**PARIS? NO, TOKYO!**



Newest sightseeing attraction in the fast-growing Japanese capital is this giant TV tower now nearing completion. Soaring 1,089 feet into the heavens, it tops the famed Eiffel Tower by more than one hundred feet and rises higher than any New York City skyscraper except the Empire State Building. In addition to housing TV and radio antennas, the Tokyo tower has two observation platforms served by high-speed elevators. The first, approximately 390 feet above ground, is at the height of a thirty story building. Far more spectacular, however, is the lookout at the 738-foot level. From this lofty perch, says the Japan Tourist Association, visitors may enjoy a panoramic view not only of Tokyo, but also of Mt. Fuji and—even farther away—the snow-capped northern and southern ranges of the Japanese Alps.

**50th ANNIVERSARY OF METAL LICENSE PLATES.**

In 1909, Michigan celebrates its 50th year of metal automobile

plates. According to James M. Hare, Secretary of State, the law requiring vehicle licenses was passed in 1904. During the first full year 2,188 intrepid pioneers registered their gasoline buggies. This compares with almost three million passenger cars registered last year. The first standard plates, which were black on white, were manufactured in Jackson Prison in 1910. These first plates were porcelain. Today, Michigan's license plates are still being manufactured by the Michigan State Industries Branch of the Corrections Department. In 1905, before plates were issued the motorist received a metal disk which he affixed to the dashboard of his automobile. However, motorists were urged to put bronze registration numbers on a leather strip and to hang it on the car axle. In 1905 the total revenue for vehicle and chauffeurs' licenses was less than \$7,000. Last year the total income from motor vehicles, operators, and chauffeurs' licenses was more than \$70,000,000. In 1905 the vehicle fee for autos was \$2.00 but a chauffeur's license selling for \$1.00 was also sold in a package deal at the same time. A display of each metal plate used for the past 50 years as well as examples of the brass disk and the leather plates are on exhibit on the ground floor of the State Capitol in Lansing. It is a favorite stop for the thousands of youngsters who visit the Capitol on school trips each year.

**RUM BUBBLES**  
2 1/4 cups sifted enriched flour 1 1/4 cups confectioners' sugar  
1/4 teaspoon baking soda 1 egg  
1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar 1 teaspoon rum extract  
1/4 cup shortening (half butter or margarine) Pecan halves (about 6 ounces)

Sift together flour, baking soda and cream of tartar. Cream together shortening and sugar until light and fluffy. Add egg and rum extract. Beat thoroughly. Cover and chill in refrigerator until mixture, mixing thoroughly. Cover and chill in refrigerator until firm, about 2 to 3 hours. Shape into small balls and flatten with finger tips. Press pecan half into each cookie. Bake on ungreased baking sheet in moderate oven (375°F.) 8 to 10 minutes. Makes 5 dozen 1 1/2-inch cookies. These will keep about 1 week.

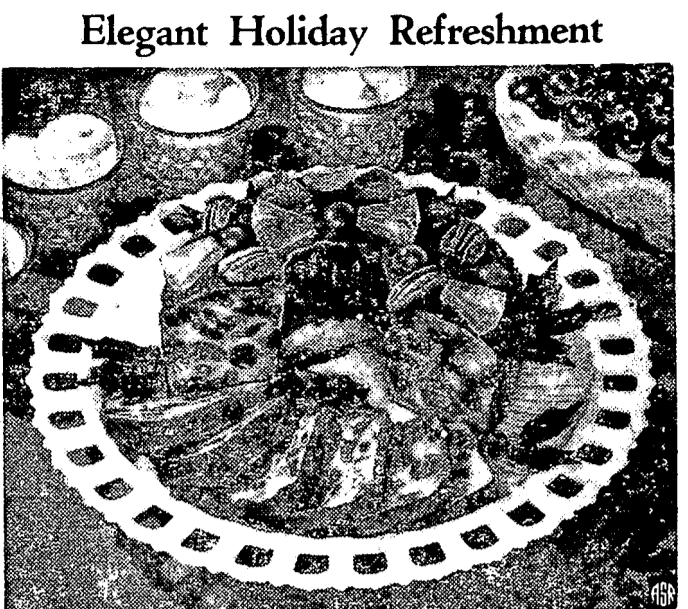
