INTRODUCTION

This summary document is meant to serve as a quick and easy reference for income and population data for communities within Oakland County and eight counties in Southeast Michigan.

The information has been divided into three sections. The sections are: INCOME DATA, POPULATION DATA and COMPARATIVE DATA.

The first section contains a map that shows median family income by census tract quartiles for Oakland County and five categories of income data. The categories are: average family income; average household income; median family income; median household income and per capita income. The definitions for these categories are provided below.

The second section contains the number of persons, families and households for communities and the County.

Information within the comparative data section, section three, ranks the 61 communities within the County by the five income categories. Population and income are also provided for the eight counties in southeast Michigan.

Definition of Categories

AVERAGE FAMILY INCOME - was derived by dividing the total family income for each unit of geography, i.e. community and county, by the number of families within that unit of geography. (Total family income \div number of families = average family income.) Families are defined as two or more related individuals living in the same housing unit.

AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD INCOME - was derived by dividing the total household income for each unit of geography, i.e. community and county, by the number of households. (Total household income \div number of households = average household income.) Households are defined as one or more individuals living in a housing unit. Families are included in the household category but households are not included in the family category. Consequently, households will be a number equal to or greater than the number of families.

MEDIAN FAMILY INCOME - the median has the connotation of the 'middlemost' or 'most central' value of a set of numbers. For ungrouped data, it is defined simply as the value of the central item when the data are arranged by size. If there is an odd number of observations, the median is directly ascertainable. If there is an even number of items, there are two central values and, by convention, the value halfway between these two central observations is designated as the median. In most cases the median family income was provided by the Census Bureau. A formula for calculating the median of a frequency distribution was used in those cases when the median was not provided.

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME - the same method of computing median family income was used to compute the median household income. However, households are included with families to provide this number. Again, households are defined as one or more individuals living in a housing unit. Families are included in the household category but households are not included in the family category. Consequently, households will be a number equal to or greater than the number of families.


PER CAPITA INCOME - was derived by dividing the total income for each geographic unit, i.e. community and county, by the number of people in the geographic unit. (Total income ÷ number of people within the geographic unit = per capita income for that unit of geography.)


Median Household Income by Census Tract




1980 CENSUS TRACTS
