

## PONTIAC BILL POSTER

Wm. Baker, of Highland, was a passenger on the train ticketed from Detroit to Clyde Sunday evening. On arriving at Clyde he was missed, and the train backed to Highland Station, where he was found with his body lying partly on the low platform between the tracks, with his left leg and arm badly smashed by the car wheels. He was conscious on the way to Holly, and stated that he was not hurt much till the train backed over him. He had a brother at Highland and it is supposed he jumped of the train there, as it did not stop. His arm was amputated about noon, and he died soon after. He was single and 33 years old. He had been a brakeman on the road. *APR 27 1885*

—The Nashville News:—James M. Cole, aged 71, Supervisor of Woodland in '44, and highly respected citizen, departed this life Tuesday morning. He was one of Michigan's earliest pioneers, died of consumption at his home in Woodland on the 7th. Mr. Cole was born at Covert, Seneca Co., N. Y., November 14, 1814. In 1835 he was married to Miss Abigail Holloway, of the same place, and moved to Huron county, Ohio, remaining there one summer. He then moved to the territory of Michigan, landing in Detroit 50 years ago. The energetic couple then started on foot for the township of Waterford, Oakland county, Mich., where in due time they arrived and entered upon the labor of clearing a farm. They remained there until 1844, when they came to Woodland, this county, where they have ever since resided. The funeral services were held in the Baptist church in Woodland, Elder Holler officiating.

The infant son of Mr. and Mrs. Geo Wolly died on the 13<sup>th</sup> inst and was interred in the Waterford Center cemetery. *APR 29 1885*
