

## WILLIAM T. MATHEWS.



Republican supervisor of the Fifth Ward, city of Pontiac, was born in the city of Detroit, Michigan, August 15, 1854, and was adopted from the Protestant Orphan Asylum of that city in 1864, by Jefferson K. Tindall (now deceased) of Springfield township, Oakland county, with whom he made his home until he was of age. He served as a member of the board of supervisors from the township of Groveland from 1884 to 1888 inclusive, and from the Fifth Ward, city of Pontiac, from 1902 to 1905 inclusive. He held the office of register of deeds of Oakland county from

1895 to 1899 inclusive, during which term of office he completed a set of abstract books, forming the basis of a business which he has since pursued.
