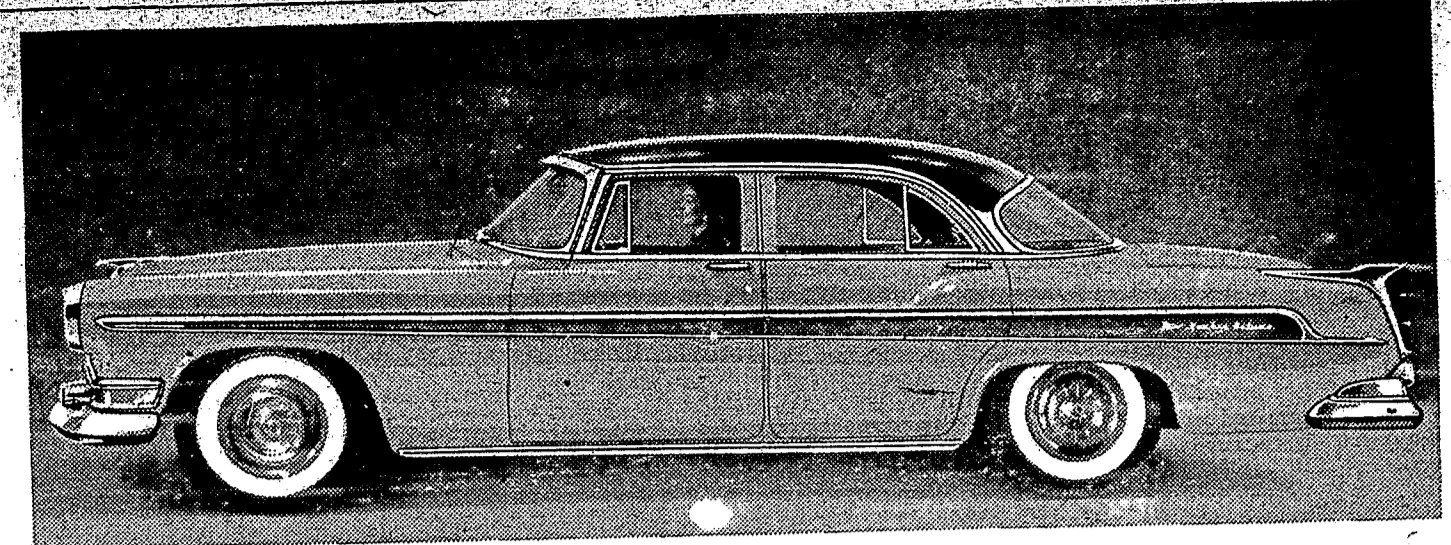

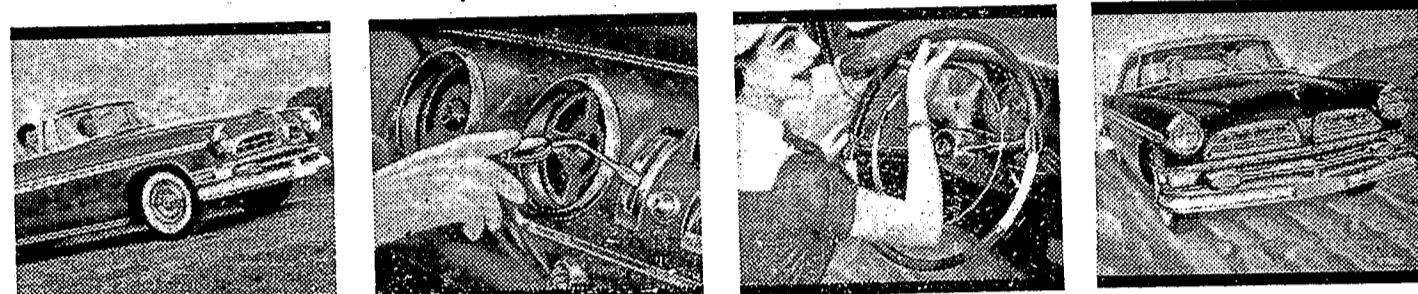

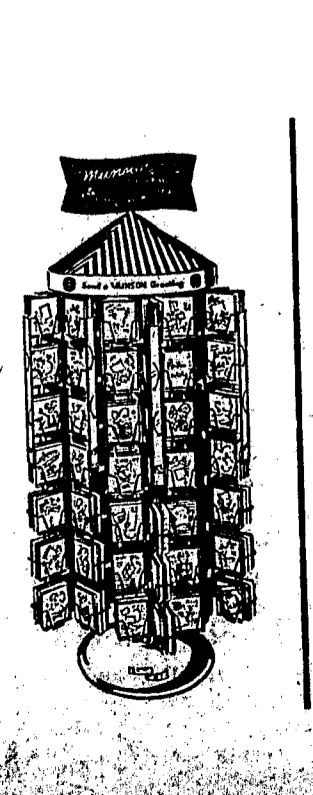

**YOUNG BALL PLAYERS TO HAVE TRYOUT**  
 Veteran Cardinal Scouts Bob Kline and Jack Sturdy have been assigned to handle the

workouts for the Red Bird tryout camp scheduled at Memorial Stadium in Pt. Huron, Michigan, on Thursday and Friday, August 4 and 5, it was announced today.
