

Assessment Roll for the Township of Orion

No more than one tract or parcel is to be valued or taxed on the same line. Two descriptions must not be joined in one valuation or tax unless contiguous and owned and occupied as one parcel. A parcel of land described in the government survey by lot number must be so assessed. The description of all lands in each town and range should be carefully written. In the case of platted land, the name of the plat must be given in full at the head of all descriptions included. If the name of the owner of non-resident land is not known, it should be assessed as "Owner Unknown." Enter the amount of any Reassessment with red ink, in the column of taxes to which it belongs, above the tax for the year for which this roll is used, and in the column for "Remarks" opposite each. The Valuation of Personal Property must be in a different column, and the taxes thereon entered on a different line from the Real Property. The name of each special tax must be entered at the head of the column in which it is placed. Supervisors will make no entry in column 10. The attention of assessing officers is especially called to Sections 1 to 8, 9 (as amended by Act 25 of 1895), 10, 11 (as amended by Act 229 of 1894), 12, 13, 14 (as amended by Act 32 of 1899), 15 to 17, 18 (as amended by Act 239 of 1899), 19, 20, 21 and 22 (as amended by Act 154 of 1890), 23, 24 (as amended by Act 326 of 1907), 25 to 40, 41 (as amended by Act 262 of 1890), 42 (as amended by Act 119 and 119 of the General Tax Law).

(INSTRUCTIONS)—In all cases mark a cross (X) in the circle (O) under the name of your party at the head of the ballot. If you desire to vote straight ticket, nothing further need be done. Where only one candidate is to be elected to any office and you desire to vote for a candidate not on your party ticket, make a cross (X) in the square () before the name of the candidate for whom you desire to vote on the other ticket. Where two or more candidates are to be elected to the same office, and you desire to vote for candidates on different tickets for such office, make a cross (X) in the square () before the name of the candidate for whom you desire to vote on the other ticket; also erase an equal number of names of candidates on your party ticket for the same office for whom you do not desire to vote. If you wish to vote for a candidate not on your ticket, write or place the name of such candidate on your ticket opposite the name of the office. Before leaving the booth, fold the ballot so that the initials of the inspector may be seen on the outside.
