Personal Estate must be entered in a different line, as well as column, from Real Estate. Non-resident land must be entered in numerical order, beginning with section one, for "Remarks," state opposite each parcel for what year the re-assessment was made. Two or more City or Village lots, owned and occupied as one parcel, may be assessed another, the township taxes in another, the county taxes in another, and the State taxes in another column; and if other taxes are at any time required by law, they shall be placed each in another column. "Omitted lands" placed upon this roll under the provisions of Act No. 6, Laws of 1873, must be placed upon a part of said assessment roll separate and distinct from the lands as assessed for the current year, and immediately preceded by a statement which shall distinctly set forth the year in which such land was omitted and for which it is then placed thereon.] (See, 4.)—AUDITOR GENERAL'S OFFICE, 1877.]
