INTRODUCTION

This report has been compiled to provide 1980 census information to those who need current demographic data relating to Oakland County, Michigan.

The report provides Provisional 1980 Census Population and Racial Data for census tracts, municipalities and county. Supplementary data includes Municipality Housing and Population changes from 1970 to 1980; Households, Group Quarters and Persons Per Household for 1980; Changes in Population for Oakland County from 1900 to 1980 and Population Trends in Southeast Michigan.

The information in this document has been gleaned from several sources. The population and racial information at the census tract level has been derived from materials used for legislative reapportionment (P.L. 94-171). Housing units were extracted from the Advance Counts. Households, Group Quarters and Person Per Household information was extracted from a computer printout provided by the Census Bureau.

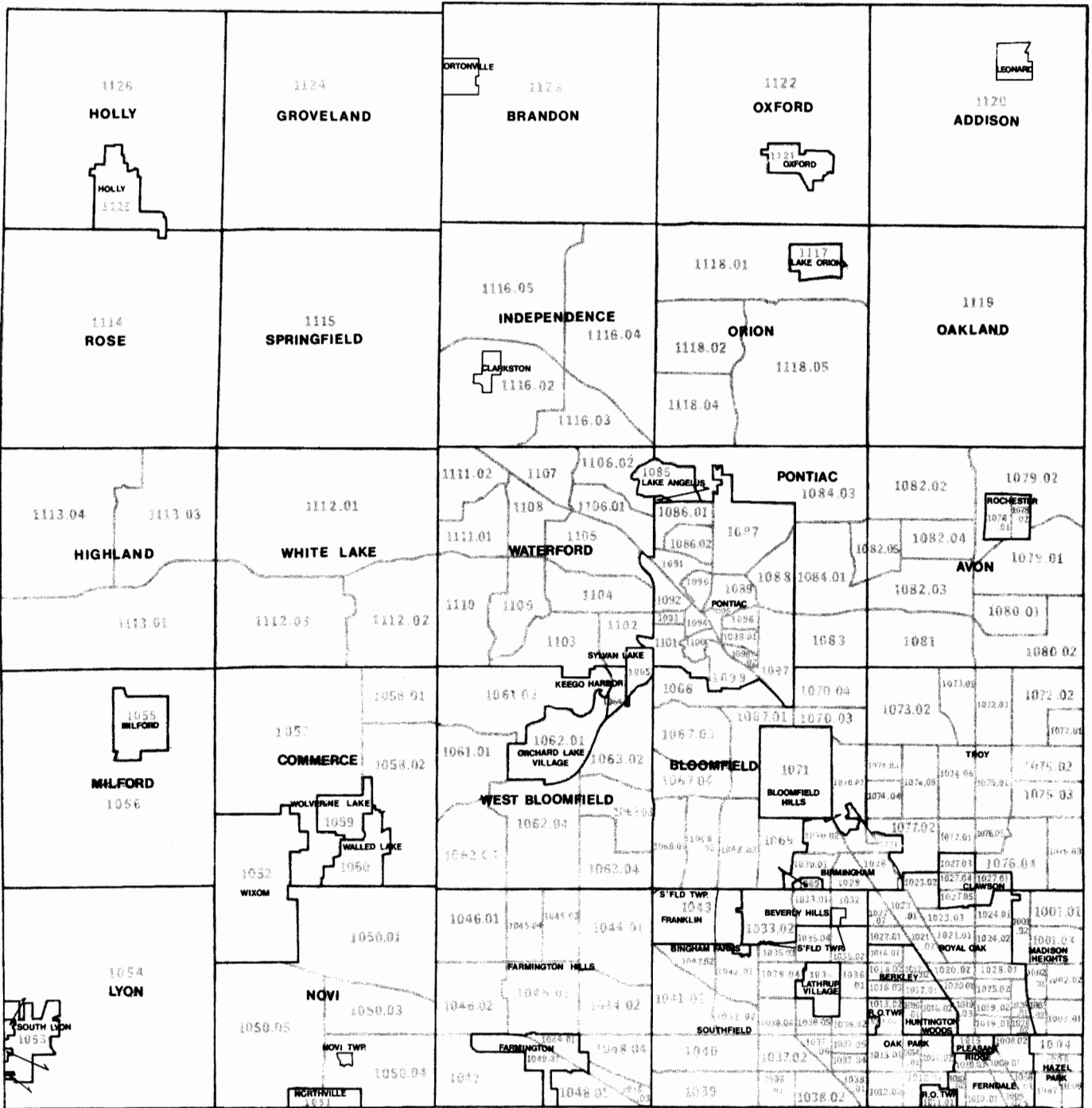
1980 Census Tract Maps for Oakland County and Southeast Oakland County are also included.

COUNTY, CITIES, VILLAGES AND TOWNSHIPS

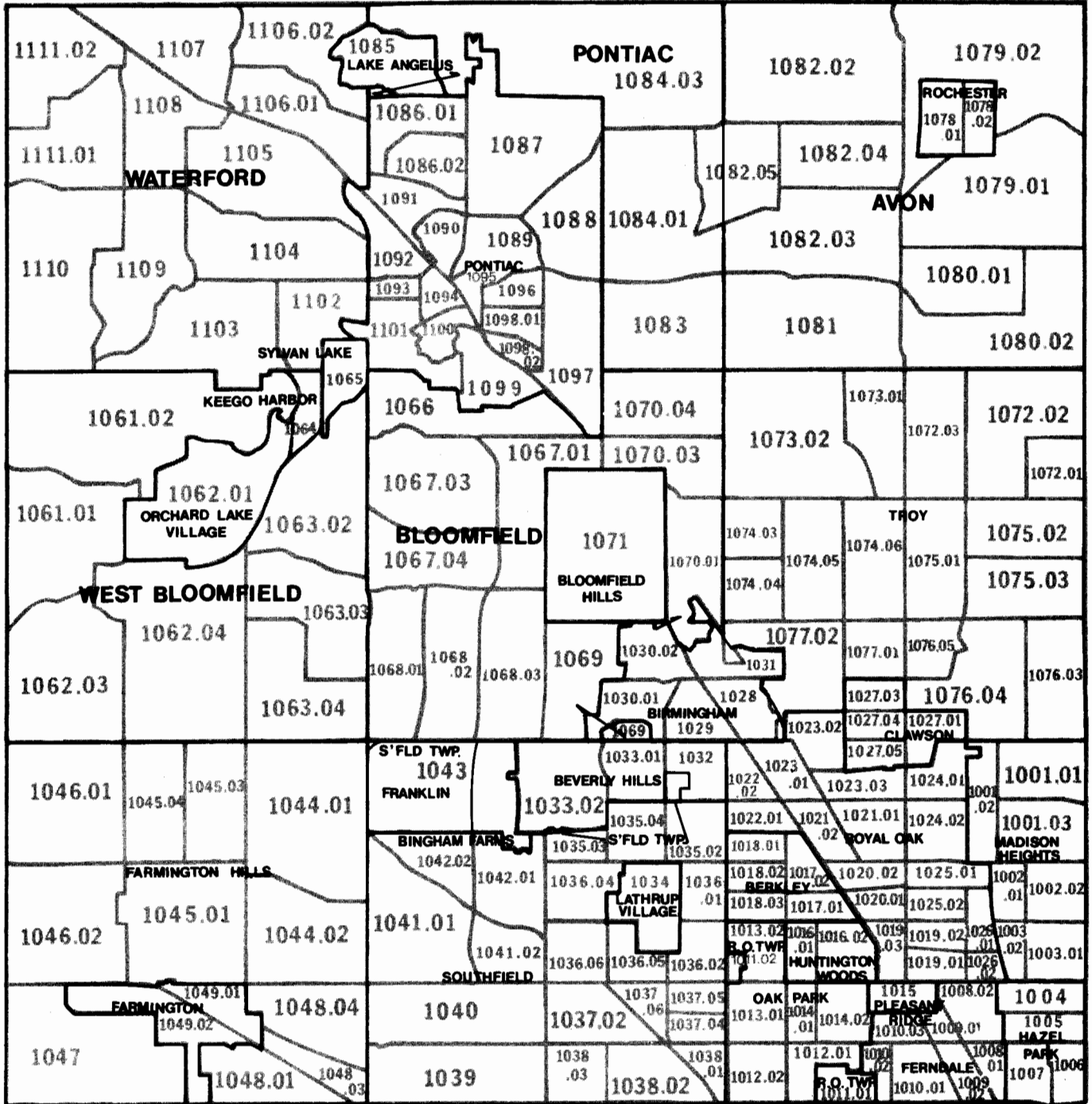
OAKLAND COUNTY MICHIGAN

NOTICE

The following table provides provisional race and Spanish origin population totals from the 1980 Census. The 1980 race and Spanish origin census counts are not comparable to the 1970 counts except for blacks. This is due to changes in definitions and reporting methods.

The category "White" includes persons who indicated their race as White, as well as persons who did not classify themselves in one of the specific race categories listed on the questionnaire but entered a response suggesting European origin such as German, Italian, or Polish.

The Category "Black" includes persons who indicated their race as Black or Negro, as well as persons who did not classify themselves in one of the specific race categories listed on the questionnaire but reported entries such as Jamaican, Black Puerto Rican, West Indian, Haitian or Nigerian.

The category "American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut" includes persons who classified themselves as such in one of the specific race categories. In addition, persons who did not report themselves in one of the specific race categories but reported the name of an Indian tribe were classified as American Indian.

The category "Asian and Pacific Islander" includes persons who indicated their race as Japanese, Chinese, Filipino, Korean, Asian Indian, Vietnamese, Hawaiian, Guamanian, or Samoan. Persons who did not classify themselves in one of the specific race categories but reported entries indicating one of the nine categories listed above were classified accordingly.

The category "Other" includes Asian and Pacific Islander groups not identified separately (e.g., Cambodian, Indochinese, Pakistani, Indonesian, Fiji Islander) and other races not included in the specific categories listed on the questionnaire.

Persons of Spanish origin or descent are those who classified themselves in one of the specific Spanish origin categories listed on the questionnaire-Mexican, Puerto Rican, or Cuban-as well as those who indicated that they were of other Spanish/Hispanic origin. Persons reporting "other Spanish/Hispanic" origin are those whose origins are from Spain or the Spanish-speaking countries of Central or South America, or they are Spanish, Spanish American, Hispano, Latino, etc. Origin or descent can be viewed as the ancestry, nationality group, lineage, or country in which the person or person's parents or ancestors were born before their arrival in the United States. Persons of Spanish origin may be of any race. These numbers are already included in the White or Black category. WHEN ADDING NUMBERS ACROSS THE PAGE DO NOT ADD OR INCLUDE SPANISH.

CAUTION: Township population includes village population; village population also listed separately. AVOID "DOUBLE COUNTING"

The word "partial" indicates that the census tract has been subdivided. To obtain the population total for the entire census tract, add the "partials" for that tract.
