<sup>15</sup> If more than one tax is levied on a specific land, it must be taxed on the same line. *Attention:* *Land with two or more taxes must be taxed on the same line.* Enter the amount of the assessment and add it to the value of the tax for which the land is used, and in the column for "Occupant" enter the name of the person who owns the land, and in the column for "Occupant" enter the same name as the name of the occupant if the premises are occupied by the owner, or the word "Mortgagor". In column 9 on the same line as the name of the owner or (occupant) enter the name of the mortgagee if the premises are occupied by the mortgagor, or the word "Mortgagor". The attention of assessing officers is especially called to section 15 of the Tax Law of 1894, which they should carefully study, and the directions there contained should be strictly followed.—ATTORNEY GENERAL OF TEXAS, OCTOBER 1894.
