

FORWARD

The following report covering the operations of the Oakland County Employees' Retirement System for 1982 is submitted pursuant to Section 14 of the Retirement Plan. Complete financial reports are detailed in the 1982 Financial Report of the County of Oakland, prepared by the County Department of Management and Budget.

The Annual Report of the Actuary through December 31, 1982, is on file with the State of Michigan and with the Secretary of the County Retirement System. All reports required by the State Pension Committee for this period have been filed with that body.

BOARD ACTIVITY REVIEW

For the 14th straight year, County retirants were granted the maximum increase in their County Retirement Allowance under the 1-1/2% annual awards clause in effect since 1969. In addition, a cost of living adjustment was approved and was made effective January 1, 1982.

The commission has kept a close watch on its investment advisors, and with the assistance of our monitoring service consultant, we are able to closely track their performance. Based on comparison reports, they are performing above average.

- 63 County retirants qualified for presentation of their retirement awards at the 1982 Annual Credit Union and Retirement Banquet.
 - 48 Applications for retirement were approved by the Commission in 1982.

MEMBERSHIP

Total Membership as of December 31, 1982, was 3,760, a decrease of 22 under 1981. These were classified as follows:

48 Members were added to the Retirement Rolls during 1982. All qualified under Social Security in addition to their County benefits.

During the one year period, 31 retirants were dropped from the rolls on account of death, leaving 688 retirants and beneficiaries on the rolls as of December 31, 1982; of these 391 were drawing straight life allowances, 168 Option A (Full Survivorship), 93 Option B (Modified Survivorship), 20 Option C (Allowance for 10 year Certain and Life), and Section 25-B 16 Benefits. Benefits paid for 1982 totaled \$2,489,144.04.

FINANCIAL STATUS

A complete financial report is included in the Executives 1982 Annual Financial Report on file in that office and, therefore, only those statements of general interest are set forth herein.

ASSETS AND LIABILITIES: The assets of the system, as of December 31, 1982, totaled \$91,043,579, an increase of \$12,517,044 over 1981. This included long term investments of \$78,910,639.

SOURCE AND APPLICATION OF FUNDS: The Commission, during 1982, had total receipts of \$151,447,330, disbursed \$148,806,151, and had cash and equivalents on hand at the end of the year of \$11,533,933.

Receipts of the system are derived from three principal sources, (a) Employer Contributions, (b) Employee Contributions and (c) Earnings on Investments. Additional sources of revenue include the gradual repayment of principal on FHA mortgages and the liquidation of investments, either through maturity or sale.

Disbursements are accounted for in the payment of retirement allowances, refunds of Employee Contributions and the purchase of new investments for the Retirement Fund. Of special note were payments of retirement allowances to our retirees and beneficiaries of \$2,489,144 and the refund of Employee Contributions totaling \$70,393.

INVESTMENT OF FUNDS: During 1982, the Commission made new investments totaling \$102,110,744 and liquidated investments of \$91,733,884. This left on hand in the fund as of December 31, 1982, \$78,910,639.
