**ADVICE TO FARMERS FROM CONGRESSMAN BROOMFIELD**

Procedures for Oakland County farmers to obtain emergency Federal loans from crop damage were outlined today by Congressman William S. Broomfield (R-

Oakland County). Oakland is one of 14 counties in Michigan which became eligible for such loans because of heavy windstorm and rain damage this summer. Any farm owner or operator in Oakland County is eligible if

he suffered production loss because of the storms, is unable to obtain the credit to continue his farming and has a reasonable prospect for success with the help of a loan, said Broomfield. The loans may be used to buy feed, seed, equipment and livestock or for the replacement or repair of damaged buildings, fences and other equipment. But the loans may not be used for refinancing existing debts or to compensate for losses. Broomfield said the loans bear

three per cent interest and are scheduled for payment according to the ability of the farmer to pay back the debt.

Farmers may apply for the loans until June 30, 1958. Detailed information on the emergency loan program can be obtained by contacting Mr. M. Keith Russell, Reickhoff Building 106 1/2 State Street, Howell.
