Resolved therefore by the board that the said Applications

above mentioned requiring them to comply with the
requirements of the Law made & provided for the
regulations of Taverns and the Board further determine
that the Said Green Phillips and Whitfield & Co shall
for such permission granted pay to the Treasurer of
Said Township each the sum of Five Dollars and
the Said Thomas Whitfield & Co further applies for Licence
as a Merchant the Board therefore further resolve that
the said application be granted and that the said clerk
also issue Licence to Said Whitfield & Co as Merchant
and for such permission the board further determine
that Said Whitfield & Co shall pay the further sum of
Five Dollars as such Merchant to the Treasurer of Said
Township afore Said — given under our hands
