## Kitchen Diary

### No Topping These Rolls

No one, but no one... not cake and chocolate fudge, even Betty Crocker, we'll waver - serves up a batch of refrigerator rolls to match those Mrs. Howard Meyer ships up in her kitchen at 48120-West Eight Mile road.

Shaped like figure eights and brushed with butter, the rolls have won Mrs. Meyer the plaudits of everyone who has tasted them.

Tip to this week - when the homemaker agrees to share some of her favorites with Kitchen Diary - the recipe could be found in the files of only a few. But here it is along with three other Meyer specialties - deep freeze lemon pie filling and frosting for slices.

**REFRIGERATOR ROLLS**  
Mrs. Howard Meyer  
1 cup dry yeast  
2 cups warm water  
1 cup sugar  
2 1/2 cups sifted flour  
1/2 cup melted shortening  
1 egg  
Dissolve yeast in water; add sugar, salt and half the flour. Beat two minutes. Add egg and shortening. Beat in remaining flour. Mix with hands until smooth. Place in bowl and grease top; cover with damp cloth and place in refrigerator. Punch down occasionally. Two hours before baking cut off amount needed.

**SHEET CAKE FILLING AND FROSTING**  
Split a 2x12 butter cake, fill with:  
1/2 cup brown sugar  
1/2 T butter  
1/2 T water  
1 egg yolk  
Mix; cook over low heat for five minutes. Add 3/4 cup ground nuts. Spread quickly.

**CHOCOLATE FUDGE**  
1/2 cup powdered sugar  
1/2 cup butter  
1 egg yolk  
1/2 L vanilla  
Cream sugar and butter. Add egg yolks and vanilla; beat.

**DEEP FREEZE LEMON PIE**  
3 egg yolks, beaten  
1/2 cup lemon juice  
1/2 cup and 1 T sugar  
dash of salt  
3 egg whites, stiffly beaten  
1 cup heavy cream, whipped  
1 cup vanilla wafers, crushed  
Combine first five ingredients and cook over hot water.

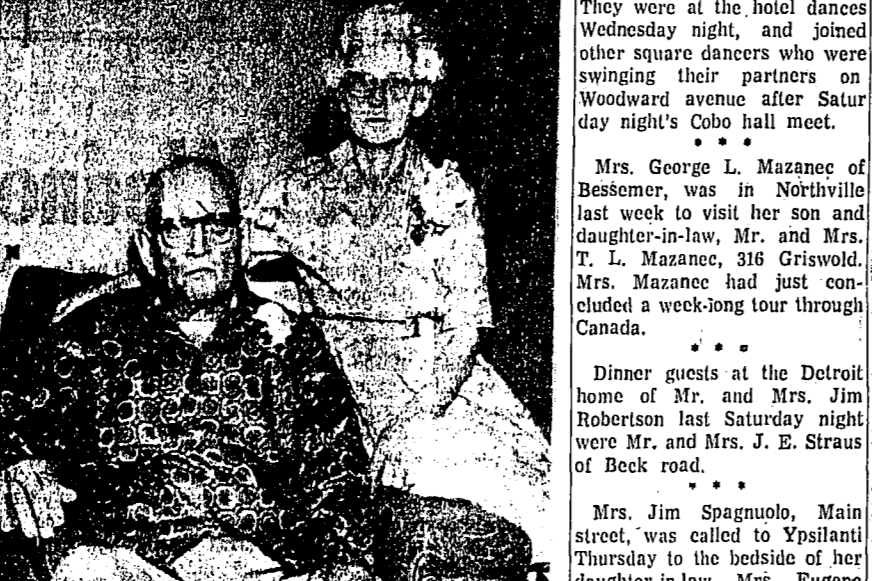

Two Plymouth women, Marion Finnegan and Edna Willoughby, will attend the International Jehovah's Witnesses convention in Europe July 11 through August 11.

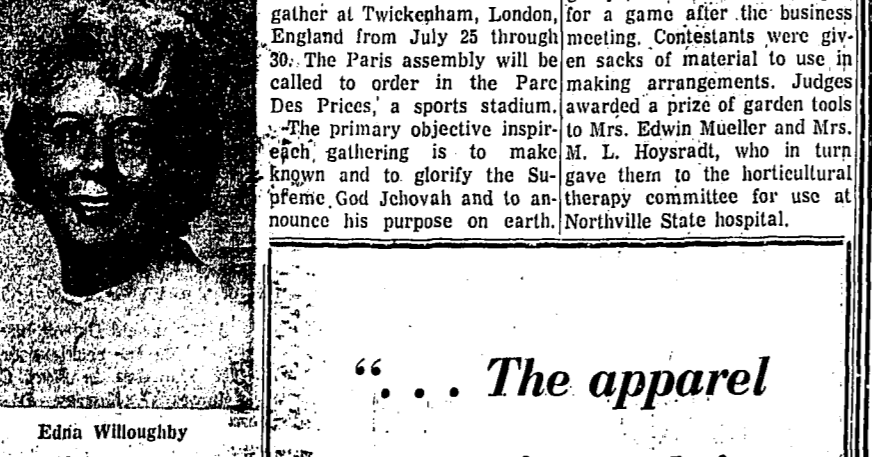

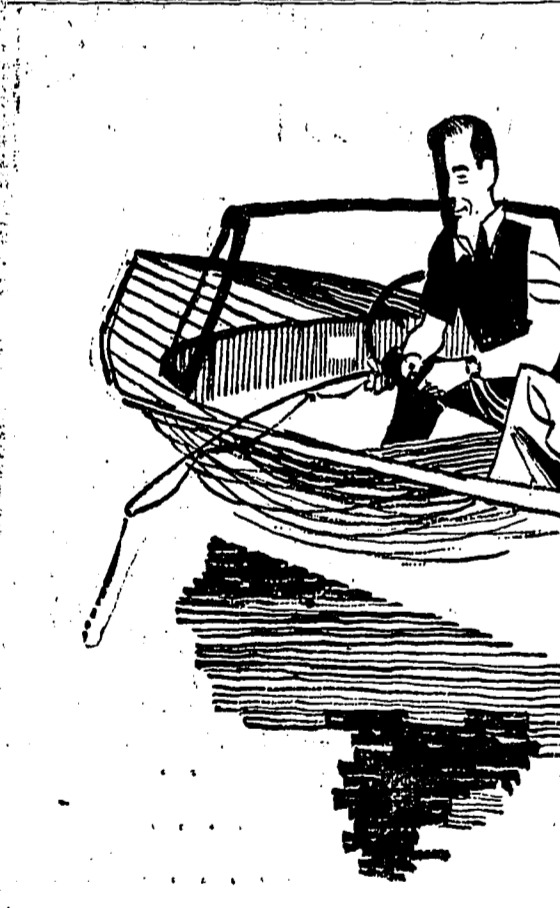

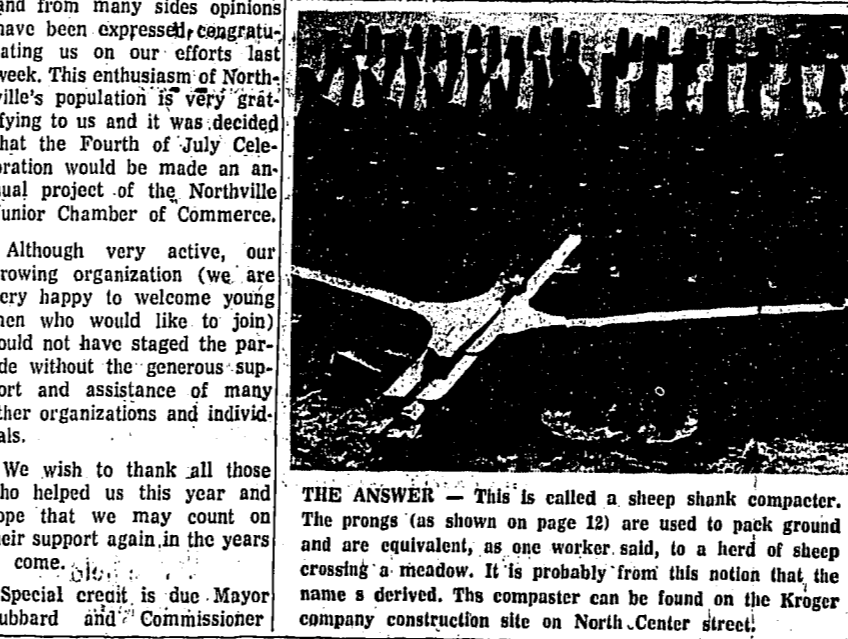
Although very active, our growing organization (we are very happy to welcome young men who would like to join) could not have staged the parade without the generous support and assistance of many other organizations and individuals.
