

A young bicyclist was killed and a motorcyclist was seriously injured in two separate recent traffic accidents.

On September 5 Stacy Lyn Brownlee, 8, of Lake Orion was fatally struck by a car driven by Edward P. Bolen of Lake Orion at Hi-Hill and Hi-Lure.

Stacy was riding a bicycle.

According to the Oakland County Sheriff's Dept., witnesses told officers the child turned in front of the uncoming car driven by Bolen. Officers were told the car was traveling between 35 and 40 m.p.h.

The legal speed limit in the area is 25 m.p.h.

Bolen told officers he was unable to tell the speed he was traveling because the car speedometer was not operating.

He said glare from the sun blocked his view of the roadway.

The accident is being investigated.

The accident occurred at the intersection of Lapeer Road and Clarkston Road.

Officers said they were told by witnesses that the car turned into the path of the motorcycle.

Mrs. Hubbard was cited and the accident is being investigated.
