Smith, which occurred in Big Rapids Wednesday evening last at about half-past seven. On the enorning of the 20th of last month. Mrs. Smith presented her husband with another son. For a few days follewing, the patient seemed to be doing well; last Saturday her condition was not so favorable, inflammation of the bowels set in, and, despite the best efforts of Drs. Bigelow and Griswold and loving friends, death claimed its own. Deceased, who had resided in Pontiac, Mich., the most of her life with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. A. A. Lall, was married to Mr. Smithtwelve years ago, A few years after Detroit was belected for a home, and three years ago the lady with her husband and children removed to Big Rapids. where they have since resided.
