A 34-year-old Lake Orion man died when a motorcycle he was riding slammed into a pickup truck.

Deputy Thomas
Poulin said the

man was a passenger on a 1995 Suzuki heading south on M-24 north of Clarkston Road about 12:25 p.m. Wednesday.

"Witnesses indicated that the motorcycle was darting in and out of traffic," Poulin said. "It pulled a wheelie at the line."

Poulin said a 34-year-old Pontiac man pulled his pickup truck onto M-24 from the west side of the road. He paused in the southbound lanes waiting for an opening to go north. The southbound traffic appeared well up the road when he pulled out, investigators said.

But the motorcycle driver, a

32-year-old Lake Orion man, continued toward the pickup.

"He laid the bike down before impact," Poulin said. "He struck the front left wheel of the truck."

The impact pushed the truck several feet, Poulin said. The driver of the pickup was unhurt. The driver of the motorcycle was injured but is expected to recover.

Investigators withheld the name of the victim until all of his family members could be notified.
