## Will he stand trial? Watkins is to undergo evaluation

Frederick Watkins, accused of murder, will undergo a psychiatric evaluation to determine if he is fit to stand trial for the Sept. 26 stabbing death of his wife of 47 years.

Walled Lake 52-1 District Court Judge Harold Bulgarelli agreed to order the evaluation after Watkins' attorney, Dennis Szokolay, said his client was unable to understand the court proceedings.

"As he sits here, he is in a stuporous state," Szokolay told the court Friday morning. "As he sits here he is unable to comprehend the seriousness of this matter and unable to understand the court proceedings."

Szokolay said Watkins, who was taking numerous prescription medications, is unable to remember the events surrounding the death of his wife, Theresa. He has filed an intent to use the insanity plea as a defense.

Theresa Watkins, 68, died the morning of Sept. 26 after police broke into their Country Place condominium and reportedly found Watkins holding a butcher knife,

which was plunged into her chest. Autopsy results indicated that she had been stabbed more than 20 times.

Police arrived four minutes after she called 9-1-1 and pleaded for help, but it was too late to save her. On the seven-minute 9-1-1 tape, Theresa Watkins repeatedly identifies her husband as the attacker.

Watkins, 76, appeared unable to recognize family members who attended the court proceeding on Friday. One woman reached forward and put her hand on his shoulder, called him several times by his nickname "Skip" and told him that she loves him. But he responded only with a blank look.

Szokolay said he has to keep explaining the situation to Watkins, who remains confused.

"He doesn't have any recollection of what happened that morning, but he knows he's in jail and he knows he's accused of murder," Szokolay said. "He's very depressed about it. He's ashamed."

He was unsure whether Watkins is aware that his wife is dead.

"This morning, again, he asked me why he was in court. I had to explain to him again that he is ac-

cused of murdering his wife."

Szokolay said he suspects that the stabbing, as well as Watkins' current state of mind, are the result of a bad reaction to medication.

Police found a medicine cabinet full of different prescription drugs. Watkins reportedly suffered from diabetes, heart problems, depression, and a head injury sustained in a car accident last July. He was also recovering from a stroke.

Szokolay said three of the drugs currently prescribed to Watkins are Haldol, Miconase and Cardizem. He said all three were prescribed by different doctors, but all were filled at Arbor Drugs, which has a computer network designed to identify incompatible prescriptions.

Haldol, a drug classified as an anti-psychotic, was prescribed to treat depression, he said. Miconase is an oral diabetes treatment, and Cardizem is a common heart medication used to regulate blood pressure.

Todd Hoerauf, a pharmacist for Providence Medical Center—Providence Park in Novi, said Haldol is not a commonly used drug because

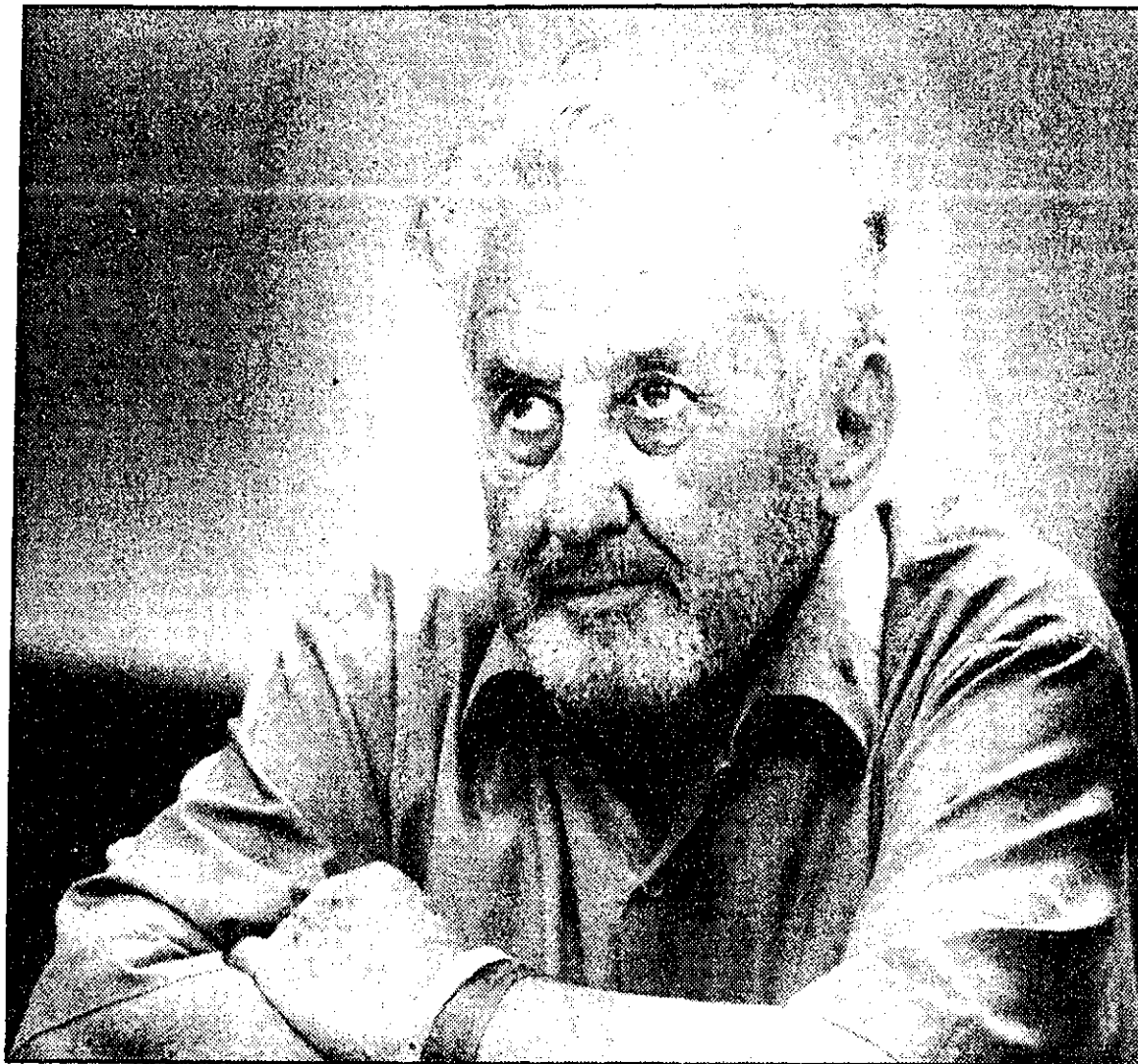

Continued on 4 Fred "Skip" Watkins watches the proceedings during his preliminary examination Friday.

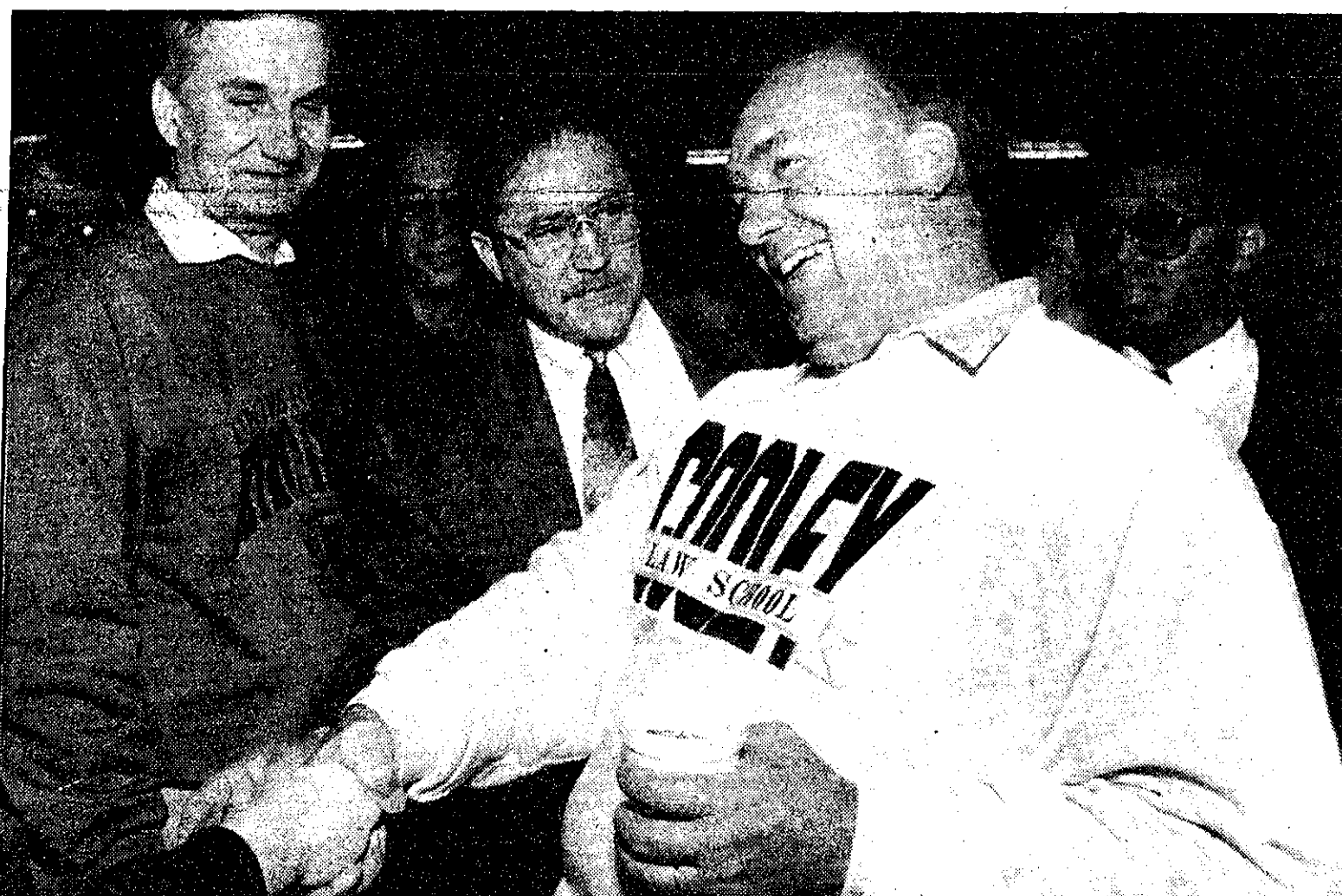

## Wolpe criticizes S.B. One, Engler

Former U.S. Congressman Howard Wolpe paid a visit to Novi last week and criticized state legislators, Gov. John Engler foremost of all, for their "reckless and potentially dangerous" moves in public school funding.

"Public education is threatened in Michigan as never before," Wolpe said during an annual breakfast meeting of the Novi Youth Assistance Oct. 6. He said that lawmakers made a rash and wrong decision earlier this summer when they passed Senate Bill One into law. That measure eliminated property taxes which fund general school operations — some \$6.5 billion in all.

Wolpe, a former Congressional representative from the Ingham County area, is a declared Republican candidate for governor. Engler is expected to run for re-election next year for the job he won in 1990.

Wiping out the funding mechanism for schools, Wolpe said, before deciding on a new one is a foolish strategy.

"I sort of compare it to heart transplant surgery," Wolpe said. "It's nice to have the replacement heart ready, or the patient won't do very well."

Wolpe, calling legislators' actions "a game of political one-upmanship," described the way one journalist recounted how Senate Bill One was

passed:

"It was a game of political chicken, and no one blinked." The candidate predicted that Michigan would see less net money for its schools and a net tax increase at the same time.

Wolpe also pointed out a fact that complicates the situation as legislators debate how to pay for Michigan's schools. The provisions of the 1978 Headlee Amendment to the state constitution limits the amount of money the state can raise in taxes for any purpose.

Specifically, Headlee says that state taxes can't take up a greater percentage of individual income than they did in '78. (Property taxes are local taxes, not part of this particular Headlee provision.) Therefore, Lansing can only increase taxes by about \$3.8 billion now.

Many legislators support state tax increases — sales, income, business and/or others — to give each student in Michigan a "foundation grant." The grant would be a set amount sent each year to the district the student attends.

To close the gap between \$6.5 billion and \$3.8 billion, many legislators also favor giving districts the opportunity to ask their voters approve local property tax millages.

Engler last week unveiled his financing plan, which calls for a two-cent sales tax increase (requiring

## Novi men join in on Civil War battle film

Paul Stulgross was in an awkward position. Draped over a cannon, he was supposed to hold that pose and play dead for an hour in the hot summer sun.

On top of the discomfort, he was riddled by attempts at humor fired by his comrades-in-arms — and couldn't put up a defense.

"They'd say, 'Hey Reb, your butt's up in the air,'" Stulgross said with a laugh.

It was all in a day's work, one Stulgross and his friend Alan Rothenberg

## Novi men join the Civil War — in the film 'Gettysburg'

The Novi residents were two of the 5,000 Civil War reenactors recruited for Ted Turner's epic \$30 million movie *Gettysburg*, which opened in movie theaters Friday.

As Confederate soldiers, they spent three days in June 1992 filming at the battlefield in Gettysburg, Penn.

"When you're out there with 5,000-plus guys and you've got 25-plus Union cannons pounding in your direction and they start to go off at one time, it feels real," Stulligross said.

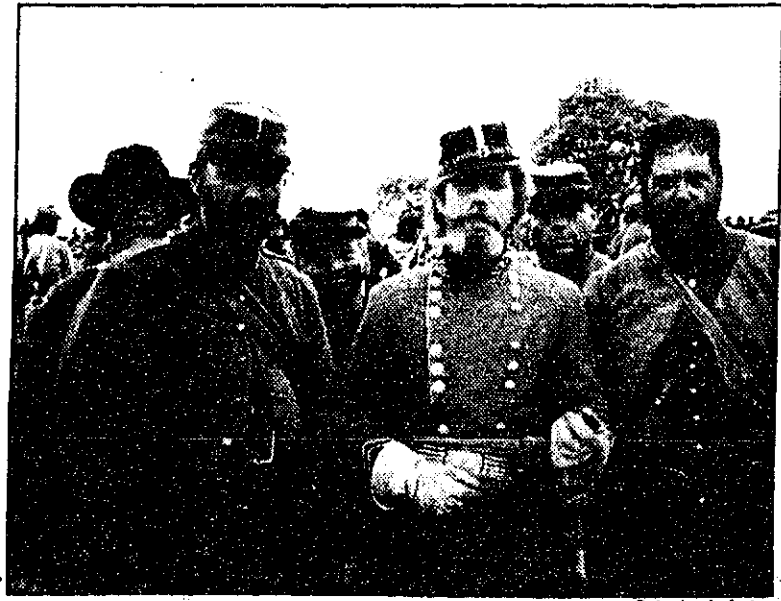
"My great-great-grandfather on the Northern side is probably rolling over in his grave."

As re-enactors on their own time, the men are members of the Fifth Texas Company. He and *Gettysburg* they play Virginia soldiers under the leadership of Gen. James Kemper. Rothenberg and Stulligross take part in movie's portrayal of the dashed but ultimately futile charge on the Union lines led by Gen. George Pickett.

In the assault, 9,000 men were killed in 15 minutes. Rothenberg got "died" three times, once under heavy fire in the angle of the wall.

"This is the most hallowed ground in the country. The men got very emotional when they made all those charges. You get that rush. I caught myself thinking 'Thank God it isn't real,'" he said.

But every effort was made to make the battle look as real as possible.

The four-hour movie was based on Michael Shaara's Pulitzer-Prize winning book *The Killer Angels*. Realizing that the growing corps of Civil War enthusiasts would be nit-picking every scene, great care was taken to make sure each detail is as historically accurate as possible.

"The Civil War has really become a popular hobby. The most blatant inaccuracy would stand out like a sore thumb," Rothenberg said.

Makeup artists daubed the re-enactors' faces with dirt and sprayed their hair with artificial perspiration.

While Civil War hobbyists carry rubber bayonets when they recreate battles, in the movie actual steel bayonets without safety tips were carried by all re-enactors except those in the first line. Several men were injured in mishaps. The re-enactors donated themselves, their uniforms and equipment. Turner provided the transportation. Turner provided the transportation. "This will be the movie for Civil War buffs in years to come. Every high school student will probably see the movie. It's like *Ten Kill* and *Mockingbird*," Rothenberg said.

The three-day battle in July 1863

sounded the death knell for the Southern cause when Gen. Robert E. Lee was defeated in Pennsylvania by Union forces under the command of Gen. George Meade.

In the years following the bloody combat, reports of eerie goings on at Gettysburg have been recorded. Photographs taken on a clear day come out fogged. A re-enactor camping out on the field during the filming said he saw a ghostly company of soldiers walking over the hills.

"There was a mist. All he could discern was their upper torsos. He said, 'I can't handle this,' and went back into his tent," Rothenberg said.

But that's not all. Rothenberg said he heard Turner paid \$100,000 to film part of Pickett's charge on the actual site, now part of the Gettysburg National Park. He and Stulligross were not in this scene.

After the day's filming, he said, the re-enactors heard church bells ringing in Gettysburg at 5 p.m. "They didn't think anything of it. Everybody heard them. When they got back to town and inquired about it, they found out there were no church bells ringing in Gettysburg," he said.

Rothenberg has a reprint of a color photo taken by a woman on the set which shows the shadows of four soldiers silhouetted against a picket fence. The odd part is, the woman swears there was no one near her who could have cast the shadows. Rothenberg and Stulligross became interested in the Civil War through playing Avalon board games. After attending a Civil War collectors' show, they were "drafted" into the Michigan-based Fifth Texas.

state voter approval, a 16-mill property tax on businesses only, and other smaller increases.

The hikes will pay for a grant of \$4,500 per pupil per year. Those districts spending up to \$8,500 per pupil will not lose money under his plan. Engler says. He also supports allowing districts which spend above \$8,500 to have the local millage option.

He had concerns about Engler's and others' plans for funding. Wolpe said, and indicated he was still considering what he felt was the best choice. He did say that he disliked a sales tax increase, which has been rejected the consecutive times in recent history in Michigan.

Wolpe also accused Engler and other politicians of trying to "make teachers the scapegoat for the problems of public education."

Engler seems to be playing this as a war against teachers. Wolpe said of several actions by the Governor, including calls for spending reform at the district level and measures to reform educational quality.

Many factors — everything from television to the changing demands of a changing economy — have contributed to the woes schools have, Wolpe said. He added that the governor seemed to want to drive wedges between teachers and parents, between parents and school boards, be-

tween boards and teachers and so on — as a tactic to advance his political agenda.

On that agenda are charter schools and cross-district schools of choice, which Wolpe said "will only get in the way of the real issue: how to improve public schools in the (everyday) public school classroom."

"There is a way to deal with the problems of inequity (of funding) and reform of quality in our schools," he said later, "but it requires consensus-building. You can't do that if you manipulate people's anger."

The former congressman then fielded questions from those who attended the breakfast. During his responses he took state legislators to task again, noting that plans are afoot to cut adult and special education programs.

"It's an invitation for disaster," Wolpe said of the adult ed cuts. "People change jobs about five times during their careers. Continuing education, retooling and retraining our workforce, should be a part of that."

Novi Schools Director of Special Education Donna Tinberg pointed out that Senate Bill One eliminated Public Act 18, which addresses the needs of special education. Tinberg said that meant a \$47 million loss to Oakland County schools alone. She added that Engler's or any plan must provide for special education students.

## Long-range plan details district mission, vision

Novi is a district with a mission and a vision, thanks to its new long-range plan. The document will serve as the blueprint for many important developments in Novi schools between now and 1998. The plan cites nine major goals for the district to accomplish in the next five years, including: ● Developing exit competencies as part of learning programs. ● Implement technology as a learning tool. ● Develop an educational partnership with the business community. ● Help district staff members prepare to

meet the new challenges and changes of the coming years. ● Consider expansion of district facilities, including a new school in coming years. ● Prioritize district expenditures. ● Integrate different areas of learning systematically. ● Address the diverse learning needs of students. ● Plan for the education of tomorrow's children; the introduction to the long-range plan report reads, "has always been important in the Novi Community School District. This plan," it continues, "adds a new dimension to the planning process. It creates a vision of what the school district seeks to be-

come and charts a course, with strategies, to get there over the next five years." The report, which a committee of administrators, parents, students and community representatives put together over several months, begins with two crucial elements: statements of mission and vision. The mission statement is the starting point; it defines why the district exists. After much discussion, the following text was agreed upon: "In partnership with parents and community," the statement reads, "the mission of the Novi Community School District is to ensure that all students construct the knowledge and develop the skills and the attitudes necessary for a lifetime of learning and participation in a diverse, competitive and changing world."

The report's vision statement expands on those themes, acting more narrowly defined goals for the district to tackle between now and 1998. The statement reads as follows, and represents what committee members envision for Novi as the 20th century comes to a close: "We see a school district where: ● Parents, community and school works together and are accountable for a quality education for all students. ● Diverse learning needs are recognized and addressed in a caring, sensitive and creative student-center learning environment. ● Students have the ability to communicate, problem-solve and demonstrate high level thinking skills. ● Students have the opportunity to develop intellectually, morally, socially and physically. ● Students are prepared to compete in a technological world. ● Students appreciate the many diversities and cultural influences that shape the community. ● Staff models the learning processes and behaviors expected of students. ● Staff is committed to and involved in personal and professional growth."

## Board of Education decides on its goals for the year

Novi school district students aren't the only ones who'll be busy this year with education: the Board of Education has given itself some "homework" as well.

Board members approved four major goals and the strategies to achieve them during the 1993-94 academic year at their Sept. 23 meeting. The concept is a new one this year. The board said that it would review the objectives at the end of the year to see how well members did.

The board's goals and strategies read as follows: ● To visit schools and become more familiar with our student programs. Each board member will visit at

least one school this year. A school visitation plan will be developed with the administration to provide an outline for individual board members to use when setting up visits to schools throughout the year. ● To be more actively involved with the Novi residents in promoting quality education. The board president will determine the homeowners associations and the school associations to be visited this year. Board members will be given the opportunity to schedule visits per the board president's plan. ● To represent Novi citizens on the future funding of education. Each board member will write one letter to either our state senator or state representative. ● To increase our knowledge and

understanding of a student exit competencies program. Board members will attend the school district in-service programs on exit competencies. As part of their own goals, board members also considered a list of district/superintendent goals as well. They include: ● To implement the new five-year long-range plan for the district per the recommendations of the committee which created it and Superintendent of Schools Emmett Lippe. Some seven sub-goals are part of this first objective. The first calls for developing alternative program scenarios that correspond to the various revenue options the district may face in the coming fiscal year, done in cooperation with the financial issues task force group, the scenarios will come to the board by April 1 for consideration. Second, to work to create partnerships between the business community and each school, to be done by March 1. Third, to implement the technology plan for the district per the three-year plan which now exists. Members asked that the first phase of the plan be implemented to bring technology into the classroom be completed and reported to the board by Feb. 1. Fourth, to begin development and implementing a K-12 student exit competencies program. This includes coming up with a staff development plan by Dec. 15 and holding an informational session for district staff members by January.

Fifth, to implement quality teams for food services, transportation, athletics and building and grounds issues. The teams are to be organized and given instruction on their responsibilities and goals this fall. Sixth, to develop a plan that will identify the current and future needs for school facilities and school sites, and to submit a report on them no later than April 15. Seventh, to put together a plan for staff development. In the area of technology and exit competencies for students. The board would like to see a report on that subject no later than Dec. 15. ● To continue maintaining the renovation/addition projects now under way. Board members will receive by monthly reports on the progress of all projects. ● To continue improvement of the outdoor appearance and environment at each district building site. Each building principal and appropriate supervisor will submit a list of activities or projects which enhance their school site to Lippe by May 1. All lists will be then passed on to the board.

### Investment yields benefits after long wait

Some 90 miles north of San Francisco, and far from mainstream northern California wine country, is Guenoc (Gwen'-ahk) Valley, an uncommonly beautiful, but extremely isolated, and under-developed area. Here the wine lover finds the 23,000 acres of the Guenoc Estate Vineyards and Winery which in total represents the area of a sizeable city.

Vineyards in Guenoc Valley grow at optimum elevations between 1,000 and 1,500 feet. Grapes reap benefits from the rich California sun by day and very cool temperatures at night. Soils are either loamy with gravel bands or rocky and lean. The former are superior for chardonnay, while the latter simulate the conditions of the Medoc and make a favorable home for the Bordeaux varietals — cabernet sauvignon, merlot, cabernet franc, malbec and petit verdot.

The Guenoc Winery label bears a portrait of the famous stage actress Lillie Langtry who was the darling of both European and American theatergoers in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Langtry owned property in the Guenoc Valley where she produced wines from her vineyards. Today, more than 300 acres of vineyards surround the original Langtry House, restored to its original Victorian elegance by Guenoc's proprietors Orville and Karen Magoon.

In 1963, Orville Magoon's family exchanged 23 acres of prime real estate in Hawaii for the 23,000 acres in Guenoc Valley because the University of Hawaii needed to expand its campus facilities. At first, the property served as a livestock ranch only, but Magoon's mother Genevieve wanted to plant grapes, considering them more romantic than hay. And so it happened!

Both the wine louse phylloxera and Prohibition destroyed the vineyards planted by Langtry and the Magoon family had to begin back at square one. Orville Magoon travelled to Bordeaux to visit vineyards and came back to the property to plant test plots. The first wines from these plantings were produced in 1976.

In 1980, the Magoons built a winery with an exterior in the original design modeled after the historic Langtry barn. Here winemaker Derek Holstein is crafting some of the most delicious wines made in California. Holstein has been honing his winemaking skills since high school when he first made wine from plums.

In 1981, Guenoc Valley became the first single-proprietor viticultural appellation recognized by the federal government Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms.

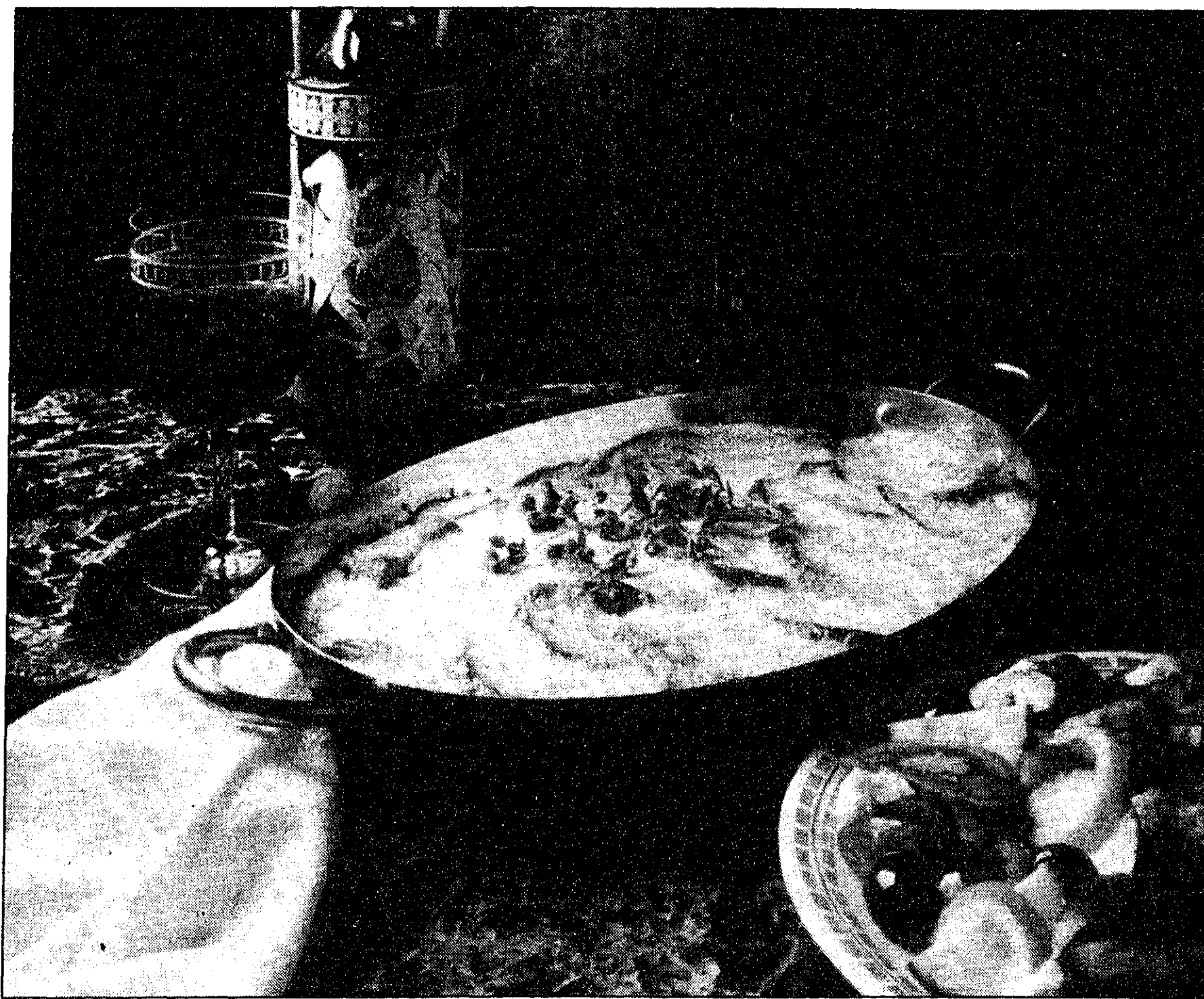

## Gracious Greek Modern favorites have Athenian roots

A great deal of civilization can be attributed to its foundation in Greek heritage — medicine, mathematics, literature, science, art, architecture — and food.

Greek cuisine and Greektown are as fundamental to the Detroit area as post-and-lintel construction is to architecture.

According to Eva Zane's book, *Greek Cooking for the Gods* (101 Productions), centuries before the birth of Christ, the Greeks were dining on legumes simmered with olive oil, oregano and bay leaf, lamb roasted with capers and honey-drenched cakes. All this while the balance of Europe was gnawing on raw bones.

The tenets of modern cuisine — stock, herb seasoning, sauces — and methods such as braising can all be attributed to Greek invention.

In *Greek Cooking for the Gods*, we learn that Athenaeus, a kind of second-century M.F.K. Fisher, wrote an esteemed treatise

on food, "The Deipnosophists" ("The Banquet of the Learned"). In it, he describes the fascination of Homer, Herodotus and Sophocles in the origins and merit of many foods. Athenaeus even includes a recipe for "electric ray stewed in oil, wine and fragrant herbs and a little grated cheese."

In spite of this respectful beginning, what most people know of Greek cooking is stuffed grape leaves. And likely they don't even know the main ingredients in these dolmadakia, as they are called.

Greek cooking is a broad and savory subject. Greece has some 2,500 miles of shoreline. As a seafaring population, Greeks exported bouillabaisse, bachel, mayonnaise, gingerbread and figs — all under different names of course.

Likewise, Hellenistic cuisine was enriched by customs from far and wide — paper-thin filo pastry from Persia; rice, lemons and eggplants from India; and thick, strong coffee and skewered meats from the Turks.

#### DIONYSUS' FARE

Like all Mediterranean countries, Greece produces lovely wines, of which resina is the best-known. The Athenians, in an attempt to discourage the Persians from drinking their storehouses of wine, added pine resin to it.

The Persians were put off, but the results after aging were exceptional.

Favorite red wines are nemea, othello and pendell. White wines include demestica, hymettus and the full-bodied robola. Ouzo, an anise-flavored acquired taste, is the Aegean's favored aperitif.

It is not coincidental that Dionysus is as often pictured eating grapes as drinking. It is the custom to quaff while eating an assortment of mezadakia (appetizers) like dolmadakia, marinated mushrooms, and little meat triangles called kreatopetes. For dyed-in-the-wool adventurers, try lamb brains marinated with oregano, or pickled squid.

With the rocky Greek countryside covered with goats and sheep, goat and

sheep cheeses are central to many Greek dishes. Some, like feta, are readily available in this country, or can be found in Greek delicatessens. Zane suggests that Parmesan can stand in for kefalotyri, mozzarella for kasseri, and ricotta for mizithra. Manouri, from Crete, is more complicated to duplicate.

A wedge of hot bread, a slice of goat's milk cheese and a local specialty like tar-amosalata (a fish roe puree) with cucumbers might make a meal with a glass of light wine.

#### DEMETER'S BOUNTY

Herbs such as mint, oregano, dill, rosemary and thyme are plentifully grown and used in the Aegean. Basil is held in special affection. The tender plants are cultivated with care and used in tomato or eggplant dishes.

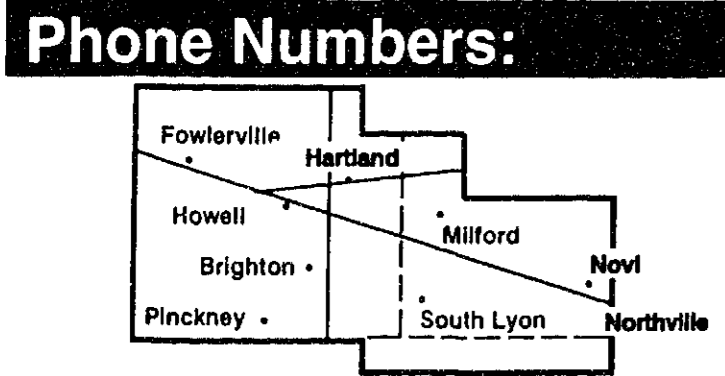

## 'I'll Fly Away' comes full circle on PBS

A poignant drama series that many critics hailed as being "too good for network TV" returns, however briefly, starting this week. "I'll Fly Away: Then and Now," an original TV movie that ties up loose ends in the now-cancelled series, airs Monday, Oct. 11, on many PBS affiliates. Beginning the following Monday, PBS will rebroadcast all 38 episodes that aired during the series' two seasons on NBC.

"I'll Fly Away" focused on two families in the mythical Deep South town of Bryland as the turbulent 1960s were dawning. Sam Waterston starred as small-town prosecutor Forrest Bedford. Regina Taylor played Lilly Harper, housekeeper and caregiver for his three children (Jeremy London, Ashlee Levitch and John Aaron Bennett). All principals were able to recreate their roles for the TV movie with the exception of London, who was replaced by his identical twin brother, Jason, due to a scheduling conflict.

"I'll Fly Away: Then and Now" opens in modern-day Atlanta, where Lilly, now in her 60s, is living comfortably. During a weekend visit from her 12-year-old grandson,

a Californian fixated on rap music, she chafes at the boy's total lack of interest in their family's history.

Finally, Lilly firmly sits him down with a scrapbook and begins to relate her experiences in the civil rights movement to the reluctant boy. She describes the tragic murder case that forced her family to flee Bryland in 1962, and forever changed the lives of the Harper and Bedford families. At the conclusion of the film, Lilly returns to Bryland to learn the fate of her friends and former employers. This return visit is not only a sequel but a prequel to the series, setting the stage for the following 38 episodes.

The movie was shot on location in Georgia and directed by series executive producer Ian Sander. It also includes taped interviews with cast and crew members, who offer their views about the importance of the series, both historically and personally. More interviews will be featured at the end of selected episodes throughout the season.

Commenting on the series' impact, Waterston says, "I think it's great that this drama takes on the history of the civil rights movement, which is one of the thorniest issues that the United States has had to

deal with...and keeps on affirming that there is a way through the problems.

"It reminds people that the result of the struggle, which looked nasty and horrible at the time, was a tremendous benefit to society; that we can move forward and have moved forward; and that giving up and bailing out is not such a good idea."

Waterston, Taylor and the series all were nominated for Emmys during both seasons of the show's NBC run. While they struck out both times, the two actors have won Golden Globes and American Television Awards for their work, and the show itself has received a battery of other awards, including the prestigious Humanitas Prize and a Television Critics Association Award.

"It was a great shame that the show didn't go on for two or three more years," says Waterston, "because the story is so interesting and absorbing in its detail. It records historic acts by people who are completely unknown, and I don't think that there's anything more interesting than the evolution of a culture."

"If every person who wrote in and got excited about keeping it on the air sends their local PBS station \$10, public television would be able to do more quality shows like 'I'll Fly Away' on its own," he adds.

## LET'S TALK

### 'Oz' filmed in Technicolor; helpful Hindman history

**Q:** I have a \$100 bet that says "The Wizard of Oz," starring Judy Garland, was filmed in color. My wife believes that it was later colorized. Who owes whom? —M. Nielsen, Portland, Ore.

**A:** Tell your wife to pay up. The Aug. 16, 1939, Variety review says, "Except for the opening and closing stretches of prologue and epilogue, which are visioned in a rich sepia, the greater portion of the film is in Technicolor. Some of the scenic passages are so beautiful in design and composition as to stir audiences by their sheer unfoldment."

**Q:** I'm a big fan of the Canadian sketch comedy show "The Kids in the Hall." Could you please tell me how the five actors on the show formed their comedy troupe? Where can I write to them? And is there an album release of the show's funny songs and theme music? —M. Girvan, Kingston, Penn.

**A:** The Kids came together when Kevin McDonald and Dave Foley met a comedy duo called The Audience (Mark McKinney and Bruce McCulloch) at a 1984 midnight comedy fest in an old movie theater. Scott Thompson soon joined the budding troupe. After becoming a Toronto comedy club favorite, they were relocated to New York by producer Lorne Michaels "to toughen them up." An hour-long special for HBO and Canadian television led to regular HBO specials. Last year, CBS picked up "The Kids in the Hall," making it the first original cable production to gain a network slot. The writing, in which the actors are quite involved, earned an Emmy nomination in July. The show has returned for a second season on CBS. There is currently no release containing the silly sketch songs, such as "Terriers." The theme music is played by Toronto's Shadowy Man from a Shadowy Planet, which serves as an intermission band during "Kids" tapings. They don't yet have a U.S. album release. 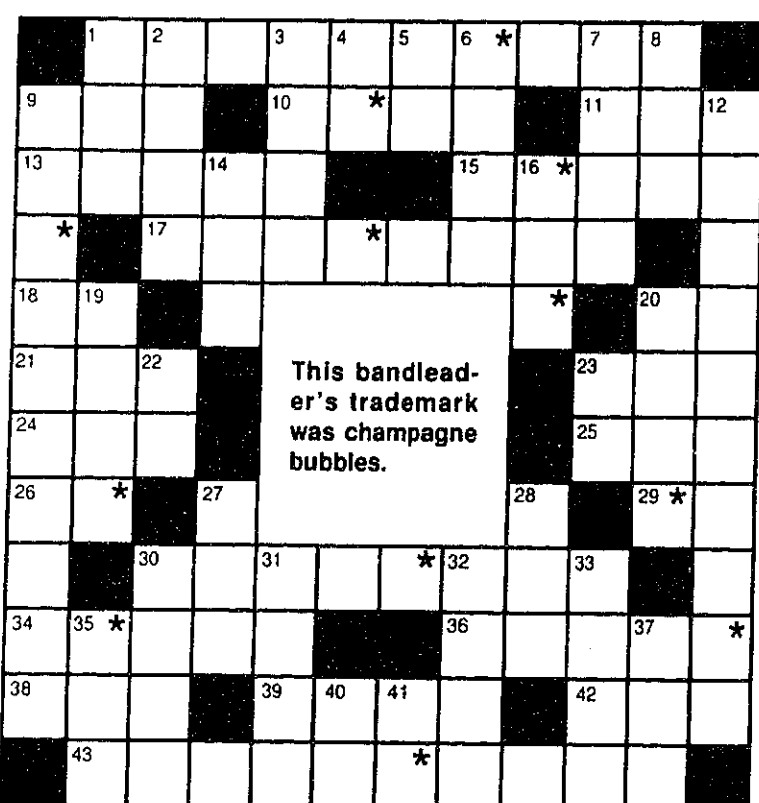

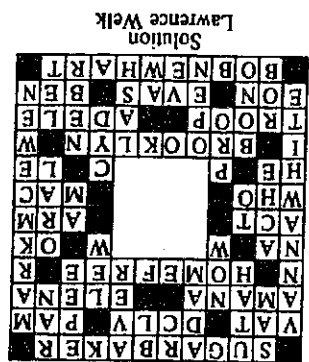

The big question is will Nick (Vincent Izzary) and Mindy ever get back together? "Mindy has made a decision that Nick is her man. They have always had this thing together. I think the writers are going to put the characters together for a while."

Fans of "The Young and the Restless" may remember Crampton as the vivacious Leanna Love. The actress has also portrayed Trista Evans on "Days of Our Lives" and has starred in several feature films.

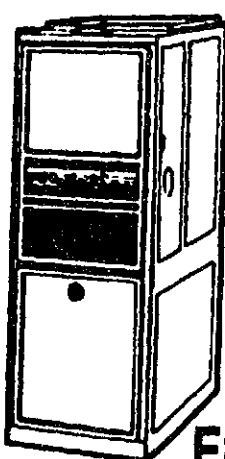
