Two descriptions must not be joined in one valuation or tax, unless owned and OCCUPIED together, beginning with section one, and if the name of the owner is not known, they should be assessed as 'owner unknown.' Enter the amount of any Re-assessment with Red the re-assessment was made. The attention of assessing officers is especially called to sections 15 to 27 of the Tax Law of 1886; they should be carefully studied and the directions therein contained should be strictly followed.—AUDITOR GENERAL'S OFFICE, 1886.
