Planning Board Releases Master Plan to Citizens

Wixom Council Argues Ordinance Asks Committee for Study, Suggestions

The Wixom city council met in "executive session" Monday night to discuss a proposed ordinance creating a department of public safety. The meeting was held at the Wixom City Hall. Mayor Donald Brooks said Tuesday that another such meeting would be held this coming Monday. The meeting is closed to the public. The "executive session" is held upon the Council as if it were another committee assigned to study a ticklish problem. And indeed, that is what it is.

At last Thursday's regular Council meeting, Brooks appointed councilman Fred Beamish and Howard Coe to a committee to study the ordinance. He asked another but then all indicated they would be interested in coming, too.

The ordinance that is under consideration concerns the integration of the policemen and firemen as public safety officials.

Many area communities, including Farmington and Oak Park, have such a department of public safety and reportedly, are satisfied.

"But there are things to be ironed out, reports Brooks, and some Councilmen are for some things, others against other things."

A major bone of contention seems to be to what extent the firemen shall have law enforcement powers. While it was indicated that the problem was "virtually" solved, there still are differences.

The Citizens Development committee accepted — with thanks — the planning board's up-to-the-minute data and maps of the Novi master plan Monday night.

They asked for all the information the planning board could provide and then asked for the opportunity to study what the planning board had done.

The planning board, in turn, requested their comments and suggestions after the conclusion of their studies. As Board Chairman Vincent Miklas put it: "We're tired of our ideas. It would be nice to hear somebody else's ideas."

The occasion for the turnover of the data to the Citizens Development committee was quite impromptu. The planning board could not hold its regular bi-monthly session for lack of a quorum, only three members were on hand — Miklas, Arthur Heslip and Andrew Burgess. Consultant Waldemar Johnson was also present.

The board agenda contained a note under "discussions" that the planning studies might be referred to the citizens.

But the citizens were meeting upstairs in the village having dinner. Rather than arrange another night, both groups agreed to meet jointly. And so they did for two and a half hours, a square off Wednesday with the final Friday.

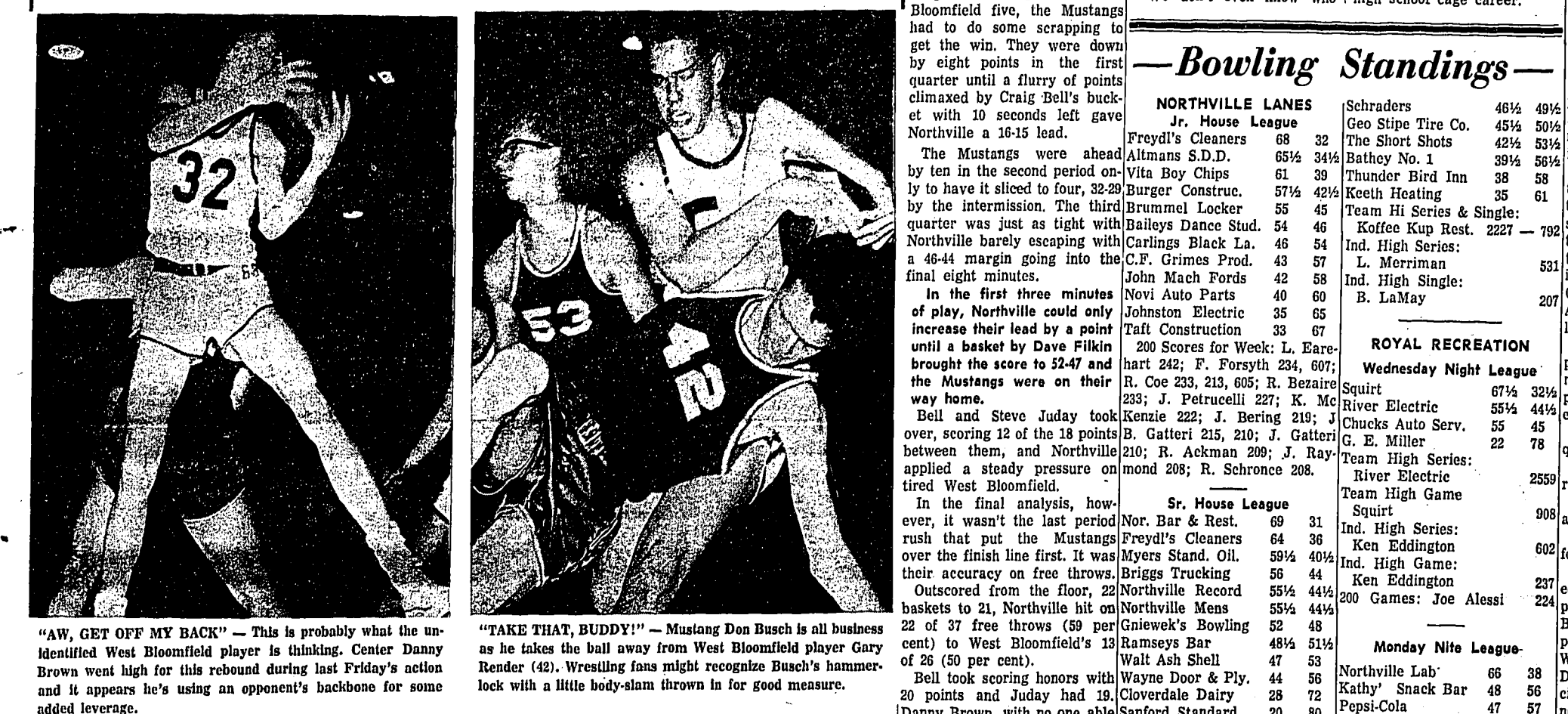
