#### **PREFACE**

The Oakland County Planning Department is officially designated as Summary Tape Processing Center by the U. S. Census Bureau. Serving in the capacity of an information, data will be provided to communities, businessmen, and citizens in both printed form and on magnetic tape when requested. The census information provides an important analytical foundation for all government and business decisions. For the first time, data will be available within areas small enough to be customized to the users needs.

#### DATA ORGANIZATION

The data which you are about to use is organized by community. All small area data is summarized to community totals. There are 54 separate line items listed under Population Characteristics, Housing Characteristics, and Household Characteristics.

The small area data is provided by census tract, enumeration district (E.D.) and block group (B.G.). These census areas decrease in geographic area, starting with the census tract as largest and ending with the block group as the smallest.

Census Tract - The census tract is a convenient type of area to be used for decennial comparisons. It is identified by four or six digit numbers on both the printout and map. The last two digits of the six digit code represent new tracts formed from a previous single tract.

Enumeration District - The E.D. is used as an area for field coverage by the enumerator. It is identified by a one to three digit number on the printout map. Each number is preceded by "E.D.". The E.D. was the only area smaller than the census tract in the 1960 census.

Block Group - The B.G. is a product of a new mail out/mail back questionnaire which was used for the first time in 1970 census. Each B.G. consists of several blocks with address ranges used for the mailing of the questionnaire. The B.G. is identified by one digit on the map and by a digit preceded by "B.G." on the printout.

#### DATA LIMITATIONS AND SUPPRESSION

In some instances, census tracts will have neither block group or enumeration district data. If a geographic boundary was questionable or if total population did not balance to community totals, the discrepancy was avoided at the small area level. Some data will not be released because of the confidentiality rule of the U. S. Bureau of the Census. When there is the possibility of data revealing the identification of an individual, the symbol "N/A", not available, is used.


