

Assessment Roll for the Township of Orion

No more than one tract or parcel is to be valued or taxed on the same line. Two descriptions must not be joined in one valuation or tax unless contiguous and owned and occupied as one parcel. A parcel of land described in the government survey by lot number must be so assessed. The description of all lands in each town and range should be carefully written. In the case of platted land, the name of the plat must be given in full at the head of all descriptions included. If the name of the owner of non-resident land is not known, it should be assessed as "Owner Unknown." Enter the amount of any Reassessment with red ink, in the column of taxes to which it belongs, above the tax for the year for which this roll is used, and in the column for "Remarks" opposite each The Valuation of Personal Property must be in a different column, and the taxes thereon entered on a different line from the Real Property. The name of each special tax must be entered at the head of the column in which it is placed. Supervisors will make no entry in column 10. The attention of assessing officers is especially called to Sections 1 to 8, 9 (as amended by Act 25 of 1895), 10, 11 (as amended by Act 229 of 1894), 12, 13, 14 (as amended by Act 32 of 1899), 15 to 17, 18 (as amended by Act 239 of 1899), 19, 20, 21 and 22 (as amended by Act 151 of 1899), 23, 24 (as amended by Act 326 of 1907), 25 to 40, 41 (as amended by Act 262 of 1899), 42 (as amended by Act 281 of 1897), and 43 of the Tax Law of 1893.
