Lots of Proteins Packed In 'Lens-Shaped Seeds'

- LENTIL LOAF: 1 pound package lentils (medium onion, chopped), 1 cup dried celery, 1 egg, 1 cup cooked rice, 1 tablespoon salt, 1/2 cup margarine or butter, 1/4 teaspoon oregano (about an hour). Saute onion and celery in margarine or butter; mix with lentils and remaining ingredients; put in baking dish and bake 45-60 minutes at 350 degrees.
