One-Day Attempt Set In United Fund Drive

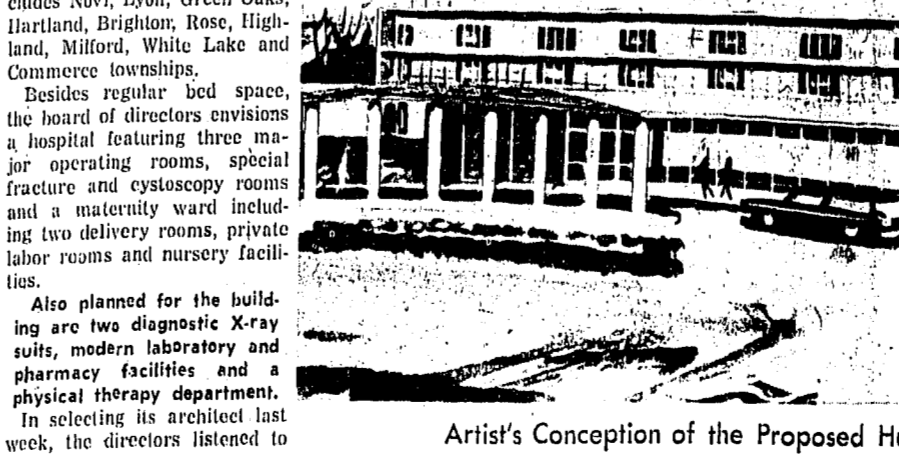
