Marie Eunice Stephens of Kingston, Tennessee, died January 7, 1991, in her home. She was 79.

Mrs Stephens, a former Lake Orion resident, was born in East Dayton, Michigan, December 3, 1911, to Charles Brady and Myrtle Wells.

She graduated from Lake Orion High School in 1929 and married Mack Stephens on September 7, 1947, in Lake Orion. She had lived in Kingston for one year after moving from Coconut Creek, Florida.

Mrs Stephens last worked as a material control hand-
