

PONTIAC BILL POSTER

STATE OF MICHIGAN, County of Oakland, ss. At a session of the Probate Court for the County of Oakland, holden at the Probate Office, in the city of Pontiac, on Mednesday, the 7th day of December, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven.

Present—Thomas L. Patterson, Judge of Probate.

In the matter of the estate of Alonzo P. Cambeil, deceased.

On reading and filing the petition duly verified of John H. Baldwin, a creditor, praying among other things that administration of said estate may be granted to him or to some other suitable person.

Thereupon it is ordered, that the 5th day of January, 1888, at 10 o'clock in the afternoon, be assigned for the hearing of said petition and that the heirs at law of said deceased, and all other persons interested in said estate, are required to appear at a session of said Court, to be holden at the Probate Office, in the city of Pontiac, and show cause, if any there be, why the prayer of the petitioner should not be granted, and it is further ordered that said petitioner give notice to the persons interested in said estate, of the pendency of said petition, and the hearing thereof, by causing a copy of this order to be published in the Pontiac Bill Poster, a newspaper printed and circulating in said county of Oakland, three successive weeks previous to said day of hearing.
