The greater part of the work in the County Treasurer's office has to do with the collection of delinquent tax, mortgage tax, dog tax and inheritance tax.

The revenue taken in by the County Treasurer from January 1, 1928, to July 1, 1928, amounted to \$7,747,795.66. The disbursements for the same period amounted to \$6,648,106.85.

The distribution of the delinquent tax, redemptions, May tax sale, collections by the Auditor General, charges by the Auditor General, to the State, County, County Road, Covert Roads, Drains, and Townships, Cities and Villages, makes an endless amount of bookkeeping in detail.
