Gentlemen:

This report summarizes the activities and operations of the Reimbursement Division for the year 1972, and is submitted to you to examine and review.

The Reimbursement Division has experienced few changes during the year 1972. However, during the last month of 1972, we were involved in establishing procedures to implement collections of Circuit Court appointed attorney fees. Plans are being made to enlarge this program during the ensuing year.

Also, we are experiencing a change in admittance priorities to Pontiac State Hospital, as many more patients are being admitted on voluntary orders, rather than through the Probate Court. In either case, the Reimbursement Division has the responsibility to develop financial information and make a recommendation as to the ability of the patient, and/or the patient's responsible relatives, as defined in the Mental Health Statutes, to pay toward the cost of care.

Through the com bined efforts of the Community Mental Health Services Board, and Dr. Donald Martin, Superintendent of Pontiac State Hospital, emergency beds have been made available at Pontiac State Hospital, eliminating the need of providing services at the County level for a large number of patients at Woodside Medical, Inc., until a bed could be available at Pontiac State Hospital.

The day to day operation of this department is related and involved with many divisions of the County, as well as the State Departments of Revenue and Mental Health, and a close liaison is maintained with the Veterans' Administration and the Social Security Administration, divisions of the Federal Government.

The Reimbursement Division is responsible for collection of all charges ordered by the Probate Judges for care supplied by the County through the Juvenile Court. Whenever a child receives this care, a financial statement is taken and an order is entered commensurate with the parents' ability to pay.

^{*}This amount includes \$3,502.07 credited to Oakland County on the State Support of Patients and represents one-half of the benefits from Social Security, and Veterans' Administration collected by the Department of Revenue.

^{**}Probate Support accounts represent monies collected and paid out as received to the person caring for the child. This is as decreed by the Probate Court order.

It is the responsibility of the Reimbursement Division to collect monies due the County of Oakland, as ordered by the Probate Judges, on all active and past due mental hospital accounts. All responsible relatives are interviewed by the Reimbursement Division and a detailed financial statement is compiled and submitted to the Probate Judge to assist him in making his determination as to ability to pay. Through these interviews, the need for verification of settlement and residence is often indicated, and the matter is investigated by the Reimbursement Division. Many hundreds of dollars each year are saved by this county as a result of these investigations; the charge is properly billed to the patient's county of residence, or assumed by the state-at-large, rather than by our county, the committing county.

Therefore, a percentage of those patients listed as discharged might still be hospitalized as state-at-large charges.
