Jack Coleman

Long-time Lake Orion resident Jack Coleman died on Dec. 8 at the age of 68.

He is survived by his wife Leah.

He is also survived by his sons, Dr. James Coleman of Rochester Hills and Harry Colman of Salem, Ohio; and his grandchildren, Justin, Grant and Troy.

Mr. Coleman attended what was then known as the Cincinnati Conservatory of Music now part of the University of Cincinnati. He was a member of Orion Lodge #46 F. & A.M. serving in 1969 as its Worshipful Master and was a member of the Detroit Shrine.

He served many years as a volunteer fireman and was also the department's first scuba diver who had the responsibility of retrieving drowning victims.

Mr. Coleman was an avid fan of classical music and served many years as first chair for trumpet in the Moslem Shrine Band. He was employed by General Motors, retiring in 1981. After retirement, the Colemans spent winters in numerous southern states.
