Democratic supervisor from Waterford. He was born in Grand Blanc, Genesee County, October 16, 1870, and is the son of J. C. Adams, who is a farmer and one of the oldest stock buyers on the Detroit market. Mr. Adams when a young man moved with his parents to a farm in Holly township, where he was engaged in teaching school winters until 1901, when he moved to Waterford, where he followed the pursuit of farming. In 1897 Mr. Adams was married to Blanche W. Earle, daughter of O. C. Earle. Mr. Adams has been a Maccabee since 1893, and a member of Lakeside and Oakland County

Pomona Grange, holding office in each. He represented his township on the board of supervisors in 1893 and 1905.
