**Mechanical Breadwinner for Game**



One of the Conservation Department's latest habitat-improvement tools for game—a D-7 tractor equipped with an 11-foot cutting blade—will begin thrusting its way through snow, brush and timber in food-shortage areas of northern Michigan this month. The 20-ton machine will again be tested on non-merchantable stands of aspen to furnish browse for deer, stimulate sprout regeneration for their post-winter food supply, and provide cover and vegetation for small game. Under normal winter conditions, the crawler-type tractor levels two to three acres per hour. Department game men report the machine's test cuttings last winter were successful.

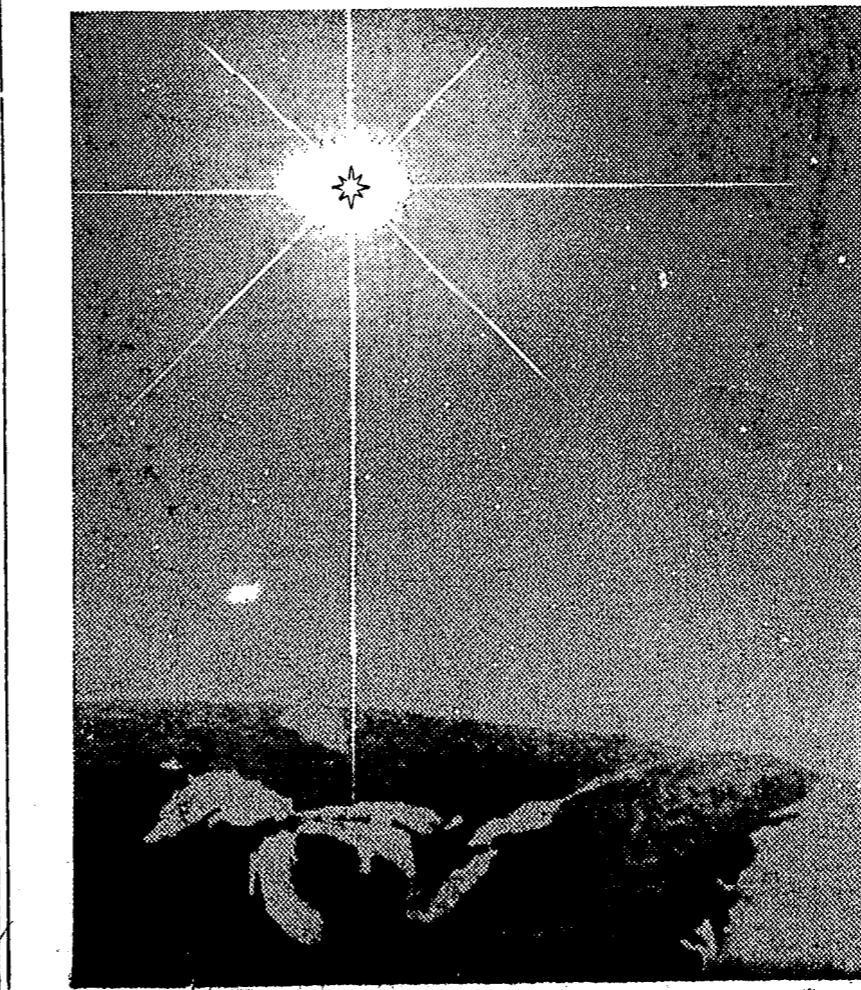
