

Assessment Roll for the Township of Avon

For more than one tract or parcel must be valued or taxed on the same line. Two descriptions need not be placed in one valuation or tax, unless owned and occupied as one parcel. If the name of the owner is not known, they should be assessed as "owner unknown." Enter the amount of any abatement with the tax in the column next to section one, and if the name of the owner is not known, they should be carefully studied and the directions therein contained observed. The situation of assessing officers is especially called to sections 15 to 27 of the Tax Law of 1897; they should be carefully studied and the directions therein contained observed.
