PONTIAC BILL POSTER

STATE OF MICHIGAN, County of Oakland, ss.—At a session of the Probate Court for the County of Oakland, holden at the Probate Office, in the city of Pontiac, on the 2d day of February, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six.

In the matter of the estate of William Ball, deceased.

On reading and filing the petition, duly verified, of Michael C. Hughston, for an examination and allowance of his final account, his discharge as such administrator, and the appointment of James Brown or some other suitable person as administrator de bonis non of said estate.

Thereupon it is ordered, that the 25th day of February, 1886, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, be assigned for the hearing of said petition, and that the heirs at law of said deceased and all other persons interested in said estate are required to appear at a session of said court, to be holden at the Probate Office, in the city of Pontiac, and show cause, if any there be, why the prayer of the petitioner should not be granted; and it is further ordered, that said petitioner give notice to the persons interested in said estate, of the pendency of said petition, and the hearing thereof, by causing a copy of this order to be published in the Pontiac Bill Poster a newspaper printed and circulating in said county of Oakland, three successive weeks previous to said day of hearing.
