are often cheaper. "The most reliable car phones will usually cost the most," Murray said. Jeff Muglia, manager of Midwest Communications in Southfield, said people who bought car phones during their early days in the marketplace did so because they represented a status symbol.

"Now, the single business owner and people in sales positions are buying car phones because of the time it saves," Muglia said.

As for the mechanics of using a car phone, Muglia said the system is run on a series of antennas that are placed about 10 square miles apart. He noted the signals from a car phone are transferred from one antenna to the next as the vehicle moves through a given area. "This type of system allows for a signal to always be picked up," Muglia explained.

Murray said the phone system, which in Michigan is available through Ameritech or Cellular One, is accessible only in southern Michigan. Although the car phone system is available in each of the 50 states, Murray said antennas have only been installed in and around large metropolitan areas, meaning rural locations are not hooked up to the system.

Muglia explained the types of car phones are divided into three areas: mobile or permanent, transportable, and portable.

A mobile or permanent car phone consists of three parts — a handset, receiver and antenna. Muglia said the antenna is the most important aspect of the mobile phone.

He said there are three types of antennas which can access the mobile phone, including glass mount, trunk lip mount, or roof mount. "With the proper antenna and installation it is hard to tell if you are talking at your desk or car," Muglia said, adding mobile phones range from \$500 to \$1,300.

Transportable phones — like mobile phones — operate on three watts of power, which is the maximum amount allowed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). Transportable phones consist of the same parts as the mobile phone, but they are smaller in size and are manufactured to be used outside, meaning they are more durable.

Besides being able to take these phones out of the car, users can plug transportable phones into their cigarette lighter, creating less of a strain on the battery, according to Muglia. Transportable phones range in price from \$750 to \$1,500.

Muglia said the third type of car phone is a portable or handheld model. These phones only operate on .6 watts of power, resulting in poorer reception.

Muglia said the attraction of portable phones is that they can fit into briefcases or shirt pockets, making them easy to carry. Portable phones range in cost from \$1,200 to \$2,000.


When purchasing a car phone, Muglia said the first step is to conduct a credit check on the individual. If the credit check is successful, he said most stores can install and program the phone to begin service.

In addition to a \$35 hook-up fee from the phone company, charges include a \$7.50 per month user fee and a peak (7 a.m. to 9 p.m.) usage fee of \$.35 per minute or off-peak (9 p.m. to 7 a.m. and all weekends and holidays) fee of \$.16 per minute. Muglia added all long distance rates charged from American Telephone and Telegraph (AT & T) are extra.

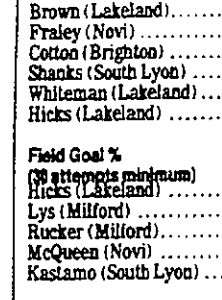

More people watch cholesterol

Ten years ago, it might not have happened — two ladies, lunching, chatting about their latest cholesterol counts over crisp, green salads.

Now, it's become rather commonplace.

The awareness level about cholesterol is as high as ever, health experts report. Pin prick tests are now readily available to the general public, while information about the risks is widely distributed by health organizations and government agencies.

"In the last year, the Michigan public has become acutely more aware that preventative medicine is very important," said Michigan Heart Association Project Director Thomas Matz.

Cholesterol content in the bloodstream basically increases with a diet heavily laden with animal fats or dairy products. It serves to increase the amount of solids in the bloodstream, clogging arteries or shrinking veins which carry blood to vital parts of the body.

Combined with other risk factors, high cholesterol can play a major role in causing heart attack or stroke.

Even with a new awareness, public health officials say plenty of education still lies ahead. There are plenty of avenues to unhealthy eating — avenues which may play a role in serious health problems later.

"What we are trying to do is educate the public so they can make

healthier choices," said Michigan Department of Health, Wellness Manager George Lafkas. "We hope those choices will lead the demand for different products."

One culprit, Lafkas said, is still "fast food," although the industry has made some changes brought about by shifts in consumer demands.

Some fast-food restaurants are now using low-fat oils for deep frying, in addition to reducing the amount of fat content in their meats. Most are now offering a full range of chicken products, which are an alternative to red meats, and in turn, cholesterol content, for a lot of eaters.

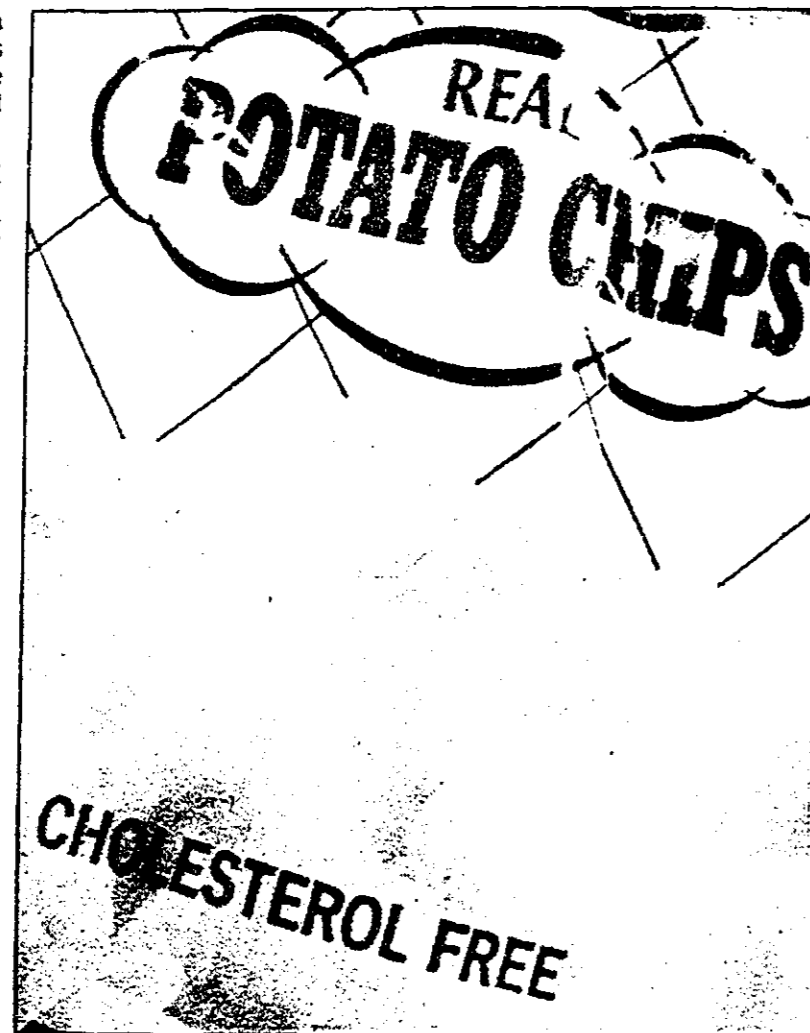
The Health Department last week held a seminar on what foods contain the least cholesterol in the fast-food environment.

So-called "junk food" products, like potato chips, have diversified their offerings of low cholesterol and low salt products.

"They really aren't going to change until the public demands it," Lafkas said.

Cholesterol tests monitor the amount of cholesterol in a very small amount of blood — per deciliter, or one-tenth of a liter. Readings of 200 or less are considered normal. Readings between 200-239 are considered borderline and call for some changes in diet.

Results over 240 call for changes in diet, increased exercise and, if high enough (over 300), perhaps medication to control the levels.

Family escape plan lowers fire threat

October is Fire Prevention Month and now is the time to consider what you can do to prevent fire in your home and how to react in case you or a family member becomes a victim of fire.

Needless waste of lives and property can be easily prevented through education on fire safety and by developing a family escape plan from your home.

Causes/Prevention: Three elements — air, fuel and heat — are necessary for a fire to start. Paper, cloth, grease, wood and combustibles such as oily rags and paint are common household fuels involved in fires. Take an inventory of your home and get rid of any unnecessary items, especially if stored in the attic, basement or closets. Also be aware of the following to help prevent fires.

Smoke Detectors: Place smoke detectors at the top of stairs and near sleeping areas. Batteries should be tested and changed periodically.

Fireplaces: Special attention is required for fireplaces. Use a screen to prevent flying sparks and logs from rolling out. Keep dampers open and never use flammable liquids to start a fire.

Matches and Lighters: Children are frequently fascinated with matches

and lighters, and often get burned while experimenting. Satisfy children's curiosities while educating them to the dangers of fire. Keep matches and lighters out of children's reach and never allow them to play with them.

Heaters: Take time to have your heating devices inspected and cleaned before use. Portable electric heaters should be used and installed according to manufacturer's instructions. All space heaters and wiring should have UL (Underwriter's Laboratory) approval.

Propane heaters: should have protective screening around the heat source; keep all heating devices away from combustibles. People, especially children, should not wear loose clothing near heaters.

Fireplaces: Special attention is required for fireplaces. Check bricks on older fireplaces. Use a screen to prevent flying sparks and logs from rolling out. Keep dampers open and never use flammable liquids to start a fire.

Baby sitters: should be instructed in safe fire practices before being left alone with children.

Emphasize that children are not to be left unattended. In case of fire, children should be led from the house in a calm and reassuring manner and prevented from returning to the home. Discuss pre-planned escape routes and have phone numbers for

the fire and rescue department easily accessible.

When handling a fire emergency, don't panic and remember to save lives first. Get your family safely outside and then call the fire department.

Develop an escape plan that includes alternate routes. It is one of the single most important factors in your family's survival of a house fire. Decide on a meeting place outside the house where everyone will assemble as soon as they are outside. Never return to a burning house.

Pay particular attention to the bedrooms since nighttime fires are usually the most serious, and children tend to panic and hide in closets or under beds. Everyone should sleep with their bedroom door closed at night. A closed door can delay the spread of fire and keep out deadly gasses and smoke for the few minutes needed to escape.

Check all windows and make sure that bedroom windows, screens or storm can be opened easily by children. It may be impossible to get out through a high window or to open a window that is painted shut or blocked by an air conditioner. Explain to children how to break window glass and how to clear away pieces of glass remaining in the frame.

Getting down from a second-story window may require a rope or folding

ladder. Agree on a way that any member of the family can sound an alarm since the fire may block hallways and prevent you from reaching other bedrooms. Time should not be wasted collecting possessions.

If the panels or knob of a door is warm, the door should be kept closed and an alternate escape route used. If the door is not hot, brace your foot and hip against the door and open cautiously to prevent extremely heated air from blowing it open. If no hot air or smoke is present, it is probably safe to pass through.

If you are forced to remain in a room, stay near a slightly open window with towels or clothes placed in door cracks. To cross a smoke-filled room, crawl with your head about 18 inches above the floor. Hang a sheet outside the window to signal for help.

Taking the time to prepare your home and family for a fire emergency is a responsibility that any parent can easily accomplish. Please obtain more detailed information and advice on fire prevention from your local fire department.

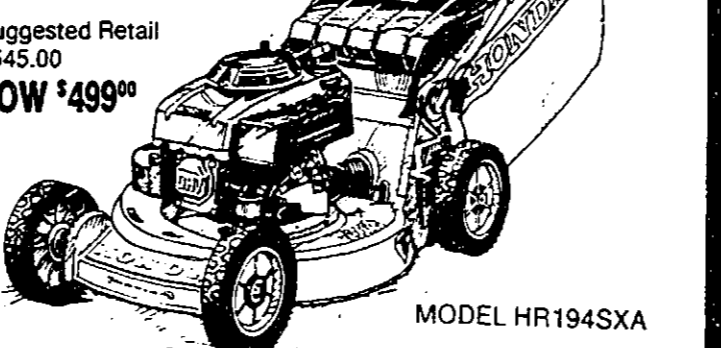

Proper care keeps your heater running

For toasty toes

There is perhaps no greater inconvenience of winter driving than a heater that won't work.

Most passenger compartment heaters use the coolant to warm the incoming fresh air. In addition to providing driver and passenger comfort, the warm air directed to the inside of the windshield generally prevents fogging or icing which obscures vision.

The personal distress of cold fingers and toes can be avoided, says the Gates Rubber Company, by inspecting the heat-producing cooling system components in your car.

Troubleshooting should begin with the coolant level in the radiator (just below the filler neck) and mixture (50 percent each water and antifreeze). A low level will reduce or cancel the flow of coolant to the heater, thereby reducing or preventing any heat output.

The radiator pressure cap helps to raise and control the temperature of the coolant in the system. It should be replaced if the seal or gasket is damaged, or if the spring is broken.

The thermostat acts as a heat sensitive valve which regulates the flow of coolant to the radiator. When the thermostat fails or malfunctions, the engine either will overheat or take longer to get any heat, because the engine will take longer to reach proper operating temperature. It is a good practice to replace a thermostat if you're in doubt, advises Gates.

Flexible hoses convey the liquid coolant between the radiator and the engine. They should be inspected for softness, cracks and cuts. In normal service, they are affected by air, heat, chemicals, oil and constant vibration.

These conditions either could harden or crack hoses, which destroys flexibility and causes leakage, or soften and swell the hoses, producing lining failure and hose rupture.

Two other important hoses run parallel from the engine to the heater, normally found under the dashboard. These, too, should be checked for swelling and cracks, and for abrasion to the hose cover where the hoses come in contact with the engine block.

The water pump and fan drive might be called the heart of the cooling system. Coolant circulates throughout the engine by means of the water pump, which is driven by a rubber belt.

Loose or worn belts could mean failure of the drive. Check the condition of the drive belts by turning them over. Gates suggests. Replace any that are cracked, frayed, brittle, wet with oil or highly polished on the sides that contact the pulleys.

Regardless of the visual condition, belts that are more than four years old should be replaced, according to Gates.

These troubleshooting procedures could solve the problem of a malfunctioning heating system. Other trouble areas, such as a clogged or leaking heating core, faulty electrical connections and fuses, a broken blower motor or a non-operating heater control valve, should be checked by an experienced mechanic.

At the very least, this exercise will prepare your cooling system for the hard winter months ahead.

Give your car a new winter coat

Just like you, your car's body needs a good "coat" for wintertime, protecting it from ice, snow, salt and grime.

A basic step in preparing a car for winter weather is to wash and wax it thoroughly. However, many people risk ruining the car's shine because all they are determined to use for winter prep is a "durable" car wax.

Many car waxes that are dubbed "durable" also may be those that contain harsh abrasives that will damage the "clear coat" finishes of today's cars. They end up doing more harm than good.

Since the early 1980's most cars have been painted with a clear coat finish that is actually a non-pigment layer of paint that adds depth and durability to the shine.

One problem with clear coats is that waxing them with a highly abrasive wax will cause white "swirl" marks or hazing—resulting in a lackluster shine and a damaged finish.

"Ideally a wax should be durable,

be easy to apply and not scratch your car," says Dr. Jim Latty, Armour All Product Corp.'s vice president of research and development. "That's what we set out to do in developing Armour All's first car wax product."

To locate ingredients that would be safe for clear coat paints, yet deliver a durable, high shine, Armour All went to the jewelry industry to acquire the same grade of polishing agents used by jewelers to shine crystal and gold. These polishing agents are five times finer than traditional automotive wax polishing agents.

Proper tire care pro-extends tread life

Proper tire care can prolong tire life by 50 percent or more—saving you money and making your automobile safer. Modern radial tires are designed to last about 40,000 miles, but many motorists must replace tires early because they failed to take proper care of their tires.

According to experts at the Goodyear Tire & Rubber Co., the average motorist spends more on tire care each year than he does on any other replacement part of his car. This cost can be considerably reduced simply by performing weekly wear tire and inflation checks.

The single worst thing you can do to your tires is to run them underinflated. Tires that are underinflated run hotter and have a higher failure rate than most with correct inflation. But you can't always tell when a tire is underinflated simply by looking at it. Modern low-profile tires often look low when they are at correct pressure. Have the tires checked with an accurate tire pressure gauge. Don't rely on the service station air pump. These units are frequently off by as much as four pounds.

The National Tire Dealers & Retailers Association recommends that you carry a tire gauge in the glove box or have your tires checked by your local tire dealer. Underinflated tires also increase rolling resistance and can decrease fuel economy by as much as a mile per gallon!

Another common mistake that many people make is to overinflate their tires. Putting too much air in a tire is almost as bad as not enough. An overinflated tire rolls more easily and actually may help

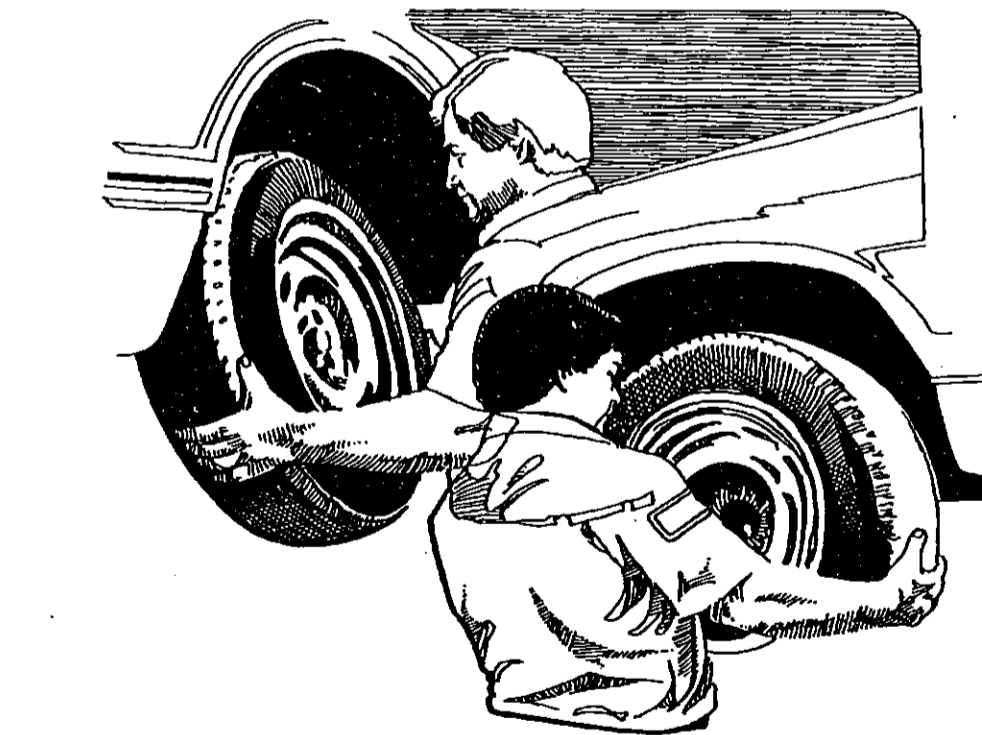
fuel economy a little, but fuel savings are more than offset by excessive tread wear.

Proper inflation is not, however, the only cause of tire wear. Uneven tire wear can also be caused by a misaligned suspension or an out-of-balance tire. Uneven wear and scalloping also can be an indication that the shock absorbers are bad. Keeping your wheels in alignment, tires balanced, and making sure your shocks are in good condition will go a long way toward extending tire life.

Another factor in increasing tire life is rotation. Experts at the Rubber Manufacturers Association recommended that tires be rotated every 6,000 to 8,000 miles. The rotation pattern is noted in your auto owner's manual. If, however, you notice uneven wear, rotating the tires won't solve the problem. You'll need to have your vehicle checked and any problems corrected.

No matter how carefully you take care of your tires, sooner or later they will wear out. To alert you to the fact that the tread depth is reaching a critical level, tire manufacturers have built wear indicators into your tires. These treadless strips appear across the tread pattern to warn the motorist that only one-sixth of an inch of tread remains and that the tires should be replaced. Driving on tires with wear indicators showing is illegal as well as dangerous. Don't try to squeeze a few extra miles out of your tires. Replace them as soon as the wear bars show through.

Getting the most mileage out of your tires takes little time and costs almost



nothing. In fact, the extra mileage you get from taking care of your tires is like putting money in the bank.

The following tips and suggestions are intended to help you get the most from your tires:

□ Tire types and tire pressures differ from car to car. Check your owner's manual for the correct tire type and inflation pressure.

□ Purchase an inexpensive tire gauge and keep it in the glove box. These gauges

only cost a few dollars and can be purchased at any auto parts store.

□ Don't forget to check the spare. Over time, spare tires can lose air.

□ Don't exceed the recommended load weight for your car. Overloading can affect performance, safety, and cause severe tire damage.

□ When replacing a tire, don't mix tire types. Mixing radial and bias-ply tires can affect the handling and safety of the vehicle.

First-timers need checklist when buying new vehicles



Look closely at the automobile ads in your favorite magazines. The female model is more likely to be in a business suit behind the wheel rather than perched on the bumper in a bikini.

The reason for the change in ad focus? Pure economics. As more women are bringing home paychecks than they did 15 years ago, more are buying cars on their own or being the main decision-maker on the purchase.

□ Take time to research the market, says automotive expert Jack R. Nerad of Motor Trend magazine. There are just too many choices. Also, take time to assess your needs since too often car buyers dive into the market without even bothering to determine what kind of car fits their particular circumstance.

Family Circle magazine suggests reading automotive and consumer magazines, quizzing friends about what problems they've had with their cars and even checking with a loan officer at the bank or credit union about car loan rates. Take a few weeks to determine what you want.

□ Next, head for the showrooms with a list of your top four or five cars. Don't fall in love with Consumer Reports editors. Make sure the dealership you finally decide to buy from offers you the fairest deal and will be equally cooperative about servicing after your purchase.

Take time to inspect the car's physical features, like steering wheel angles and legroom, passenger and trunk space and the car's interior and exterior finish, suggests Family Circle. Don't be tempted to buy because of pressure from the salesman; it's best to go home, think it over and then narrow your list.

□ Once that list is trimmed to just one or two models, it's time for a test drive. Family Circle suggests doing all the test drives in one day, using one route for all. If possible, include highway and city streets, hills and bumpy roads, and make the entire drive last from 20 to 30 minutes. After each test drive, note your reactions—if you aren't happy with the performance now, chances are you won't be later, either.

□ After your testing and research, you should be able to come to a final decision. Now comes the bargaining. Remember that the car market is the last of the great American sales frontiers—the sticker



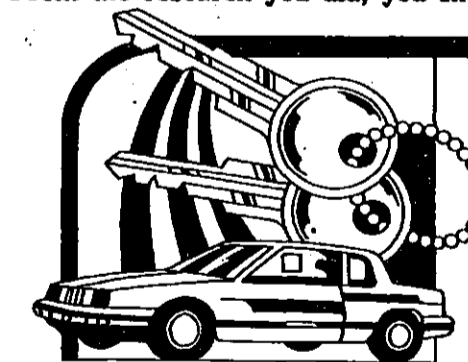

price is negotiable, not absolute. How much you can negotiate depends on the kind of car you're buying and demand. From the research you did, you should

have an idea of how much the car will cost with the options you want, keeping in mind the dealership will make a profit. □ Finally, get the whole deal down in

writing. Be sure all conditions of the sale—such as used car trade-in allowances and financing rates—are noted in writing.



Use air conditioner to defog windows this year

simultaneously dries it as it cools.

Inside the evaporator, low pressure refrigerant gas, called freon, evaporates and turns to vapor, absorbing heat in the same way that your hand will get cold from holding a piece of ice—your hand is giving up that heat which is absorbed by the ice. Your hand then feels colder.

As the car's warm interior air passes over the cooler air conditioner's evaporator, moisture also condenses on it, just like on that can of cold soda pop. This moisture collects on the evaporator, and is discharged outside the car after it accumulates as a liquid.

This is the manner in which the air conditioner dries the interior air as it cools, and therefore reduces the tendency for

the windows to fog.

If the idea of using your air conditioner to assist in defrosting your windows sounds to off beat, then at least take the other piece of advice being offered by Saab.

During the winter, Saab says, your car's air conditioning system should be switched on once or twice a month, and run five or ten minutes each time. This practice helps prevent deterioration of compressor gaskets and seals.

When you run your air conditioner, the compressor is lubricated by a special oil which circulates with the refrigerant. When you do run the air conditioner in winter, be sure the outside air temperature is above approximately 35 degrees.
