- ♦ Between 1990 and 1999, Oakland County households grew 14% to a total of 459,300 -- more households than each of 12 states.
- ♦ Oakland County's population grew 8.9% between 1990 and 1999 while the state of Michigan grew 6.1%. The increase in Oakland County accounts for 17% of the total increase in the state's population.
- ♦ In 2000, over thirteen percent (13.4) of people employed in Michigan worked in Oakland County.
- ♦ Oakland County's payroll in 1998 for its 41,626 businesses exceeded \$29.5 billion.
- Oakland County has 26 private and 60 public golf courses with over 900 golf holes available.
- ♦ Oakland County's Total Effective Buying Income (EBI) of \$29.8 billion was higher than that of 15 states in 1999.
- ♦ In 1999, Oakland County's median household EBI of \$52,669 was 7th highest nationally among other metro areas.
- Retail sales in Oakland County during 1999 totaled \$22.2 billion which exceeded the total retail sales of each of fifteen states.
- ♦ 38 percent of the Fortune 500 companies do business in the county.
- ♦ Oakland County is Michigan's leading center for international commercial activity with 565 companies representing 25 countries doing business in the County.
- Over 43 percent of Japanese owned firms in the state are located in the county.



FAST FACTS II

Oakland County



- ♦ More than \$2 billion (\$2.2) was invested in construction projects in the county during the year 2000.
- ♦ There are more natural lakes in the County than any other county in the state. Oakland contains about 1,468 lakes and the headwaters of five major rivers, the Clinton, Huron, Rouge, Shiawassee and Flint Rivers.
- Premiere cultural and entertainment options include the Meadow Brook Theatre, the Meadow Brook Music Festival, the Michigan Opera Theatre and the Detroit Symphony Orchestra Hall.
- ♦ More than 59,256 business establishments and government agencies are located in the county and employ over 795,000 people.
- ♦ Oakland County is home to 14 of Michigan's 27 institutions of higher learning including Lawrence Technological University and Oakland University. Total enrollment of these 14 schools exceeded 60,000 in 2000.
- ♦ One of Michigan's most popular tourist attractions is the 1.7 million square foot Great Lakes Crossing. This 175 store and entertainment center contains resturants, department store outlets, big box retailers and a 25-screen theater complex with stadium seating.
- ♦ More than one third of Michigan's R&D firms are located in Oakland County.
- ♦ More than 178 business, industrial, and research parks with a total of almost 9,000 acres have ready sites for manufacturing and R&D operations in the county.
- One third of all U.S. auto production takes place within 70 miles of the county.
- ♦ Per capita income of Oakland County residents in 1998 was \$42,378. Oakland ranks second in per capita income in 1998 for counties with over 1 million population.

- ♦ 38% of Fortune 500 companies do business in Oakland County.
- Kmart, Lear Corporation, Kelly Services and Meritor are the Fortune 500 companies headquartered in Oakland County. DaimlerChrysler AG is also headquartered in the county.
- ♦ In 2000, forty-five (45) of the Fortune 500 global companies did business in Oakland County. Oakland County's top 20 employers include international companies such as DaimlerChrysler, Ford, General Motors, Bank One, Kmart and Lear.
- General Motors Corporation ranks as the number one company in revenues in the world and country, and largest employer in Oakland County.
- ♦ Ford Motor Company ranks fourth in Fortune 500's 2000 list of largest corporations, but is only the eleventh largest employer in Oakland County.
- Six of the top sixteen leading auto suppliers in the county are also ranked among the largest 500 companies in the country.

FAST FACTS

Site & Building Data



- Oakland County has 178 business parks totalling over 9,000 acres.
- ♦ Auburn Hills and Wixom lead the county with 21 business parks each, Novi follows with 19 parks, Farmington Hills and Troy each have 17 and are closely followed by Commerce Township (14) and Rochester Hills (13).
- ♦ The 2000 rental rate for multi-tenant office space ranged from \$20.54 to \$28.04 per sq. ft.
- ♦ The lakes area, in the southwest region of the county, continues to develop due to an availability of land and growing infrastructure in Wixom and Walled Lake.
- ♦ The Auburn Hills / Rochester Hills area is the number one market for industrial and hi-tech space with 21,860,502 leasable square feet. Southfield is the number one office market with 15,613,097 leasable square feet.
- ♦ Auburn Hills and Wixom accounted for over half of the 10.4 million square feet of industrial projects planned for Oakland County during 2000. Auburn Hills led with 28.6% of planned development in square feet, while Wixom led in number of acres with 30.5%.
- ♦ Planned commercial space totaled 9.2 million square feet in 2000. Bloomfield Township leads with 3.45 million square feet, followed by Troy with 1.5 million, and Auburn Hills with 0.83 million.
- ♦ Troy has the greatest amount of new office space in the county with 720,000 square feet added since January 2000.
- ♦ Oakland County has obtained five new select retail centers in the last few years: Great Lakes Crossing and The Auburn Mile in Auburn Hills, Grand/Sakwa in Bloomfield Hills, Palladium in Birmingham and The Fountain Walk in Novi. These and other shopping centres make Oakland a premiere shopping destination.
- ♦ Oakland County is leading the way in new hospitality development with 13,200 hotel rooms. Wayne County has 13,400 rooms, Macomb County has 3,600 rooms and Ann Arbor has 3,500 rooms.
- Southfield is Oakland County's hub for telecom and data center activity due to its connectivity with multiple fiber optic carriers.

FAST FACTS Quality of Life



- The quality of life in Oakland County is sustained by excellent medical facilities, recreational parks and activities, sports teams, shopping centers, theaters and musical venues, and museums.
- ♦ More than 89,000 acres of park land offer year round outdoor recreation. In addition, three major downhill ski sites operate in the county.
- ♦ Premiere cultural entertainment venues include the Meadow Brook Theatre and the Meadow Brook Music Festival, the Palace of Auburn Hills, and the outdoor DTE Energy Music Theatre (formerly known as Pine Knob Music Theater.)
- ♦ Included among Oakland County's eight museums are the world renowned Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum, the Cranbrook Institute of Science and the brand new Chrysler Automotive Museum.
- ♦ The county is home to an extensive collection of malls and shopping centers ranging from the small village malls and popular local downtown shopping districts, to the multiple floor regional malls found in most major cities.
- ♦ The Great Lakes Crossing is an I-75 store and entertaiment venue, which is one of Michigan's most popular tourist attractions. It is home to the only Bass Pro Shop's "Outdoor World" center for the midwest/great lakes region.
- ♦ There over 60 public golf courses with almost 900 holes in Oakland County.
- ♦ There are 26 private golf courses in Oakland County.
- ♦ Included among the county's elite clubs are the Oakland Hills Country Club, home to the 1996 PGA U.S. Open and Indianwood Country Club, home to the 1994 LPGA U.S. Open. The 2003 Ryder Cup will be played at Oakland Hills Country Club.
- ♦ Professional sports venues include the Pontiac Silverdome, home to the Detroit Lions, and the Palace of Auburn Hills, home to the Detroit Pistons. Other professional sports teams include the Detroit Shock WNBA, Detroit Neon indoor soccer team and the Detroit Fury arena football.



Forecast Population Growth 2000-2030




- ♦ Oakland County's population is expected to grow 14% between 2000 and 2030.




Regional Share of Population






Oakland County Compared to Selected Suburban Counties



FIRMS WITH FOREIGN PARENT COMPANIES



- As of December 2000, 562 business locations with a foreign parent company had a presence in Oakland County.
- ♦ Altogether 25 different countries currently have business interests in the county. Countries doing business in Oakland County include the UK, Japan, Germany, France, Canada, Italy, Sweden, Spain, Switzerland, China, Korea and Taiwan. Other countries with a presence in the County also include: Africa, Australia, Brazil, India, Israel and Mexico.
- ♦ 40 percent of the firms with foreign parents in Michigan are in Oakland County.
- ♦ Japanese owned firms total 181 and comprise 32 percent of foreign owned firms in the county. German owned businesses rank second with 119 representing 21 percent of the county's international companies.
- ◆ Twelve of the sixteen leading auto suppliers located in Oakland County have business locations owned by foreign parent companies. They are: Delphi Automotive (UK), Robert Bosch Co. (Germany), Denso International Americas Inc.(Japan), Valeo Automotive (France), DuPont Automotive (Japan), Meritor Automotive Inc. (Japan), GKN Automotive Inc. (UK), AutoLiv North America (Sweden), Bridgestone/Firestone Inc. (Japan), Siemens Automotive Corp. (Germany), Sach Automotiveof America (Germany), and Calsonic North America Inc. (Japan).









- The County's labor force equaled 13.4% of the total persons employed in Michigan in 2000.
- The 2000 unemployment rate in Oakland County is 2.1%, which is the 3rd best county unemployment rate in the state.
- Oakland County employment increased 5% from 1997 to 2000. This equals 15% of the increase in employment in the state.
- Unemployment in 2000 marked the low for the decade.
- Oakland County contributed to the dramatic decrease in unemployment for the Detroit MSA. The decline in uenmployment for Oakland County from 1997 to 2000 accounted for 19% of the Detroit MSA decline.
- The labor force and the number of employed persons in Michigan have increased by 12.3% and 15.5% respectively, since 1990. Oakland County increases for the same time period are 13.4% and 16.7%.





Educational Attainment - Oakland County









- ♦ Between 1990 and 1999, Oakland County households grew 14% to a total of 459,300 -- more households than each of 12 states.
- Oakland County's population grew 8.9% between 1990 and 1999 while the state of Michigan grew 6.1%. The increase in Oakland County accounts for 17% of the total increase in the state's population.
- In 2000, over 13% of all people employed in Michigan worked in Oakland County.
- Oakland County's payroll in 1998 for its 41,626 businesses exceeded \$29.5 billion (County Business Patterns, 1998).



Median Household Income By Community, 1999





Business Parks:

- Almost 9,000 acres in Oakland County are currently contained in 178 business parks. Classifications for these business parks include research & development/hi-tech, light industrial, heavy industrial and office.
- ♦ Auburn Hills and Wixom lead the county with 21 business parks each. Novi ranks second with 19, followed by Farmington Hills and Troy (each have 17), Commerce Township with 14 and Rochester Hills with 13 business parks.
- ♦ In 2000, industrial parks occupied 688 acres in Madison Heights, 437 acres in Farmington Hills, 401 acres in Commerce Township and 364 acres in Troy. Oakland County's R&D/High Tech Parks were primarily located in Auburn Hills, which boasts 1,978 acres of these parks, followed by Novi (185 acres), Rochester (140 acres) and Southfield (109 acres).

Multi Tenant Office Buildings:

- ◆ Oakland County led the region in new office development in 1999, with a total of 4,570,203 square feet completed or under construction.
- Southfield has the lowest vacancy rate for multi tenant office space at 3.15%
- ♦ The major suburban markets for office space in Oakland County consisted of 42,322,310 square feet in 2000. Over three million square feet of this space was available to rent. The vacancy rate for Oakland County was 8.91% on average.
- ♦ The median cost for Oakland County multi-tenant office buildings is \$23.55 per sq. ft.
- Southfield, followed by Troy and Farmington Hills, have the most space available to rent.
- Multi-tenant office space occupancy reached an all-time high in 1999. Demand resulted in 20 new office projects in Oakland County for the first six months of 2000.



- ♦ Individual income tax rate reduced to 4.2% as of 2000
- ♦ Inheritance tax eliminated
- ♦ Phase out and elimination of the intangibles tax
- ♦ Phase out and elimination of the single business tax (SBT)
- **♦** Tax-free zones established in more than 100 Renaissance Zones to spur job creation and investment

These tax cuts saved business and families \$15 billion from 1991 through 2000.





PROPERTY TAXES



- ♦ Per person property tax is 12.1% below the national average.
- ♦ Property taxes are levied at state and local levels.
- ♦ The state reduced property taxes for school operations beginning in 1994.
- ♦ Businesses pay 24 mills in school property taxes, an average 30% less than before reforms.
- ♦ The taxable value of property is 50% of the current market value.
- Real and personal property are taxable.
- ♦ Annual property assessment increases will now be limited to the lesser of 5% or the rate of inflation.

SINGLE BUSINESS TAX



- ♦ The Single Business Tax (SBT) was instituted in 1975 to replace seven different business taxes.
- ♦ The SBT replaces such taxes as the business income tax, franchise fee and property tax on inventory.
- ♦ As of June 1999, Governor Engler started **phasing out the SBT** at a rate of .1% per year, retroactive to January 1st of 1999. This process will continue to eliminate the tax over the course of the next 23 years.
- ♦ The Budget Stabilization Fund (BSF) was created to protect valuable state programs and services in future years. Also known as the Rainy Day Fund, this program will halt the annual SBT rate cut any year in which the balance falls below \$250 million. This provides a safety net to ensure sufficient funds to support state programs and services.
- ♦ Impacts of the elimination of the Single Business Tax include:
 - ♦ Savings to businesses of \$339.7 million in 2001 and \$479.9 million in 2002
 - ♦ Savings to Michigan businesses of an estimated \$679.3 million since 1991 when several SBT reductions and reforms were implemented
 - ♦ Benefits to businesses and consumers through the capital saved in conducting business, which in turn will make it possible for employers to provide new jobs


SINGLE BUSINESS TAX



The Single Business Tax offers many advantages to Michigan businesses.

- ♦ Predictable cost of doing business
 - Profits are only part of tax base
 - Tax does not fluctuate dramatically with changes in profitability
 - Better planning of projected tax costs
- ♦ Generous capital acquisition deduction included
 - Purchases of real and personal property may be deducted from tax base
 - Apportionment formula used to determine the deduction for purchases of real and personal property
 - Value of deductions can be carried forward for up to ten years
- ♦ Deductions and credits reduce the tax burden for businesses (including small and low-profit businesses)
- **♦** Low percent of Michigan companies with Single Business Tax liabilities
- ♦ Tax liability cannot exceed 50% of adjusted gross receipts


SALES TAX



- Michigan's sales tax is set at 6%.
- Michigan allows no local sales tax, which makes Michigan's sales tax less burdensome than other locations in the United States that do allow local sales taxes.
- Michigan sales tax exemptions for businesses include:
 - ♦ Machinery and equipment used in manufacturing
 - ♦ Food, prescription drugs, medical devices and water
 - ♦ Air and water pollution abatement equipment



UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE



- ♦ Michigan's maximum weekly unemployment benefit amount is frozen at \$300.
- ♦ Michigan institutes a 10% across the board reduction in taxes during years that the Unemployment Trust Fund reaches qualified levels.
- ♦ Companies with no layoffs for five years or more can see their rates drop as low as .1%.
- ♦ Michigan has a highly experience-rated unemployment insurance system.
- ♦ Firms with few layoffs pay very low unemployment insurance costs.
- ♦ Firms with large layoffs pay higher rates.




WORKERS COMPENSATION



- ♦ An open competitive rating system was adopted in 1983 with more than 240 carriers. This allows carriers to offer competitive rates and let workers select the service that best meets their needs.
- ♦ Michigan employers have a variety of insurance plan options, including, group self-insurance, individual self-insurance, deductible plans, and retrospectively rated plans. Self-insurance accounts enable companies to save as much 50% in insurance costs.
- ♦ Workers' Compensation insurance rates continue to decline. Between 1995 and 1996, the rate dropped 16%. In 1998, Michigan witnessed a 3% drop. In 1999 and 2000, the rates further dropped by 4.5% and 3 %, respectively.
- Overall, people are working more and filing less. In 1994, there were 1380 total workers compensation awards considered. By 1999, this number had dropped 34% with 916 potential awards considered.

- ♦ The quality of life in Oakland County is sustained by excellent medical facilities, recreational parks and activities, sports teams, shopping centers, theaters and musical venues, and museums.
- ♦ More than 89,000 acres of park land offer year round outdoor recreation. In addition, three major downhill ski sites operate in the county.
- Residents of Oakland County live amid a variety of cultural entertainment venues, including the popular Meadow Brook Theatre and the Meadow Brook Music Festival Theatre, the summer home of the Detroit Symphony, the Palace of Auburn Hills, and the outdoor DTE Energy Music Theatre (formerly known as Pine Knob Music Theater.)
- ♦ Included among Oakland County's eight museums are the world renown Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum, the Cranbrook Institute of Science and the brand new Chrysler Automotive Museum.
- ♦ Great Lakes Crossing and the exclusive Somerset Collection are just two of the County's extensive collection of malls and shopping centers. Shopping opportunities range from the small village malls, popular local downtown shopping districts, to the multiple floor regional malls found in most major cities.
- ♦ The new Great Lakes Crossing is an 1-75 store and entertaiment venue, which is one of Michigan's most popular tourist attractions. It is home to the only Bass Pro Shop's outdoor World" center for the midwest/great lakes region.
- ♦ There are nearly 60 public golf courses with over 900 available holes in Oakland County.
- ♦ There are 26 private golf courses in Oakland County.
- Included among the county's elite clubs are the Oakland Hills Country Club, home to the 1996 PGA U.S. Open, and Indianwood Country Club, home to the 1994 LPGA U.S. Open. The 2001 PGA Championship and the Ryder Cup 2003 will be played at Oakland Hills Country Club.
- Professional sports venues include the Pontiac Silverdome, home to the Detroit Lions, and the Palace of Auburn Hills, home to the Detroit Pistons. Other professional sports teams include the Detroit Vipers IHL hockey team and the Detroit Shock soccer team.


