City of Wixom Ordinance No. 52

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE FILLING OF LANDS WITHIN THE CITY OF WIXOM; TO REGULATE OR PROHIBIT DUMPING, DEPOSITING OR ACCUMULATION OF WASTE, RUBBISH, REFUSE, DEBRIS, JUNK, OR GARBAGE; TO REGULATE THE COLLECTION, HANDLING AND DISPOSAL OF WASTE, RUBBISH, REFUSE, JUNK OR GARBAGE; TO PRESCRIBE RULES, REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS OR LICENSES FOR SAME, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The City of Wixom Ordinance No. 52, which was passed by the City Council on April 10, 1963, is hereby published for information and to advise the public of its contents. It is the policy of the City of Wixom to regulate the filling of lands with waste, rubbish, refuse, debris, junk, or garbage, and to provide for the proper disposal of such materials. Merchants Cautioned By Police

Northville Chief of Police Eugene King warned local merchants last week that violators of the Fraternities Ordinance are not merely identified by the local police. Section 15.01. Also any person, persons, firm, partnership, association, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to the city of Wixom for a fine of not more than \$100 and imprisonment for not more than 30 days.

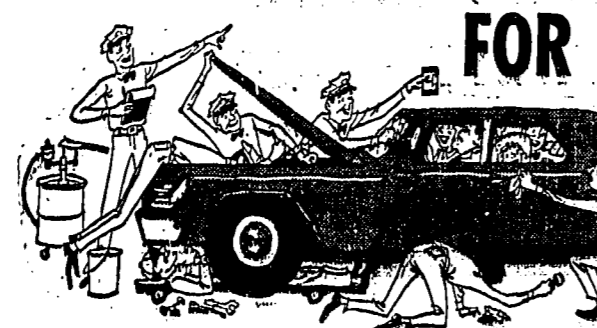
