

Michigan Mirror 19th District Difficult to Form

Voters probably will elect a committee to study the possibility of a 19th district in Michigan. The Legislature's first attempt to reapportion the state's Congressional districts to create a 19th seat met a veto on the Governor's desk.

Republicans in the Legislature admitted the plan was a "status quo" measure, which would have left most of the districts as they are now. The district would have been created with the southwestern section of the state.

The Legislature is expected to try again in the remaining weeks of the session. It is expected that the "old guard" of the GOP ranks will go along with the reapportionment plan proposed by Gov. George Romney.

The Morris plan was tentatively approved by the Michigan Democratic Party. The plan would have created a 19th district in the western part of the state.

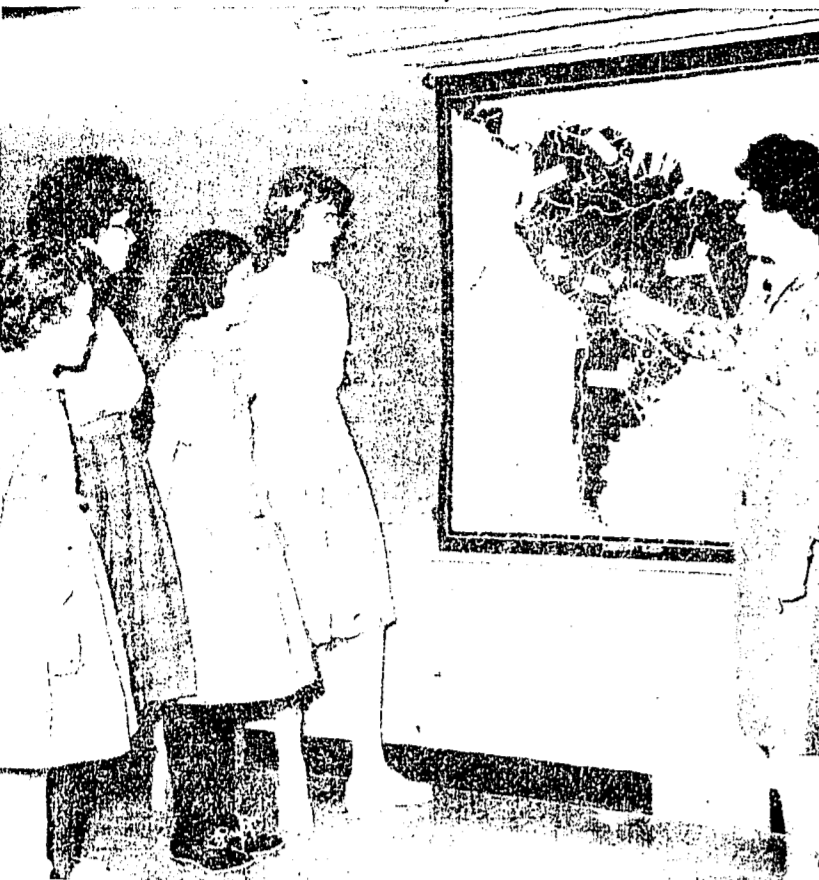

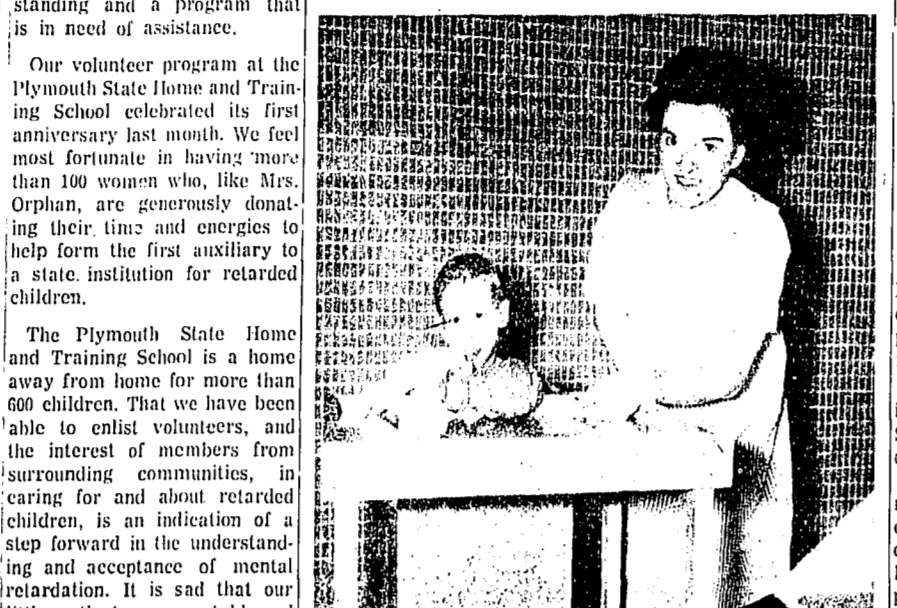

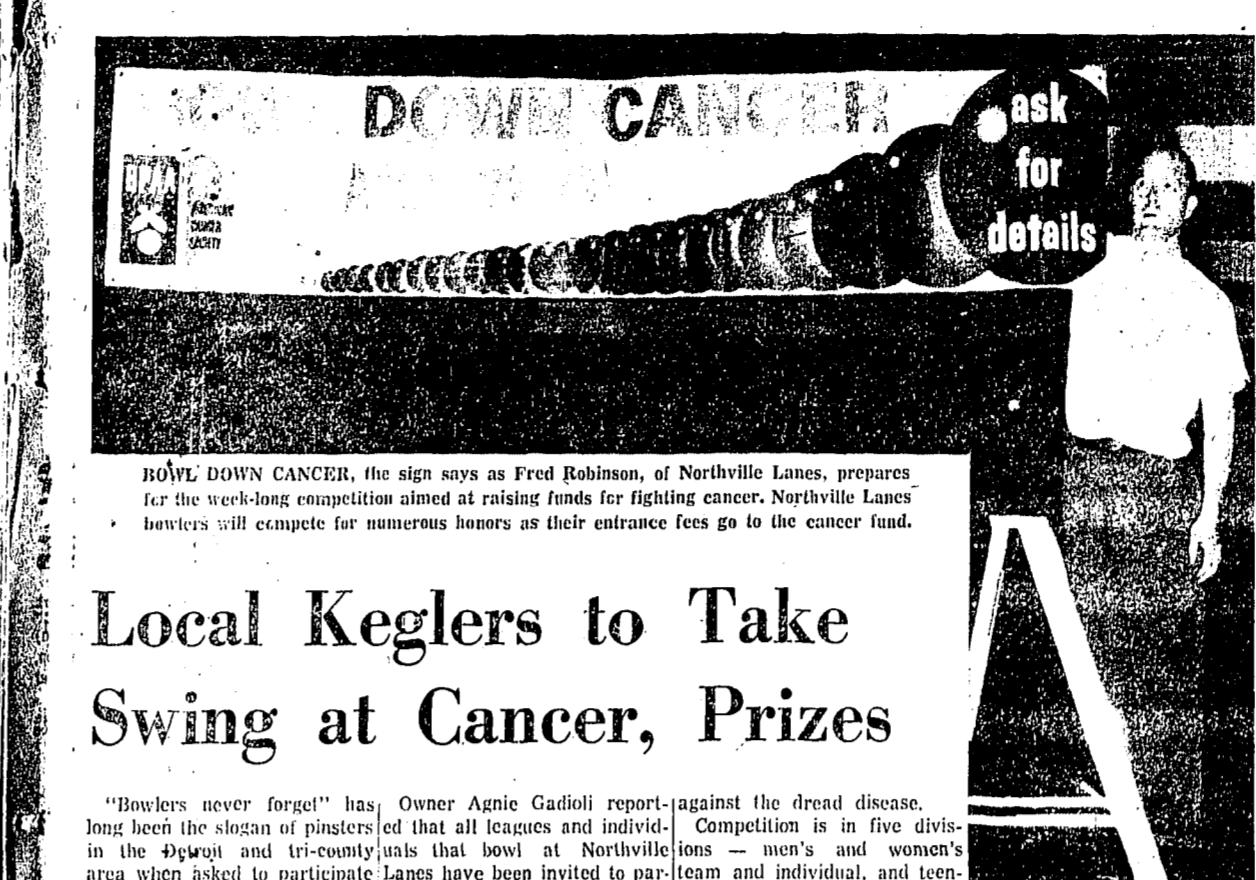

Bell Telephone Church Services Tells of Expansion

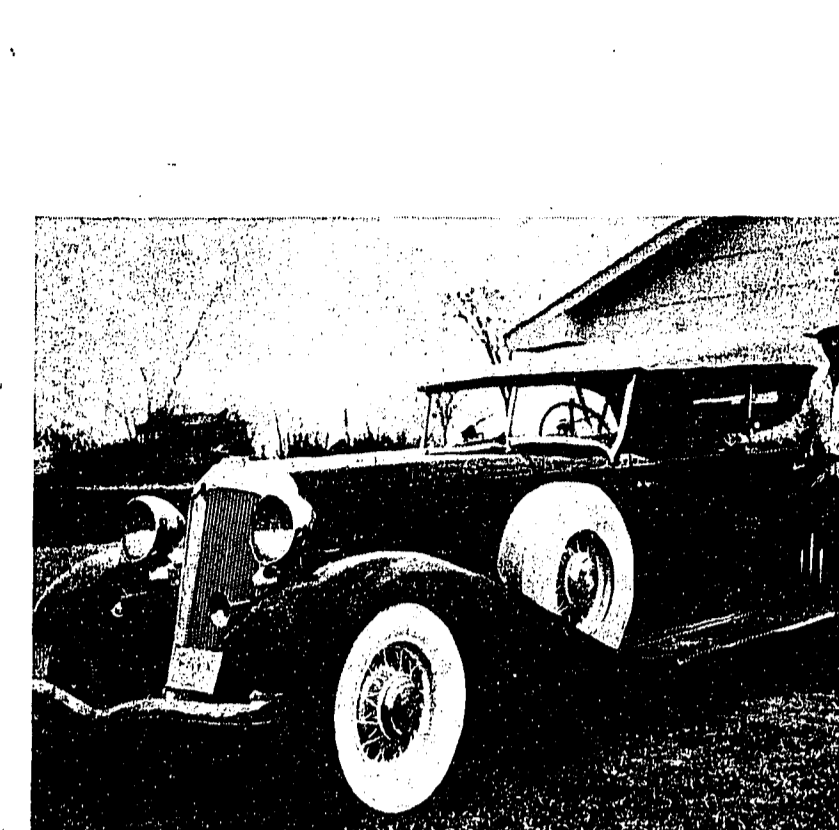
An outlay of nearly \$80 million will be made this year for the expansion and improvement of its facilities, the Michigan Bell Telephone Company announced today.

In the construction program, one of the largest in the company's history, more than \$10,000,000 has been earmarked for new and expanded facilities in Northville.

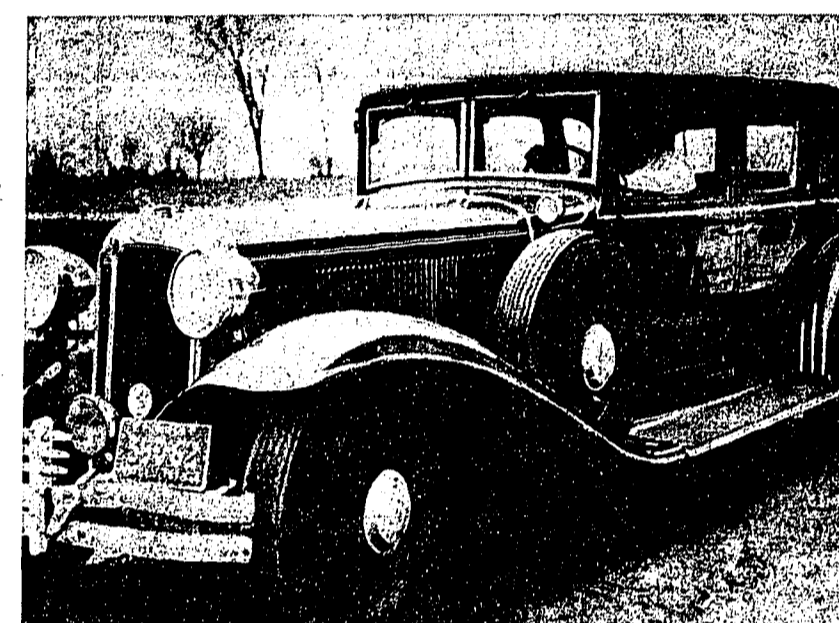

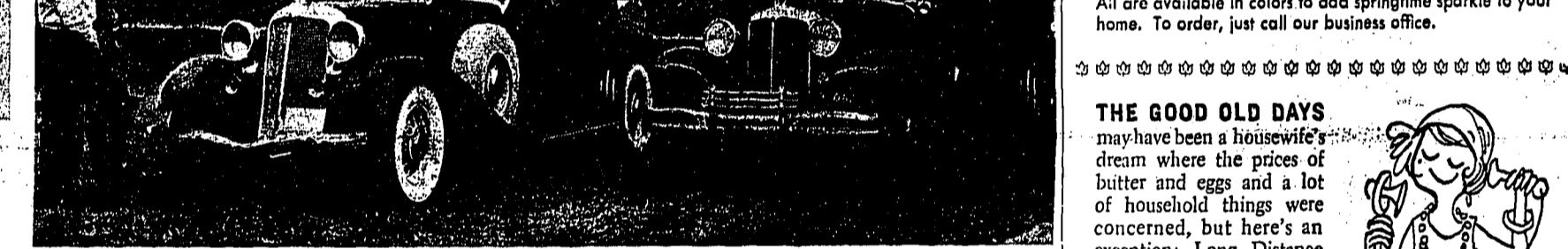
They Ride First Class - 1930 Style!
