

Hutton, Robert S.,

Was born in Kinross, Scotland, September 26, 1831 and came to the States with his parents in 1840. His parents were John and Catherine (Wylie) Hutton and were born in Scotland. It is not known when he came to Genesee County, Michigan but he was there in 1852 when he became a member Genesee Lodge No. 23.

September 10, 1856 he was married to Clymena Palmerlee, who was born in Franklinville, Cattaragus County, N. Y. To them seven children were born; Lucy, Nannie, George, Lillie, Mary and Millie and one died in infancy. Lillie, now Mrs. Kirk White of Lapeer to whom I am indebted for the above further states that while they were in Pontiac "my father was a clerk in a large store. When they moved to Hadley he opened a store of his own with a partner, David Mills. After he was elected Register of Deeps f Lapeer County he moved his family to Lapeer. He held this position one and one-half years when he was found dead in his office, June 26, 1886. After my father's death the family moved back to Hadley. My mother died there June 7 approximately 1900," Mrs. White served ar Worthy Matron of Martha Chapter, O. E. S. four years.

Raised in Genesee Lodge No. 23, January 5, 1852; transferred to Acacia No. 45 to bec me a charter member December 25, 1854; transferred to Oakwood Lodge No. 100 in 1858; dimitted to Pontiac Lodge No. 21 December 9, 1859 and was elected January 6, 1860; transferred to Hadley No. 210, March 31, 1869. Served as Secretary of Pontiac Lodge No. 21, 1860-1861-1862 and was Worshipful Master of Hadley Lodge 1870-75 and 1877-78 and 1884. High Priest of Lapeer Chapter R. A. M. No. 91, 1885.
