

PONTIAC BILL POSTER

John K. Dewey died April 12, at the residence of his son Chas. E. Dewey, at Four Towns. Deceased was born in Royalton, Windsor Co., Vermont, Feb. 28, 1795. Moved to New York state with the man to whom he was apprenticed at the carpenter and joiner trade, and on Nov. 23, 1819, was married to Harriet Hunt, whose death occurred Aug. 20, 1863. He moved to Michigan in 1831, and settled in Waterford township where he has since resided. He was made a F. & A Mason in New York in 1818, and was an honorary member of Birmingham Lodge at the time of his death and of which lodge he was also a charter member. Funeral from the house to-morrow (Thursday) at 11 o'clock. The members of B'ham lodge will attend the funeral in a body. *APR 13 1887*

Died, at the residence of his parents, in Detroit, on Monday April 4, 1887, of measles, Doty, only son of Mr. and Mrs. A. R. Buchanan. Deceased was born in Orion township, where he had always lived until April 1886, when he entered the employ of the M. C. R. R. Co., where he was well liked and highly spoken of.
