Mrs. Dorcas Bayley, wife of the late James Bagley, was born in Cayuga Co., N. Y., August 26th, 1804. She was the daughter of the late Michael Pearsall, who was a resident of Troy at the date of his death. In Jan., 1825 Dorcas Pearsall was united in marriage with James Bayley and in March of the same year came with her husband to Michigan and settled on the middle part of the south half of Section 21, in Troy Township. A log house was soon erected with ample accommodations suited to their circumstances. As happy a couple as ever settled
