No more than one tract or parcel is to be valued or taxed on the same line. Two descriptions must not be joined in one valuation or tax unless contiguous and owned and occupied as one parcel. A parcel of land described in the government survey by lot number must be so assessed. The description of all lands in each town and range should be carefully written. In the case of platted land, the name of the plat must be given in full at the head of the description included therein. If the name of the owner of non-resident land is not known it should be assessed as "Owner Unknown." Enter the amount of any reassessment with red ink, in the column of taxes to which it belongs, above the tax for the year for which this Roll is used, and in the column of "Remarks," opposite each parcel, state for what year the reassessment was made. The valuation of Personal Property must be made in a different column and the assessment thereon entered on a different line from that on Real Property. The name of each special tax must be entered at the head of the column in which it is placed. Supervisors will make no entry in column 10.
