*April 25 1888*

**Gazette:** "Died in Detroit on Sunday morning, April 8th, at the residence of her daughter, Mrs. Henry N. Williams, Mrs. Clewitt, aged 75 years. Funeral Tuesday, April 10. The deceased was for 18 years housekeeper for Mrs. John P. Holley, of this city, by whom her daughter, Mary Clewitt, was reared and educated. Mrs. Clewitt was held in high esteem by all who knew her, and by none more so than by Mr. and Mrs. John P. Holley."

**Milford Times:** "Cornelius Austin, Oakland county's oldest citizen died at Walled Lake Saturday, April 14, aged 97 years. Mr. Austin was born in New Jersey in 1791. He served in the war of 1812, afterwards settling in the township of Commerce, his son being the first white child born in the township. Mr. Austin was in ordinarily good health until this winter and confidently expected to complete his century, when a fall upon the ice gave him a shock from which he never recovered." *April 25 1888*
