PONTIAC BILL POSTER

STATE OF MICHIGAN, County of Oakland ss.—At a Session of the Probate Court for the county of Oakland, holden at the Probate Office, in the city of Pontiac on the 2d day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven.

Present, Thomas L. Patterson, Judge of Probate.

In the matter of the estates of Sarah Johnson, deceased.

On reading and filing the petition, duly verified, of M. F. Johnson, praying among other things for the appointment of himself or some other suitable person as administrator of said estate.

Thereupon it is ordered, that the 1st day of December, 1887, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, be assigned for the hearing of said petition, and that the heirs at law of said deceased, and all other persons interested in said estate, are required to appear at a session of said Court, then to be holden at the Probate Office, in the City of Pontiac, and show cause, if any there be, why the prayer of the petitioner should not be granted; and, it is further ordered, that said petitioner give notice to the persons interested in said estate, of the pendency of such petition, and the hearing thereof, by causing a copy of this order to be published in THE PONTIAC BILL POSTER, a newspaper printed and circulated in said county of Oakland, three successive weeks previous to said day of hearing.
