Not much has been learned of this brother excepting that he lived in Waterford Township and later moved to Linden, Mich. Brother Claude E. Hyatt, of Linden has given the following information: "He joined Linden Lodge on a dimit from Waterford Lodge No. 98 on April 17, 1894. Died here on Dec. 25, 1897 and was buried with Masonic Service at White Lake Dec. 27, 1897.

He bought a small farm here just outside of the corporation limits but was, on account of age and physical condition, unable to work it himself. There was a young man named Ira Caster who made his home at Mr. Howland's and worked the farm and did such other work as he could for others. I think there was a son, but of that I am not sure. There was however a daughter named Grace, who after the death of her father, married Ira Caster. They were finally divorced and Grace then married a man named Frank Sanford. I think he is also dead. They lived then near Flint."

Masonic record. Raised in Cedar Lodge No. 60, June 12, 1856, transferred to Waterford Lodge No. 98, March 29, 1857 to become a charter member. Dimitted to Linden Lodge No. 132, April 17, 1894.
