

ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF *Canaan*

No more than one tract or parcel must be valued or listed on the same line. Two descriptions must not be joined in one valuation of tax, unless owned and occupied by the same person, beginning with section one, and if the name of the owner is not known, they should be assessed as "owners unknown." Enter the amount of any discount or abatement the re-assessment was made. The attention of assessing officers is especially called to sections 18 to 27 of the Tax Law of 1880; they should be carefully studied and the directions therein contained should be strictly followed.—AUDITOR GENERAL'S OFFICE, 1880.
